# Nokia 105 Dual SIM Mobile Phone User Manual

Model: Nokia 105 (TA-1459 DS)

## 1. INTRODUCTION

The Nokia 105 Dual SIM is a reliable and easy-to-use mobile phone designed for essential communication. This manual provides detailed instructions to help you get started and make the most of your device.

Key features include:

- Dual SIM support for managing two phone numbers.
- Long-lasting battery for extended talk and standby times.
- Integrated LED flashlight for convenience.
- Built-in FM radio for entertainment.
- Storage for up to 2000 contacts.

## 2. SETUP

### 2.1 Package Contents

Ensure your package contains the following items:

- Nokia 105 Dual SIM Mobile Phone
- Battery
- Micro USB Charger
- Quick Start Guide (this manual)

### 2.2 Inserting the SIM Cards and Battery

To insert the SIM cards and battery:

1. Turn off the phone and disconnect any charger.
2. Remove the back cover by gently prying it from the notch at the bottom of the phone.
3. If the battery is in, lift it out.

4. Slide the SIM cards into their respective slots with the gold contacts facing down. Ensure they are securely in place. The Nokia 105 supports two SIM cards.
5. Align the battery contacts with the phone's contacts and insert the battery.
6. Replace the back cover by pressing it firmly until it clicks into place.

## 2.3 Charging the Battery

Your phone's battery has been partially charged at the factory, but you may need to recharge it before you can use it. Use only Nokia-approved chargers.

1. Connect the Micro USB charger to the charging port at the bottom of your phone.
2. Plug the charger into a wall outlet.
3. When the battery is fully charged, disconnect the charger from the phone and then from the wall outlet.

## 3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

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### 3.1 Power On/Off

- To power on, press and hold the **Power key** until the phone vibrates.
- To power off, press and hold the **Power key**, then select **Power off**.

### 3.2 Making a Call

1. From the home screen, enter the phone number.
2. Press the **Call key** (green button).
3. If you have two SIM cards, select which SIM to use for the call.
4. To end the call, press the **End key** (red button).

### 3.3 Sending a Message

1. Go to **Menu > Messages > Create message**.
2. Write your message using the keypad.
3. Enter the recipient's phone number or select from contacts.
4. Select **Send**.

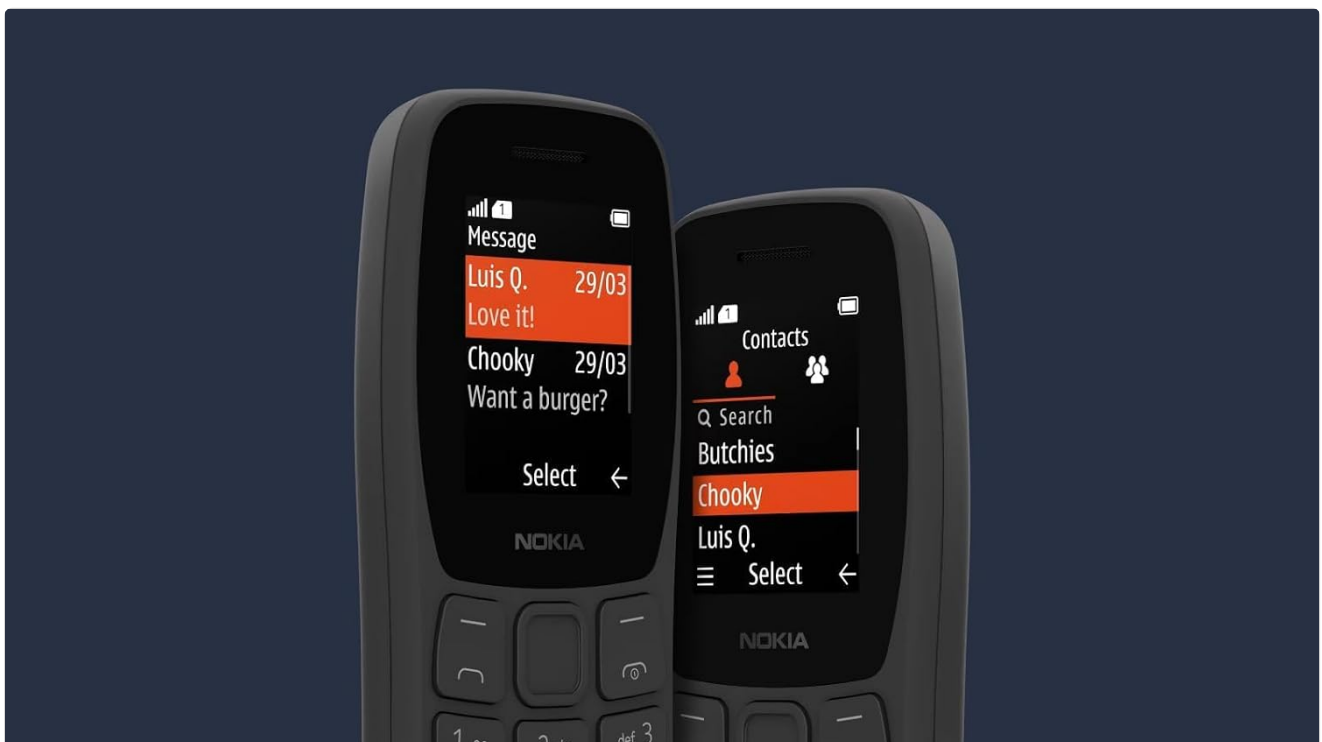


Image: The phone display showing a message thread and the contacts menu.

### 3.4 Using the Flashlight

To turn the flashlight on or off:

- From the home screen, press and hold the **Up navigation key**.
- Alternatively, navigate to **Menu > Flashlight** and select **On** or **Off**.

### 3.5 Using the FM Radio

To listen to FM radio:

1. Go to **Menu > Radio**.
2. The phone will automatically search for available stations.
3. Use the navigation keys to change stations or adjust volume.

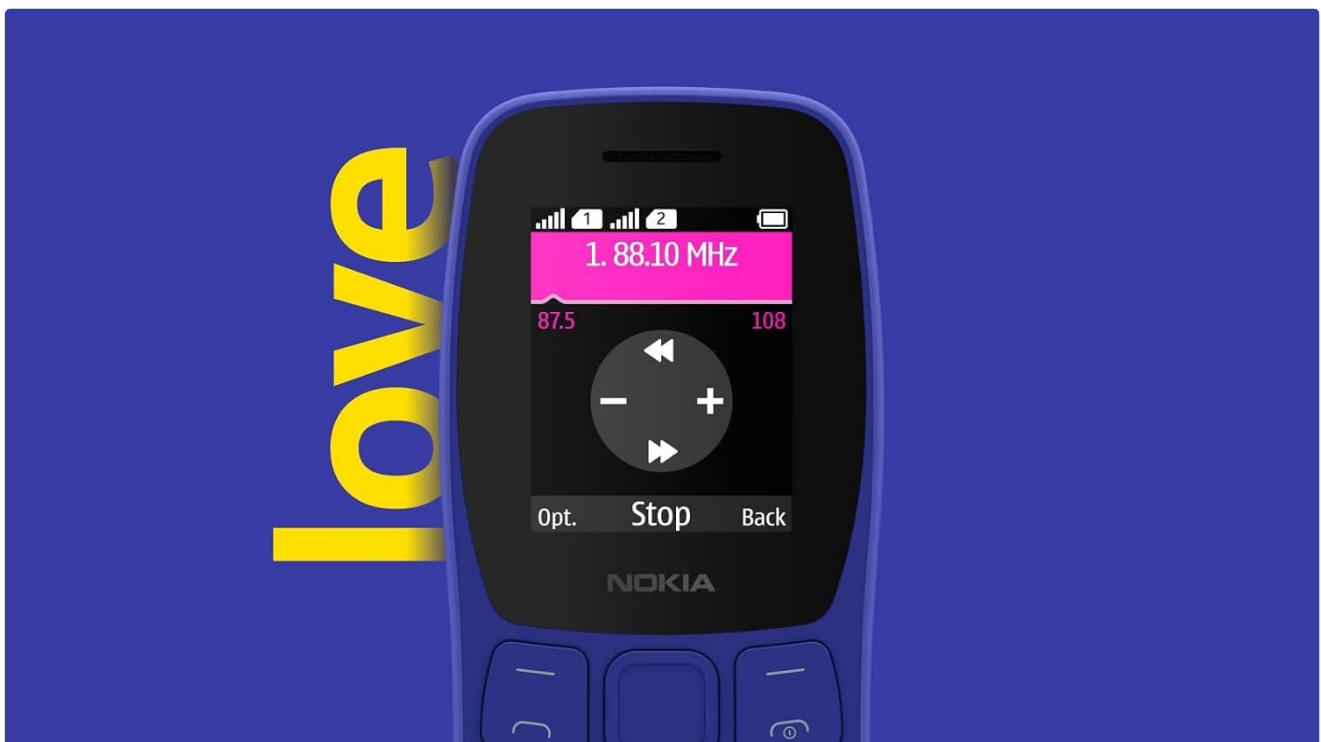


Image: The phone display showing the FM radio interface with frequency and control options.

## 4. MAINTENANCE

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

- Ensure the battery is correctly inserted and charged.
- Try charging the phone for at least 30 minutes.
- Remove and reinsert the battery.

### 5.2 No Network Signal

- Check that your SIM card is correctly inserted.
- Move to an open area or a location with better network coverage.
- Restart your phone.

### 5.3 Charging Issues

- Ensure the charger is properly connected to both the phone and the power outlet.
- Try using a different compatible charger.
- Check the charging port for any debris.
