INTRODUCTION

SETUP

Before first use, fully charge the camera and ensure the 64GB Micro SD card is properly inserted.

Charging the Camera

Connect the camera to a power source (PC or wall adapter) using the provided USB cable. The camera features a 1000mAh rechargeable lithium battery, offering up to 360 minutes of filming time. It is recommended to remove the SD card before charging to ensure optimal charging performance.

Inserting/Removing the Micro SD Card

The camera comes with a built-in 64GB storage. To access or remove the Micro SD card, gently slide off the bottom part of the camera. The card can then be easily popped out. Ensure the card is securely inserted before use.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Brathird Mini Body Camera features simple controls for various functions.

Power On/Off

- To Power On: Long press the "power" button. The blue light will indicate standby mode.
- To Power Off: Long press the "power" button again.

Recording Video

- From standby mode (steady blue light), short press the "Video" button. The blue light will flash slowly, indicating recording has started.
- To stop recording, short press the "Video" button again. The blue light will return to steady, and the video file will be saved.

Taking Photos

- From standby mode (steady blue light), short press the "Photo" button once. The blue light will flash once, indicating a photo has been taken and saved.

Activating Night Vision

- From standby mode, short press the power button. The blue light will turn yellow, indicating night vision is active. The camera features 4 invisible IR lights for clear footage up to 6 feet in low light conditions.

Motion Detection Mode

- From standby mode, long press the "Video" button. The lights will turn green, indicating motion detection mode is active. The camera will automatically start recording for 1 minute when motion is detected.

Loop Recording

The camera supports loop recording. When the 64GB storage limit is reached, the camera automatically overwrites the oldest files, ensuring continuous recording without manual intervention.

Viewing Files

Files can be read on any PC using two methods:

- Connect the camera directly to your computer using the included USB cable (ensure the camera is powered off).
- Use the included card reader to access files directly from the Micro SD card. For Mac users, a specific card reader for Mac may be required.

MAINTENANCE

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
Camera not turning on	Battery may be depleted. Charge the camera fully. Ensure the power button is long-pressed correctly.
Cannot record video/take photos	Micro SD card may be full or improperly inserted. Check card insertion and ensure sufficient storage space. The camera supports loop recording, but a full card might temporarily prevent new recordings if the overwrite function is delayed.
Poor video/photo quality	Ensure the lens is clean and free from smudges. Check lighting conditions; night vision should be activated in low light.
Files not accessible on PC	Ensure the camera is powered off when connecting via USB. Try using the included card reader. For Mac users, a different card reader might be necessary.
Camera stops recording unexpectedly	Battery may be low. Ensure the camera is fully charged before extended use. Check for sufficient storage space on the Micro SD card.
