Intelligent, waterproof, and rechargeable bark collar for effective and safe barking control.

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1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The GROOVYPETS Smart Automatic Anti-Bark Dog Collar (Model TC005) is designed to help manage and reduce excessive barking in dogs. It features an intelligent system that detects barking and applies corrective stimuli through sound, vibration, and static shock, with adjustable sensitivity levels to suit various dog temperaments and barking habits. The collar is rechargeable, waterproof, and suitable for dogs weighing 10lbs-110lbs with neck sizes from 6 to 24 inches.

2. SETUP

2.1 Unboxing and Components

Before first use, ensure all components are present:

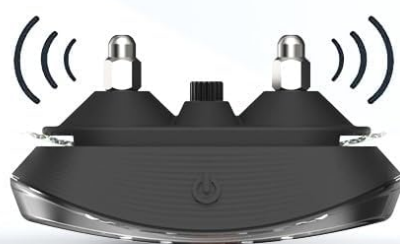
- Anti-Bark Collar Unit

- Contact Points (various sizes)
- Silicone Protective Caps

2.2 Charging the Collar

The collar is equipped with a rechargeable battery. Charge the device fully before initial use.

1. Locate the charging port on the collar unit, usually covered by a rubber flap for waterproofing.
2. Open the rubber flap and connect the USB charging cable.
3. Connect the other end of the USB cable to a suitable USB power adapter (not included) or a computer USB port.
4. The indicator lights on the collar will show charging status. A full charge typically provides up to 12 days of battery life.
5. Once fully charged, disconnect the cable and securely close the rubber flap to maintain waterproofing.

2.3 Attaching Contact Points and Protective Caps

Select the appropriate length of contact points based on your dog's fur length to ensure proper contact with the skin. Use

the silicone protective caps for comfort and to prevent direct metal-to-skin contact if static shock is not desired or for sensitive dogs.

- Twist the desired contact points onto the collar unit.
- Place the silicone protective caps over the contact points if you wish to disable the static shock function or for added comfort.

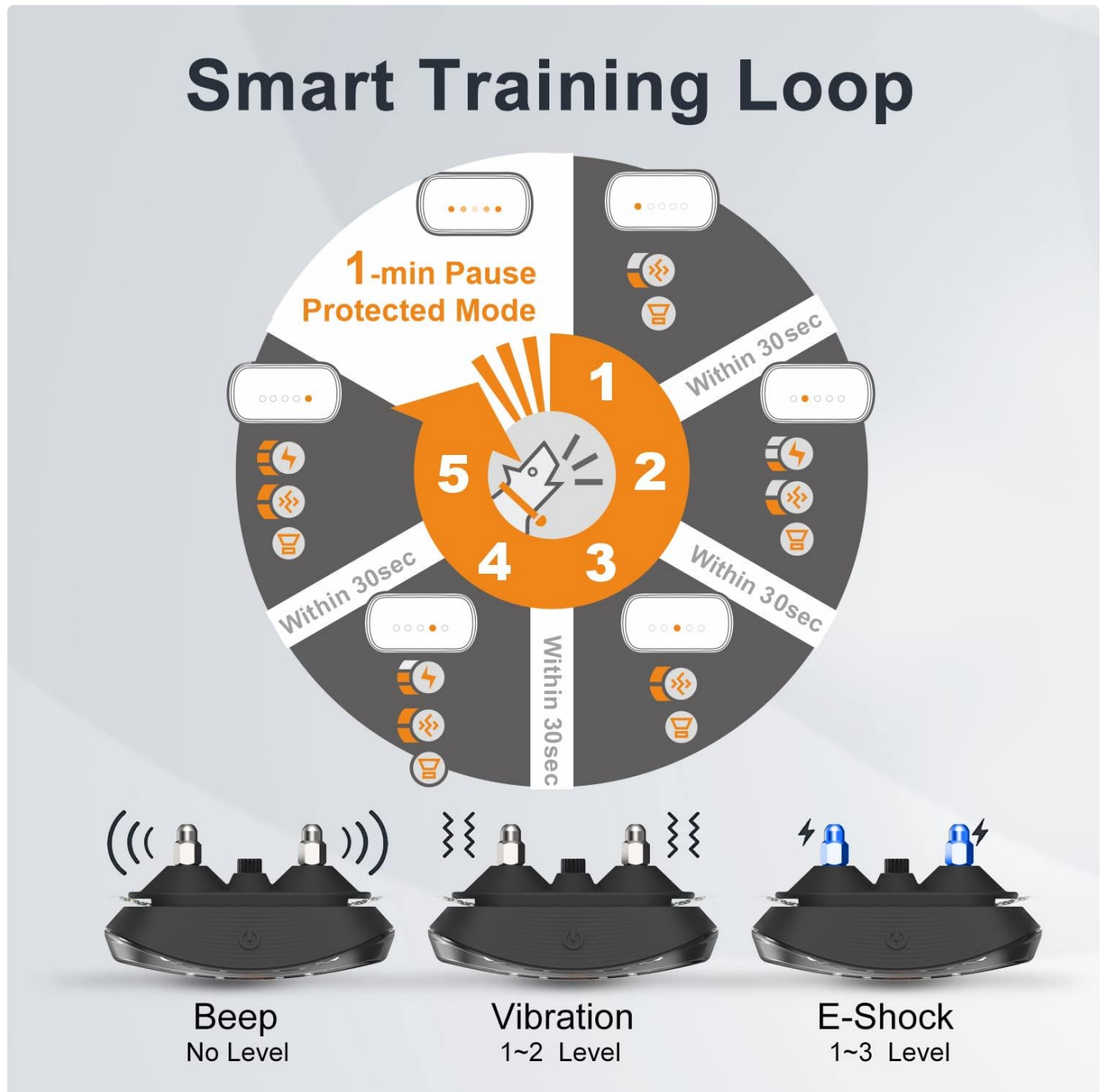


Image 2.2: The collar unit showing contact points and the option to use silicone protective caps.

2.4 Fitting the Collar

Proper fit is crucial for the collar's effectiveness and your dog's comfort.

- Adjust the nylon strap to ensure the collar unit sits snugly on your dog's neck, typically around the throat area.
- You should be able to fit one or two fingers comfortably between the collar and your dog's neck.
- The contact points should make consistent contact with the skin.
- The collar is designed for dogs with neck circumferences from 6 to 24 inches and weights from 10 to 110 lbs.

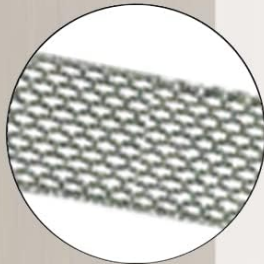

3. OPERATION

3.1 Powering On/Off

To power on or off the collar, press and hold the power button located on the unit. The indicator lights will illuminate to confirm the status.

3.2 Adjusting Sensitivity Levels

The collar offers 5 levels of sensitivity to barking. Adjusting the sensitivity allows the collar to respond appropriately to your dog's barking volume and frequency.

- While the collar is on, tap the power button to cycle through the sensitivity levels.

- More illuminated lights indicate higher sensitivity (responds to quieter barks).
- Fewer illuminated lights indicate lower sensitivity (responds to louder barks).
- Choose a sensitivity level that prevents false triggers from other noises but effectively detects your dog's barks.

3.3 Automatic Barking Control Modes

The collar operates automatically, progressing through corrective modes if barking continues. It features a smart training loop to prevent overcorrection.

- **Levels 1-2 (Beep & Vibrate):** The initial corrections involve a warning beep followed by vibration. These are designed to startle the dog without causing discomfort.
- **Levels 3-5 (Beep, Vibrate & Static Shock):** If barking persists, the collar will introduce a mild static shock in addition to the beep and vibration. The intensity of the static shock increases with each subsequent bark within a 30-second interval.
- **Safety Pause:** After 5 consecutive triggers within a cycle, the collar will enter a 1-minute non-action pause to

prevent overcorrection, ensuring the dog's safety and well-being.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Cleaning

Regularly clean the collar unit and strap to ensure hygiene and proper function.

- Wipe the collar unit with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- Clean the contact points to remove any dirt or debris that might impede contact with the dog's skin.
- The nylon strap can be hand-washed with mild soap and water. Ensure it is completely dry before reattaching to the unit.

4.2 Battery Care

To prolong battery life:

- Charge the collar fully when the battery indicator is low.
- Avoid overcharging or completely draining the battery for extended periods.
- If storing the collar for a long time, charge it to about 50% and recharge every few months.

4.3 Waterproofing

The collar has an IP67 waterproof rating, meaning it is protected against immersion in water up to 1 meter for up to 30 minutes. Ensure the charging port's rubber flap is securely closed before exposing the collar to water.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Collar not activating:**

- Ensure the collar is powered on and fully charged.
- Check the sensitivity level. Increase sensitivity if your dog's bark is quiet.
- Verify that the contact points are making proper contact with your dog's skin. Adjust the strap or use longer contact points if necessary.
- Test the collar by blowing air onto the sensor between the contact points. It should beep and vibrate.

- **False activations:**

- Decrease the sensitivity level.
 - Ensure the collar is not too loose, allowing it to rub against other surfaces or your dog's movements to trigger it.
 - Check for external noises that might be triggering the collar.
- **Static shock not felt:**
 - Ensure silicone protective caps are not installed if static shock is desired.
 - Verify contact points are making good skin contact.
 - The static shock levels are progressive; it may take a few barks to reach higher levels.
