1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Ingco 20V Lithium-Ion Blower, Model CABLI20428. Please read these instructions carefully before using the product and retain them for future reference.

The Ingco 20V Lithium-Ion Blower is a handheld, battery-powered tool designed for clearing leaves and debris from outdoor surfaces. It features a powerful airflow and is engineered for ease of use.

2. Safety Information

5. Setup

5.1 Attaching the Nozzle:

1. Align the nozzle with the air outlet on the front of the blower unit.
2. Push the nozzle firmly onto the outlet until it clicks into place, ensuring a secure connection.

5.2 Installing the Battery:

1. Ensure the blower's power switch is in the 'OFF' position.
2. Slide a fully charged Ingco 20V Lithium-Ion battery (sold separately) into the battery port on the blower handle until it locks securely.
3. To remove the battery, press the release button (if present) and slide the battery out.

Always ensure the battery is fully charged before use for optimal performance.

6. Operating Instructions

6.1 Starting the Blower:

1. Ensure the battery is securely installed.
2. Hold the blower firmly with one hand on the main handle.
3. Press the power trigger to start the blower. The blower features a variable speed switch, allowing you to control the airflow intensity by adjusting the pressure on the trigger.

6.2 Using the Blower:

- Direct the nozzle towards the leaves or debris you wish to clear.
- Use a sweeping motion to gather debris into piles.
- For stubborn debris, increase the airflow by pressing the trigger further.
- Avoid directing the airflow towards people, animals, or fragile objects.

6.3 Stopping the Blower:

- Release the power trigger to turn off the blower.
- For extended storage or before maintenance, always remove the battery.

7. Maintenance

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your blower.

7.1 Cleaning:

- Before cleaning, ensure the blower is switched off and the battery is removed.
- Wipe the exterior of the blower with a clean, damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Clear any debris from the air intake vents and the nozzle to maintain proper airflow.

7.2 Storage:

- Store the blower in a dry, cool place, away from direct sunlight and moisture.
- Ensure the battery is removed before storing the unit for extended periods.
- Keep the blower out of reach of children.

8. Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your Ingco 20V Lithium-Ion Blower, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Blower does not start.	Battery not installed correctly or discharged.	Ensure battery is fully inserted and charged.
Reduced airflow.	Air intake or nozzle blocked.	Clear any debris from the air intake vents and nozzle.
Blower stops during operation.	Battery overheated or discharged.	Allow battery to cool down or replace with a fully charged battery.
