INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and effective use of your Westinghouse Electric Blanket Controller, model KTHB-TCN-Q. This controller is designed as a replacement unit for compatible Westinghouse heated blankets. Please read all instructions carefully before use and retain this manual for future reference.

Important Note: This product is the controller only. The electric blanket is not included.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always disconnect the controller from the power outlet before cleaning or when not in use.
- Do not immerse the controller in water or any other liquid.
- Ensure the controller and blanket connection is secure before plugging into a power source.
- Do not use if the controller or cord appears damaged. Contact Westinghouse customer support for assistance.
- Keep out of reach of children and pets.
- This controller is designed for use with Westinghouse electric blankets only. Using it with other brands or incompatible blankets may cause damage or safety hazards.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Westinghouse Electric Blanket Controller KTHB-TCN-Q features multiple heat settings for personalized comfort. It is designed for easy connection to compatible Westinghouse heated blankets.

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Prepare the Blanket:** Ensure your Westinghouse electric blanket is laid flat on the bed and is free from any folds or creases that could restrict heat distribution.
2. **Connect the Controller:** Locate the connector port on your electric blanket. Align the controller's plug with the blanket's port and push firmly until it clicks securely into place. Ensure the connection is snug and fully inserted.
3. **Plug into Power:** Insert the power cord from the controller into a standard 120V AC electrical outlet. Do not use extension cords or power strips.
4. **Initial Check:** After connecting, ensure all cables are free from kinks or pinches and are not trapped between the mattress and bed frame.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Power On:** Press the **Power** button on the controller to turn on the electric blanket. The display will illuminate, showing the current heat setting.
2. **Adjust Heat Setting:** Use the **Up** and **Down** arrow buttons (or similar controls, depending on controller design) to cycle through the available heat levels. Select your desired warmth.
3. **Pre-heating:** For best results, turn on the blanket 15-30 minutes before use to allow it to pre-heat.
4. **Power Off:** Press the **Power** button again to turn off the electric blanket. The display will turn off.

Note: This controller features multiple heat settings. If the blanket is left on for an extended period, it may automatically shut off to prevent overheating. If this occurs, turn the controller off, unplug it from the wall, wait a few minutes, then plug it back in and restart.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning the Controller:** Disconnect the controller from both the blanket and the wall outlet. Wipe the surface of the controller with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or immerse the controller in water.
- **Blanket Care:** Refer to your electric blanket's specific care instructions for washing and drying. Always disconnect the controller from the blanket before washing the blanket.
- **Storage:** When not in use, ensure the controller is disconnected from the blanket and power outlet. Store the controller and blanket in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and heavy objects that could damage the wiring.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Controller does not turn on.	Not plugged in; loose connection; power outage.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet. Check the connection between the controller and the blanket. Verify power to the outlet.
Blanket is not heating.	Low heat setting; blanket folded/bunched; internal safety shutdown.	Increase the heat setting. Ensure the blanket is spread flat. If the controller shut off, unplug it, wait a few minutes, then reconnect and restart.
Controller displays an error code.	Internal fault; overheating; blanket malfunction.	Turn off the controller, unplug it from the wall, and disconnect it from the blanket. Wait 5-10 minutes. Reconnect everything securely and try again. If the error persists, contact customer support.

If troubleshooting steps do not resolve the issue, do not attempt to repair the controller yourself. Contact Westinghouse customer support.
