1. INTRODUCTION

Constructed from extremely tough plastic, these handguards offer flexibility, absorbing impact effectively without transferring it directly to your handlebars or bar mounts, unlike rigid aluminum or steel alternatives.

2. COMPATIBILITY AND FITMENT

This product includes one pair of hand windshields without the full handguard assembly, designed to install directly into your existing hand protector setup.

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Installation of the EdvenA Handguard is straightforward. It is designed to be installed on both sides of the handlebar, integrating with your existing hand protector system.

Installation Steps:

1. Ensure your motorcycle is stable and turned off.
2. Identify the mounting points on your existing hand protectors or handlebars.
3. Align the EdvenA Handguard with the designated mounting points.
4. Use the provided hardware (screws and washers) to secure the handguard.
5. Tighten all fasteners firmly but do not overtighten, as this may damage the plastic or mounting points.
6. Repeat the process for the other side of the handlebar.
7. After installation, gently test the handguards to ensure they are securely attached and do not interfere with the operation of levers or controls.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The EdvenA Handguard operates passively once installed. Its primary function is to provide continuous protection to your motorcycle's controls and hands from environmental elements and minor impacts during riding. No active operation or user input is required after proper installation.

To ensure the longevity and effectiveness of your handguards, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Clean the handguards regularly with mild soap and water. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents that could damage the plastic finish.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the handguards for any signs of damage, cracks, or loose mounting hardware.
- **Fastener Check:** Ensure all mounting screws remain tight. Retighten if necessary, but avoid overtightening.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Most issues related to the handguards can be resolved by ensuring proper installation.

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|---|--|---|
| Handguard feels loose or vibrates | Mounting screws are not tight enough. | Check and tighten all mounting screws. Ensure they are securely fastened to the handlebar or existing hand protector. |
| Handguard interferes with lever operation | Incorrect positioning during installation. | Loosen mounting screws, adjust the handguard's position to ensure clearance for levers, then retighten. |
| Visible damage to handguard | Impact or wear and tear. | If the damage compromises protection, consider replacing the handguard. |
