3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

To fully utilize the Philips Hue Secure Battery Camera, a Philips Hue Bridge is required for seamless integration with your smart lighting system and advanced features.

3.1 Preparing for Installation

- Download the latest Philips Hue app on your smartphone or tablet.
- Ensure your Philips Hue Bridge is set up and connected to your network.
- Choose a suitable indoor or outdoor location for your camera. The camera has an IP65 rating, making it resistant to dust and water jets.

3.2 Mounting the Camera

The camera comes with a magnetic mount for flexible placement. Follow these steps for secure installation:

1. Twist to remove the mounting bracket from the magnetic mount.

- 2. Using a pencil, mark the placement of the bracket on the wall.
- 3. Drill a hole into the mounting surface at the marked spot.

- 5. Route the power cable through the mounting bracket.
- 6. Place the magnetic mount back onto the mounting bracket and twist to secure.
- 7. Place the camera onto the magnetic mount and adjust its angle as desired.
- 8. Connect the power cable to the camera.

- 4. The app will guide you through connecting the camera to your Hue Bridge and Wi-Fi network.




Image: The camera is designed for easy installation and setup via the Hue app.




Image: Monitor your home in real-time with the Hue app's live view feature.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning

To maintain optimal performance, regularly clean the camera lens and body with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials that could damage the camera's finish or lens.

6.2 Battery Charging

The Philips Hue Secure Battery Camera is rechargeable. When the battery level is low, you will receive a notification in the Hue app. Use the provided USB A cable and PSU to charge the camera. Ensure the charging port is dry before connecting the cable.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

7.1 Connectivity Issues

- Camera Offline: Ensure your Wi-Fi network is active and the camera is within range of your router or Hue Bridge. Restarting your router, Hue Bridge, and camera may resolve the issue.
- App Not Detecting Camera: Verify the camera is powered on and in pairing mode (if applicable). Try rescanning the QR code in the Hue app.

7.2 Video Quality Problems

- **Blurry or Unclear Footage:** Clean the camera lens. Ensure there are no obstructions in the camera's field of view. Check your internet connection speed.
- **Poor Night Vision:** Ensure the infrared lights are not obstructed. Adjust the camera's position to minimize glare from nearby light sources.

7.3 Battery Life Concerns

- Short Battery Life: Frequent live view access, high motion activity, and extreme temperatures can affect battery life. Adjust motion sensitivity settings in the app.
- Not Charging: Ensure the charging cable and PSU are properly connected and functioning.
 Try a different power outlet.
