WHAT'S IN THE Box


Carefully unpack your Roku Smart TV and ensure all components are present. The package should contain the following items:









SETUP

1. Attaching the TV Stands

If you are not wall-mounting your TV, attach the included stands. Place the TV screen-down on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches. Align each stand with the corresponding screw holes on the bottom of the TV and secure them with the provided screws.

2. Connecting Devices

Your Roku TV offers multiple connectivity options for external devices.

- **HDMI Ports:** Connect Blu-ray players, game consoles, cable boxes, and other HDMI-enabled devices. This model includes HDMI 1 (eARC) for enhanced audio return channel functionality.
- **USB Port:** For media playback from USB drives.
- **Optical Audio Out:** For connecting to soundbars or audio receivers.
- **Ethernet (LAN) Port:** For a wired internet connection.
- **Antenna/Cable Input:** For connecting an antenna or cable TV feed.

3. Powering On and Initial Setup

Connect the power cable to the TV and a wall outlet. Press the power button on the TV or the remote. Follow the on-screen instructions to:

- Select your language.
- Connect to your Wi-Fi network (or use Ethernet).
- Activate your Roku account (or create a new one).

- Scan for local channels (if using an antenna).

4. Remote Control Setup

The Roku Voice Remote Pro is rechargeable. Connect the included USB charging cable to the remote and a USB power source to charge it. The remote features a hands-free voice on/off switch, a microphone for voice commands, and personal shortcut buttons for quick access to your favorite streaming apps.







MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning Your TV

To clean the screen, gently wipe it with a soft, lint-free cloth. For stubborn marks, dampen the cloth slightly with water or a screen-cleaning solution. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials. For the TV body, use a dry, soft cloth.

2. Software Updates

Your Roku TV automatically checks for and installs software updates when connected to the internet. These updates provide new features, performance improvements, and bug fixes. Ensure your TV remains connected to the internet for optimal performance.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Roku Smart TV, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
No Power	Ensure the power cable is securely connected to both the TV and a working electrical outlet. Try a different outlet.
No Picture / Black Screen	Check input source (HDMI, Antenna). Ensure connected devices are powered on. Restart the TV by unplugging it for 30 seconds.
No Sound	Check volume level and mute status. Ensure external audio devices (soundbar, receiver) are properly connected and powered on. Check audio settings in the TV menu.
Remote Not Responding	Ensure the remote is charged. Try re-pairing the remote by pressing and holding the pairing button inside the battery compartment (if applicable) or following on-screen instructions.
Network Connection Issues	Restart your Wi-Fi router. Check Wi-Fi password. Try connecting via Ethernet cable if possible.
Apps Not Loading / Slow Performance	Check internet speed. Restart the TV. Remove and re-add the problematic app. Ensure TV software is up to date.




