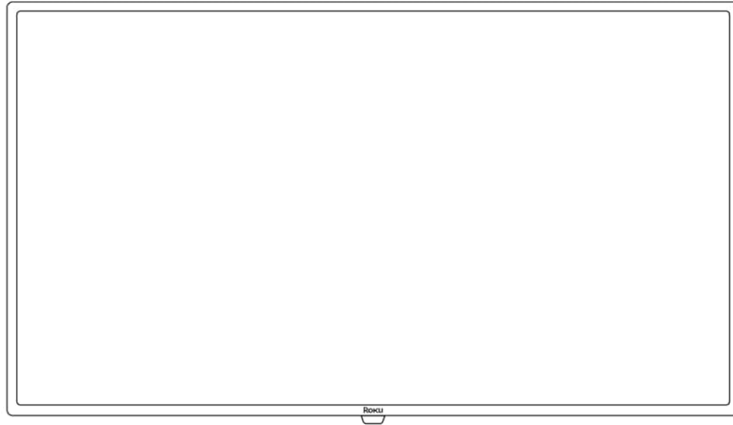


Image: Front view of the Roku 40" Select Series Full HD Smart TV.

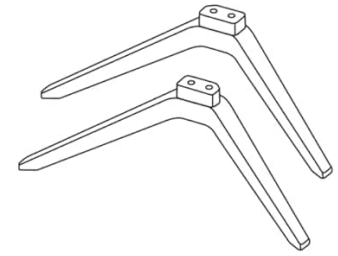

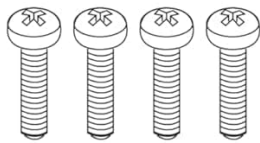

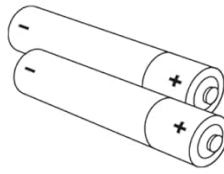

## 3. SETUP GUIDE

### 3.1 Attaching the TV Stands

1. Carefully place the TV screen-down on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
2. Align each TV stand with the corresponding screw holes on the bottom of the TV.
3. Insert the provided screws into the holes and tighten them securely with a screwdriver.
4. Ensure both stands are firmly attached before proceeding.

### 3.2 Connecting Power and Initial Setup

1. Connect the power cord to the TV and then to a standard electrical outlet (100-240 VAC, 50-60 Hz).
2. Insert the AAA batteries into the Roku voice remote.
3. Press the power button on the remote to turn on the TV.
4. Follow the on-screen instructions to select your language, connect to your Wi-Fi network, and activate your Roku account.
5. The TV will guide you through adding your preferred streaming apps and setting up any connected devices.



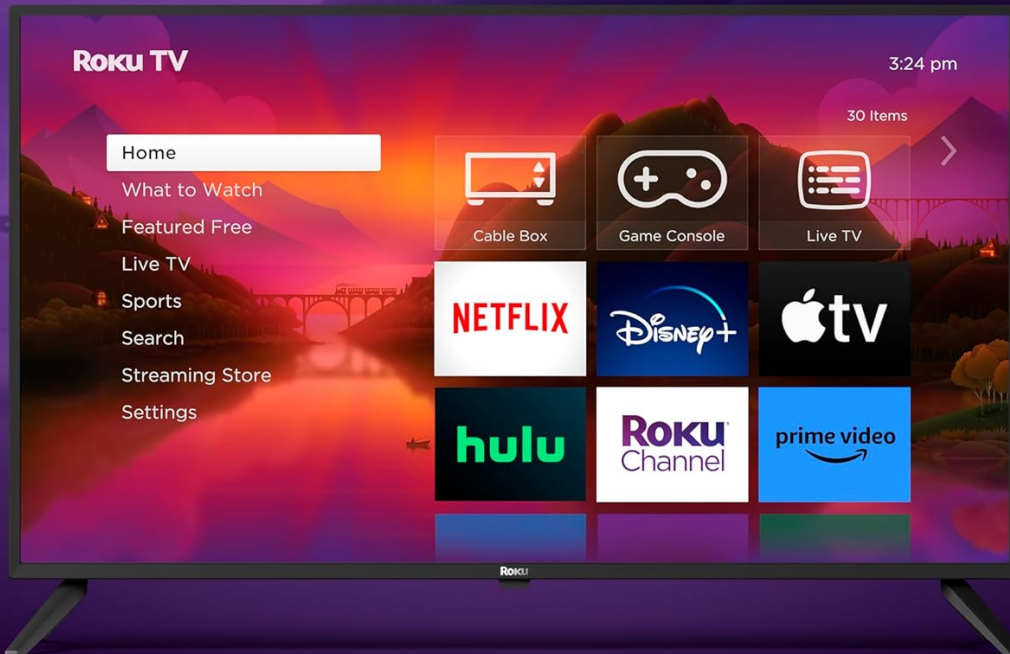

## 5. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Roku TV, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning the Screen:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth specifically designed for electronics. Gently wipe the screen to remove dust and smudges. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Cleaning the Exterior:** Wipe the TV's exterior with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners directly on the TV.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure the TV's ventilation openings are not blocked to prevent overheating. Maintain adequate space around the TV for air circulation.
- **Power Management:** Unplug the TV from the power outlet during electrical storms or when it will be left unattended for long periods.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Roku TV, try the following basic troubleshooting steps:

- **No Power:** Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into both the TV and the electrical outlet. Check if the outlet is

functioning by plugging in another device.

- **No Picture/Sound:** Verify that the correct input source is selected on the TV. Check all cable connections (HDMI, AV, etc.) for looseness.
- **Remote Not Responding:** Replace the batteries in the remote. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV. Re-pair the remote if necessary (refer to the on-screen instructions during initial setup or the Roku support site).
- **Network Connection Issues:** Restart your Wi-Fi router and modem. Go to the TV's network settings to reconnect to your Wi-Fi network.
- **App Freezing/Crashing:** Restart the specific app. If the issue persists, restart the TV by unplugging it from the power outlet for 30 seconds and then plugging it back in.
