INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Shadowhawk S1476 Rechargeable Flashlight. This high-performance tactical flashlight is designed for various applications, including camping, hiking, fishing, running, dog walking, power outages, and emergency situations. Equipped with an advanced XHP70.2 LED chip, it delivers exceptional brightness and reliability. This manual provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your flashlight to ensure optimal performance and longevity.

SETUP

1. Battery Installation

The Shadowhawk S1476 flashlight uses a large capacity rechargeable battery. Before first use, it is crucial to prepare the battery correctly.

- 1. Open the back cover of the flashlight by unscrewing it counter-clockwise.
- 2. **Important:** Locate the transparent plastic film wrapped around the battery. This film must be removed before installation. Failure to remove it will prevent the flashlight from functioning or charging.
- 3. Insert the battery into the flashlight with the positive (+) pole facing inwards towards the flashlight head, and the negative (-) pole facing outwards towards the tail cap.

4. Carefully screw the back cover clockwise until it is securely tightened.

2. Initial Charging

For optimal performance, fully charge the flashlight before its first use.

- Locate the USB charging port on the flashlight. This model features both USB input and output capabilities.
- Connect the provided USB charging cable to the flashlight's input port and plug the other end into a compatible USB power source (e.g., wall adapter, computer, power bank).
- The LED power indicator lights will illuminate to show the charging progress (25%, 50%, 75%, 100%). Once all four lights are solid, the flashlight is fully charged.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Power On/Off

Press the power button located on the side of the flashlight to turn it on. To turn it off from any mode, press and hold the power button for approximately 3 seconds.

2. Light Modes

The Shadowhawk S1476 features 5 distinct lighting modes. Briefly press the power button to cycle through the modes in the following order:

- High: Maximum brightness for powerful illumination.
- Medium: Balanced brightness for general use and extended battery life.
- Low: Minimal brightness for close-range tasks or preserving night vision.

- Strobe: Flashing light for signaling or disorienting.
- SOS: International Morse code signal for emergencies.

3. Zoom Function

The flashlight features a zoomable head, allowing you to adjust the beam from a wide floodlight to a focused spotlight.

- To achieve a wide floodlight, pull the head of the flashlight outwards. This is ideal for illuminating large areas.
- To achieve a focused spotlight, push the head of the flashlight inwards. This concentrates the beam for longdistance illumination.

4. Power Indicator

The integrated LED display provides real-time battery level information, ensuring you are aware of the remaining power.

• The indicator shows battery levels at 25%, 50%, 75%, and 100%.

• When the battery level is low, the indicator will prompt you to recharge the flashlight.

5. Power Bank Function (USB Output)

The Shadowhawk S1476 can also function as a power bank to charge other electronic devices.

- Connect your device's charging cable to the flashlight's USB output port.
- The flashlight will begin charging your device. Note that using this feature will deplete the flashlight's battery.

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning

- Wipe the flashlight body with a clean, soft cloth.
- For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by drying thoroughly.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents, as they may damage the finish or internal components.

2. Battery Care

- Recharge the battery regularly, even if the flashlight is not in frequent use, to maintain battery health.
- · Avoid completely draining the battery before recharging, as this can shorten its lifespan.
- If storing the flashlight for an extended period, charge the battery to approximately 50% and store it in a cool, dry place. Recharge every 3-6 months.

3. Waterproofing

The Shadowhawk S1476 is IP67 waterproof, meaning it is protected from dust and can withstand temporary immersion in water up to 1 meter for 30 minutes.

- Ensure the back cover is securely tightened to maintain the waterproof seal.
- Regularly inspect the sealing ring (O-ring) for any signs of wear or damage. If damaged, replace it to maintain waterproofing.
- After exposure to water, especially saltwater, rinse the flashlight with fresh water and dry it thoroughly.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Flashlight does not turn on.	Battery not installed correctly, battery is dead, or transparent film not removed.	Ensure battery is inserted with correct polarity. Remove the transparent plastic film from the battery. Charge the battery fully.
Light is dim or flickers.	Low battery, loose connections, or dirty contacts.	Recharge the battery. Ensure the tail cap is tightened. Clean battery contacts and flashlight contacts with a clean cloth.
Flashlight does not charge.	Charging cable faulty, power source issue, or transparent film not removed.	Try a different USB cable and power source. Ensure the transparent plastic film is removed from the battery.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Zoom function is stiff.	Dirt or debris in the mechanism.	Clean the exterior of the zoom mechanism. Avoid forcing the zoom.
