## 1. INTRODUCTION

Congratulations on your purchase of the Lilienthal Berlin Chronograph Meteorite III Anthracite watch. This timepiece combines sophisticated design with precision engineering, featuring a unique meteorite dial and a robust surgical steel case. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your watch to ensure its longevity and optimal performance.

## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Lilienthal Berlin Chronograph Meteorite III is an iconic timepiece designed with cosmic elegance. Each watch features a unique meteorite pattern, making it a truly one-of-a-kind accessory. Crafted with high-quality materials and Swiss precision, it offers both durability and style.

## Key Features:

- **Swiss Quartz Movement:** Equipped with a precise Ronda movement for reliable timekeeping.
- **Durable Construction:** Made with 316L surgical steel and sapphire-hardened mineral glass for enhanced durability.
- **Natural Leather Strap:** Comfortable, skin-friendly, and environmentally conscious, with a quick-release mechanism for easy replacement.
- **Chronograph Functionality:** Integrated stopwatch feature for precise timing.

## 3. SETUP

### 3.1 Initial Inspection

Upon unboxing your watch, carefully inspect it for any signs of damage. Ensure all protective films are removed from the crystal and case back.

### 3.2 Setting the Time

1. Pull the crown (middle knob on the right side of the case) out to position 2 (the outermost position).
2. Turn the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to set the hour and minute hands to the correct time.
3. Push the crown back into position 0 (normal operating position).

### 3.3 Setting the Date

1. Pull the crown out to position 1 (the first click).
2. Turn the crown clockwise to adjust the date. Avoid setting the date between 9 PM and 3 AM, as this can interfere with the automatic date change mechanism.
3. Once the correct date is displayed, push the crown back into position 0.

## 4. OPERATING THE CHRONOGRAPH

Your Lilienthal Berlin Chronograph features a precise stopwatch function, ideal for measuring elapsed time.

### 4.1 Starting and Stopping

1. Press the upper pusher (button A) to start the chronograph. The chronograph second hand will begin to move.
2. Press the upper pusher (button A) again to stop the chronograph. The elapsed time will be displayed on the sub-dials.

### 4.2 Resetting the Chronograph

1. After stopping the chronograph, press the lower pusher (button B) to reset all chronograph hands to their zero positions.

### 4.3 Split Time Function (if applicable)

Some chronograph models may feature a split time function. Consult the specific movement manual for detailed instructions if your watch supports this feature.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

### 5.1 Cleaning Your Watch

- Wipe the watch case and crystal regularly with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth.
- For the leather strap, avoid prolonged exposure to water, direct sunlight, and harsh chemicals. Clean with a damp cloth and mild soap if necessary, then dry thoroughly.
- Do not use chemical cleaning agents or abrasive materials, as these can damage the watch's finish.

### 5.2 Water Resistance

Your Lilienthal Berlin watch is designed with a certain level of water resistance. Refer to the markings on the case back for specific water resistance ratings (e.g., 5 ATM, 10 ATM). Generally, 5 ATM is suitable for splashes and brief immersion, while 10 ATM allows for swimming. *Always ensure the crown is fully pushed in before exposing the watch to water.*

### 5.3 Battery Replacement

The watch is powered by one LR44 battery. When the battery is low, the second hand may jump in 4-second intervals (End-of-Life indicator). Battery replacement should be performed by a qualified watchmaker to ensure proper sealing and water resistance.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- Watch not running:** Check if the crown is fully pushed in. If the watch still doesn't run, the battery may need replacement.
- Chronograph hands not resetting to zero:** If the chronograph hands do not align perfectly to the 12 o'clock position after resetting, they may need calibration. Consult a professional watchmaker for adjustment.
- Date not changing:** Ensure the time is set correctly (AM/PM). Avoid setting the date between 9 PM and 3 AM.
