1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the SiFENE Slow Masticating Juicer Machine JS3209. This appliance is designed to extract juice from various fruits and vegetables using a slow-speed cold press technology, preserving nutrients and flavor. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use to ensure safe and optimal operation.

The SiFENE JS3209 features a dual-feed chute for convenience, a quiet DC motor, and an efficient auger designed to minimize clogging and maximize juice yield. Its low-speed operation (80 RPM) helps reduce oxidation, resulting in a more nutrient-rich juice.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Do not immerse the motor base in water or other liquids.
- Keep hands and utensils out of the feed chute during operation to prevent injury. Use the food pusher provided.
- Ensure the appliance is properly assembled and all safety locks are engaged before operating.
- Unplug from the outlet when not in use, before assembling or disassembling parts, and before cleaning.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- This appliance is for household use only. Do not use outdoors.
- Children should be supervised to ensure they do not play with the appliance.

3. PRODUCT COMPONENTS

Familiarize yourself with the parts of your SiFENE juicer before assembly.

- 1. Motor Base: Contains the motor and control knob.
- 2. Feed Chute Assembly: Includes the dual-feed chute for different ingredient sizes.
- 3. **Auger:** The spiral component that crushes and presses ingredients.
- 4. **Filter:** Separates juice from pulp.
- 5. **Juice Cup:** Collects the extracted juice.
- 6. **Pulp Container:** Collects the discarded pulp.
- 7. **Food Pusher:** Used to guide ingredients into the feed chute.
- 8. Cleaning Brush: For easy cleaning of the filter and other parts.

4. ASSEMBLY AND SETUP

Follow these steps to assemble your juicer before use:

- 1. Place the motor base on a stable, flat surface.
- 2. Insert the auger into the filter.
- 3. Attach the combined auger and filter assembly into the feed chute assembly.
- 4. Align the feed chute assembly with the motor base and rotate clockwise until it locks securely into place. You should hear a click.
- 5. Place the juice cup under the juice outlet and the pulp container under the pulp outlet.

6. Ensure the anti-drip cap on the juice outlet is open for juicing.

5. OPERATION

5.1 Ingredient Preparation

- Wash all fruits and vegetables thoroughly.
- Remove hard pits from fruits (e.g., peaches, plums, cherries).
- Peel fruits with thick or inedible skins (e.g., oranges, lemons, pineapples).
- Cut ingredients into appropriate sizes to fit the feed chutes. The juicer features a dual-feed chute: a wider opening (2.4 inches) for larger items like apple slices, and a narrower opening (1.6 inches) for long vegetables like celery.



5.2 Juicing Process

- 1. Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet.
- 2. Turn the control knob to the desired setting: 'Soft' for softer fruits (85-100 RPM) or 'Hard' for harder vegetables (95-110 RPM).
- 3. Gradually feed prepared ingredients into the appropriate feed chute. Use the food pusher to gently guide ingredients down. Do not force ingredients.
- 4. The juicer will extract juice into the juice cup and separate pulp into the pulp container.
- 5. If the juicer becomes clogged, turn the knob to 'Rev' (Reverse) for a few seconds to clear the blockage, then return to 'Soft' or 'Hard' to continue juicing.
- 6. Once juicing is complete, turn the knob to 'Off' and unplug the appliance.



Anti-Clogging

The powerful 150W - 300W motor pushes fruits and veggies into the upgraded auger without clogging.




Image 5.4: The auger efficiently processes ingredients to extract juice.

6. CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning ensures the longevity and hygiene of your juicer.

- 1. Unplug the juicer from the power outlet.
- 2. Disassemble the juicer by rotating the feed chute assembly counter-clockwise and lifting it off the motor base.
- 3. Separate the auger, filter, and feed chute assembly.
- 4. Rinse all detachable parts (feed chute assembly, auger, filter, juice cup, pulp container, food pusher) under running water.
- 5. Use the provided cleaning brush to remove any pulp residue from the filter and other intricate parts.
- 6. All detachable parts are dishwasher safe.
- 7. Wipe the motor base with a damp cloth. Never immerse the motor base in water.
- 8. Allow all parts to dry completely before reassembling or storing.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Juicer does not turn on.	Not plugged in; not assembled correctly; safety lock not engaged.	Ensure power cord is securely plugged in. Check that the feed chute assembly is locked into the motor base.
Juicer stops during operation or gets clogged.	Too many ingredients fed at once; hard ingredients causing blockage.	Turn the knob to 'Rev' (Reverse) for a few seconds to clear the blockage, then resume juicing. Feed ingredients slowly.
Excessive pulp in juice.	Filter is clogged or damaged.	Clean the filter thoroughly. If damaged, contact customer service for a replacement.
Loud noise during operation.	Improper assembly; foreign object inside.	Disassemble and reassemble the juicer, ensuring all parts are correctly fitted. Check for any foreign objects.
