# AFMAT Effortless Stapler User Manual

Model: ES10BL

### 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The AFMAT Effortless Stapler is designed for ease of use and high efficiency, suitable for various environments including office, home, and school. It features a low-force mechanism, a built-in staple remover, and a capacity to staple up to 50 sheets of paper.

#### Key Features:

- **50-Sheet Capacity:** Capable of stapling up to 50 sheets of 70 gsm paper using #23/8 staples.
- **50% Effort Reduced:** Ergonomically designed for comfortable, one-finger operation, reducing hand strain.
- **Easy to Use & Quick Reloading:** Features a release button for fast and simple staple refilling.
- **JAM-FREE Technology:** Engineered to prevent staple jams for smooth and consistent performance.
- **Built-in Staple Remover:** Conveniently located at the back for quick staple removal.
- **Dual-Use Design:** Functions as both a desktop stapler and a handheld stapler.

### 2. SETUP AND LOADING

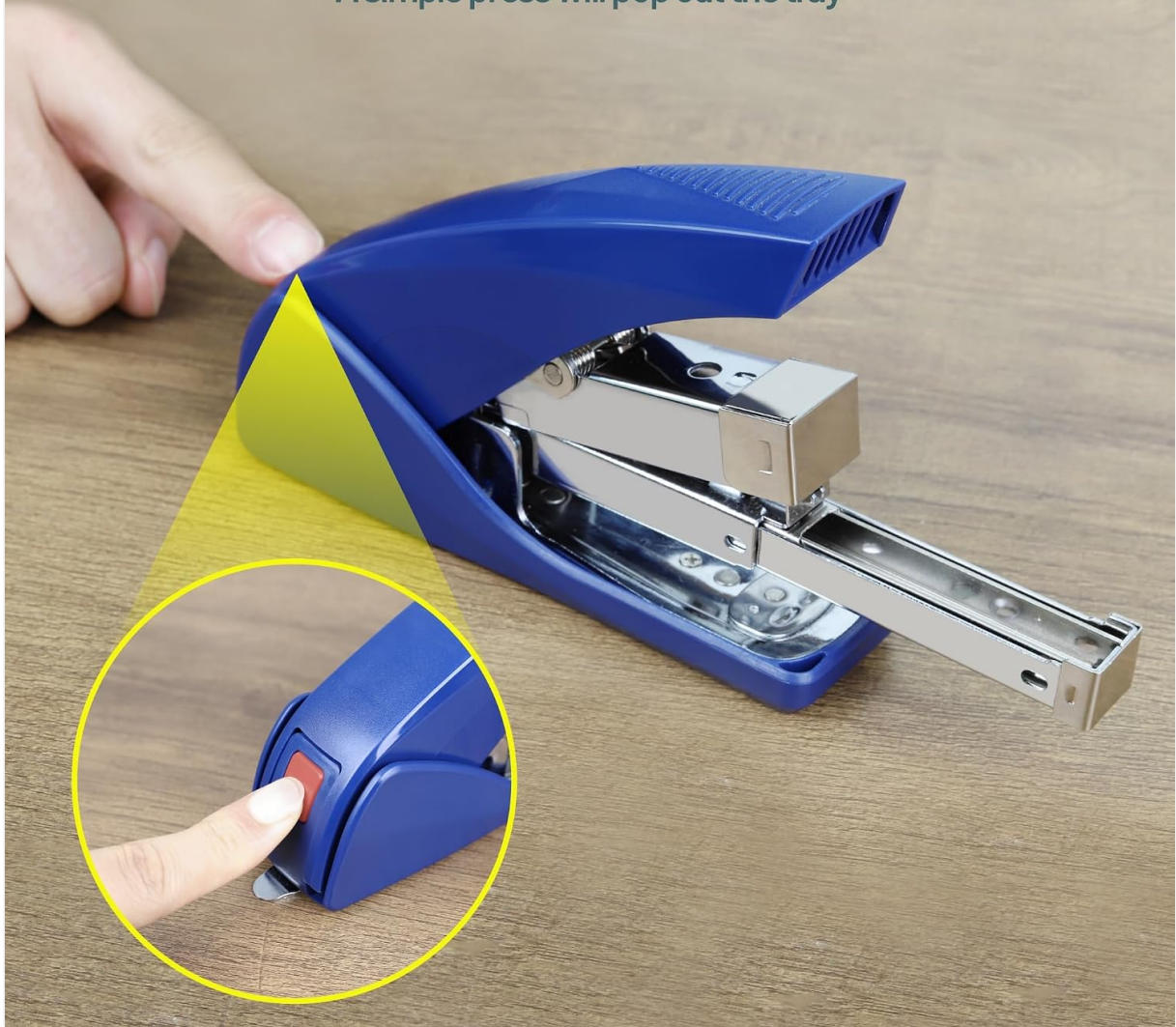
#### Loading Staples:

To load staples into your AFMAT Effortless Stapler, follow these steps:

1. Locate the red release button at the back of the stapler.
2. Press the release button firmly. The staple magazine will pop out from the front.
3. Insert a strip of compatible staples into the open magazine. Ensure the staples are facing the correct direction (legs down).
4. Gently push the staple magazine back into the stapler until it clicks securely into place.

## **Staple Compatibility:**

The AFMAT Effortless Stapler supports various staple types and capacities. Please refer to the table below to select the appropriate staple type for your needs. Staples are not included with the stapler.

**Staple Type and Sheet Capacity Guide**

| Staple Type      | Leg Length | Capacity (70 gsm paper) | Capacity (80 gsm paper) |
|------------------|------------|-------------------------|-------------------------|
| #26/6 (Standard) | 1/4 inch   | 25 Sheets               | 25 Sheets               |
| #24/6            | 1/4 inch   | 20 Sheets               | 20 Sheets               |
| #23/6            | 1/4 inch   | 30 Sheets               | 25 Sheets               |
| #23/8            | 5/16 inch  | 50 Sheets               | 40 Sheets               |

*Note: Always use the correct staple type for the desired sheet capacity to ensure optimal performance and prevent jams.*

### 3. OPERATION

#### Stapling Process:

The AFMAT Effortless Stapler is designed for simple, low-force stapling:

1. Gather the papers you wish to staple, ensuring they are neatly aligned.

2. Insert the corner of the paper stack into the stapler's opening, positioning it where you want the staple to be placed.
3. Apply gentle, firm pressure to the top of the stapler. Due to its low-force design, only minimal effort is required, often just one finger.
4. Continue pressing down until the stapler mechanism fully engages and the staple is driven through the paper. Ensure you press down deep enough before releasing to avoid half-staples or jams.
5. Release pressure and remove the stapled documents.

#### **Dual-Use Functionality:**

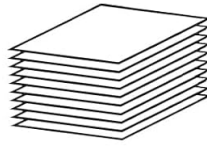
The AFMAT Effortless Stapler is versatile and can be used in two primary ways:

- **Desktop Stapler:** Place the stapler on a flat surface and press down with one finger for quick and easy stapling of documents.
- **Handheld Stapler:** The ergonomic design allows for comfortable gripping, making it suitable for handheld stapling, especially useful for larger or awkwardly shaped items.

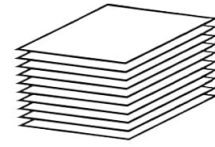

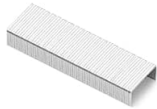

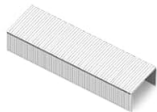

## 4. MAINTENANCE

### Using the Built-in Staple Remover:

The stapler includes a convenient staple remover integrated into its design:

1. Locate the small metal tab at the very back of the stapler, near the red release button.
2. Slide this tab underneath the staple you wish to remove.
3. Gently lift the stapler, using the tab to pry up the staple legs from the paper.
4. Once the staple is loosened, you can easily pull it out.

### General Care:

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your AFMAT Effortless Stapler:

- Keep the stapler clean by wiping it with a soft, dry cloth.
- Avoid exposing the stapler to excessive moisture or extreme temperatures.
- Store the stapler in a dry, dust-free environment when not in use.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

The AFMAT Effortless Stapler is designed with JAM-FREE technology. However, if you encounter any issues, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

### What to do if the stapler is jammed?

1. Press the release button to open the staple magazine.
2. Gently catch and remove any jammed staples, using pliers if necessary.
3. Remove and discard a few staples near the staple outlet to clear the path.

What to do if the staple tray is jammed and cannot be opened?

1. If the staple tray cannot be opened by pressing the release button, try to gently separate the stuck metal parts with your hands.
2. Alternatively, gently pry the stuck metal parts with a pair of pliers.
3. Once cleared, the staple tray should be able to open normally by pressing the release button.
