SETUP

1. Fire TV Stick 4K Max Setup

1. **Connect Fire TV Stick:** Plug the Fire TV Stick 4K Max directly into an available HDMI port on your TV. For optimal Wi-Fi performance, use the included HDMI extender if the stick is too close to other cables or devices.
2. **Power On:** Connect the USB cable to the Fire TV Stick and the power adapter, then plug the adapter into a wall outlet.
3. **Insert Remote Batteries:** Open the back of the Alexa Voice Remote and insert the two AAA batteries.
4. **Select Input:** Turn on your TV and select the HDMI input where your Fire TV Stick is connected.
5. **Follow On-Screen Instructions:** The Fire TV Stick will guide you through language selection, Wi-Fi network connection, and Amazon account registration.

2. Luna Controller Setup

1. **Insert Batteries:** Open the battery compartment on the back of the Luna Controller and insert the two AA batteries.
2. **Power On:** Press and hold the Luna button (circle with a purple ring) for 3 seconds until the light ring around the Luna button turns blue.
3. **Pairing with Fire TV Stick:**
 - Ensure your Fire TV Stick is set up and connected to the internet.
 - On your Fire TV, navigate to **Settings > Controllers & Bluetooth Devices > Amazon Luna Controllers > Add New Luna Controller**.
 - Follow the on-screen prompts to complete the pairing process. The Luna button light ring will turn solid blue when connected.
4. **Cloud Direct Connection:** For optimal low-latency gaming, the Luna Controller connects directly to Amazon's custom game servers via Wi-Fi. Ensure your Fire TV Stick and Luna Controller are on the same Wi-Fi

network.

5. **Bluetooth Connection (Optional):** The Luna Controller can also connect via Bluetooth to compatible devices (e.g., PCs, Macs, Android phones, iPhones). To switch to Bluetooth mode, press and hold the Luna button and the 'B' button simultaneously for 3 seconds until the light ring flashes white. Then, pair it like any other Bluetooth device.

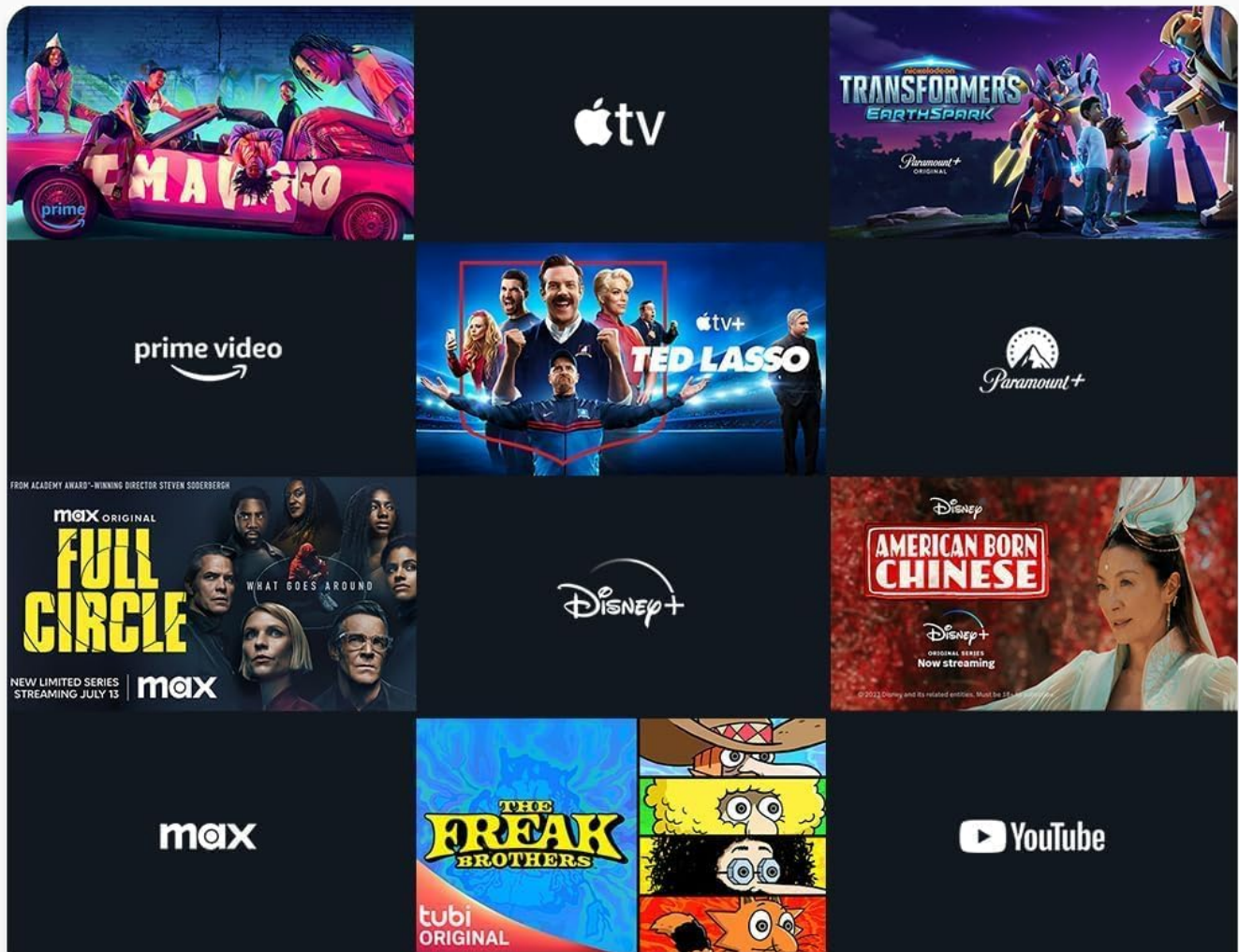

OPERATING

1. Using Fire TV Stick 4K Max for Streaming

- **Navigation:** Use the Alexa Voice Remote's directional pad to navigate menus, select content, and control playback.
- **Voice Commands:** Press and hold the microphone button on the Alexa Voice Remote and speak your commands (e.g., "Open Netflix," "Find action movies," "Play Fortnite").
- **App Installation:** Download and install your favorite streaming apps from the Appstore on your Fire TV.

- **Ambient Experience:** The Fire TV Stick 4K Max features an Ambient Experience, transforming your TV into a smart display when not in use, showing art, photos, or useful information.

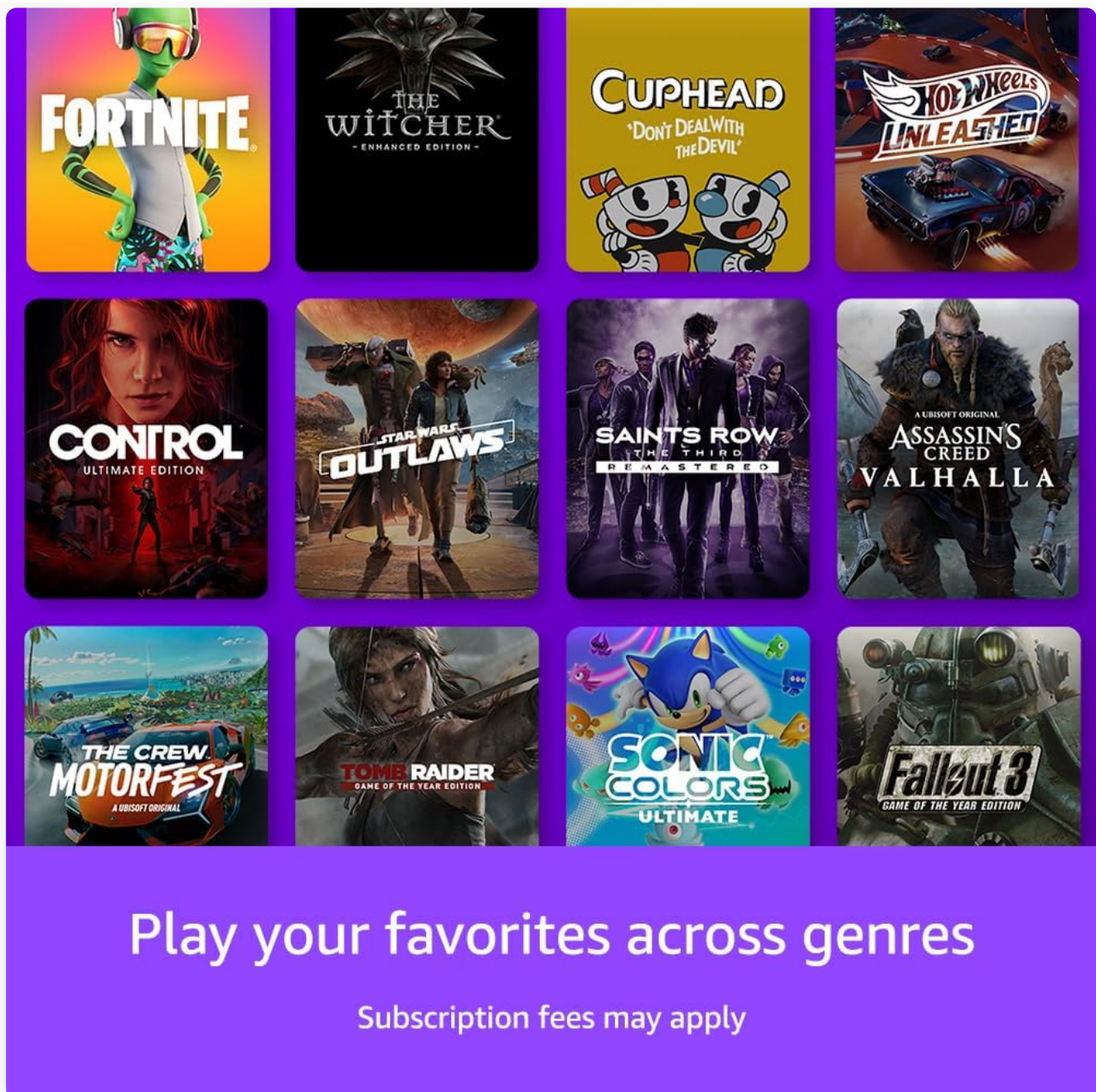
2. Using Luna Controller for Cloud Gaming

- **Luna App:** Download the Luna app on your Fire TV Stick 4K Max. This app is your gateway to the Luna cloud gaming service.
- **Game Selection:** Browse and select games directly from the Luna app.
- **Cloud Direct Advantage:** The Luna Controller's Cloud Direct technology connects directly to Amazon's cloud gaming servers, reducing input lag compared to traditional Bluetooth connections.
- **Subscription Requirements:** Access to Luna games typically requires a Prime membership or a Luna+ subscription. Specific game libraries (e.g., Ubisoft+, Jackbox Games) may require additional subscriptions.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to clean the Fire TV Stick, remote, and Luna Controller. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Software Updates:** Your Fire TV Stick 4K Max will automatically download and install software updates when connected to the internet. Ensure it remains connected to receive critical updates.
- **Luna Controller Batteries:** Replace the AA batteries in your Luna Controller when the light ring around the Luna button flashes red, indicating low battery.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store devices in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Fire TV Stick Issues

- **No Power/No Signal:**

- Ensure the Fire TV Stick is properly plugged into the HDMI port and the power adapter is connected to a working outlet.
- Verify your TV is set to the correct HDMI input.
- Try a different HDMI port or power outlet.

- **Remote Not Responding:**

- Replace the AAA batteries.
- Pair the remote again by holding the Home button for 10 seconds near the Fire TV Stick.

- **Wi-Fi Connection Problems:**

- Restart your Wi-Fi router and modem.
- Go to Fire TV Settings > Network and try reconnecting or forgetting and re-adding your network.
- Ensure the Fire TV Stick is within range of your Wi-Fi router.

Luna Controller Issues

- **Controller Not Connecting:**

- Ensure the Luna Controller has fresh AA batteries.
- Verify the controller is powered on (blue light ring).
- Re-pair the controller through the Fire TV Settings > Controllers & Bluetooth Devices menu.
- Ensure your Fire TV Stick and Luna Controller are on the same Wi-Fi network for Cloud Direct.

- **Input Lag/Performance Issues in Games:**

- Check your internet connection speed. Luna requires a stable, high-speed connection (at least 10 Mbps for 1080p).
- Reduce Wi-Fi interference by moving your router or Fire TV Stick.
- Ensure no other devices are heavily using your network bandwidth.
- Confirm the Luna Controller is connected via Cloud Direct (solid blue light) for optimal performance.

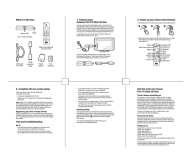
