## 1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Read all instructions carefully before using the appliance and retain them for future reference. Failure to follow these safety guidelines may result in electric shock, fire, or injury.

- Do not operate the microwave oven if the door is damaged, or if the oven is malfunctioning.
- Ensure the appliance is properly grounded.
- Do not heat liquids or other foods in sealed containers as they are liable to explode.
- Never operate the oven when it is empty. This can cause damage to the appliance.
- Only use microwave-safe cookware. Metal or foil can cause arcing and fire.
- Supervise children closely when the microwave is in use. Activate the Baby Protection Closure feature for added safety.
- Do not attempt to service or repair the appliance yourself. Contact qualified service personnel.

## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

#### 3.1 Unpacking

- Do not place the oven near heat sources such as stoves or radiators, or in damp areas.

- Ensure your household voltage matches the rating label on the back of the oven.
- Plug the power cord into a properly grounded electrical outlet. Do not use extension cords or adapters.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

## 4.1 Basic Operation

- 1. Place food in a microwave-safe container inside the oven.
- 2. Close the oven door securely.
- 3. Use the control panel to select the desired cooking time and power level.
- 4. Press the 'Start' button to begin cooking.

#### 4.2 Electronic Stopwatch

The electronic stopwatch allows for precise timing. Refer to the control panel for specific button labels, typically a 'Timer' or 'Clock' button. Press the button, enter the desired time using the number pad, and confirm.

### 4.3 Time-Melting Feature (Defrost by Time)

This feature allows you to defrost food for a specified duration.

#### 4.5 Baby Protection Closure (Child Lock)

To activate the child lock, typically press and hold a specific button (e.g., 'Stop' or 'Cancel') for a few seconds until an indicator appears on the display. To deactivate, repeat the process.

#### 4.6 Quick Start Feature

The Quick Start feature allows for rapid cooking at full power. Press the 'Quick Start' button (often labeled 'Start' or a dedicated quick cook button) to add a predetermined amount of cooking time (e.g., 30 seconds or 1 minute) with each press.

## 5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning helps maintain the performance and longevity of your microwave oven.

- Exterior: Wipe the exterior surface with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- Interior: Clean the interior cavity immediately after use to prevent food spills from drying. Use a damp cloth with mild detergent. For stubborn stains, place a bowl of water with lemon juice inside and heat for a few minutes to loosen residue.
- **Door Seals:** Keep the door seals clean to ensure proper closure and efficient operation.
- Stainless Steel Bowl: The included stainless steel bowl can be washed with warm, soapy water. Ensure it is completely dry before placing it back in the oven.
- Always unplug the microwave oven before cleaning.

### 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your ELBA Microwave Oven, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Oven does not start	Power cord unplugged; Door not closed properly; Child lock activated.	Check power connection; Ensure door is fully latched; Deactivate child lock.
Food not heating	Incorrect cooking time/power setting; Microwave-safe cookware not used.	Adjust settings; Use appropriate cookware.
Unusual noise during operation	Turntable not correctly positioned; Debris under turntable.	Re-position turntable; Clean any debris.
Light bulb not working	Bulb needs replacement.	Contact qualified service personnel for bulb replacement.
