INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the safe and efficient use of your Itari M832 Portable Thermal Printer. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating the device and retain it for future reference.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Itari M832 is a compact, inkless thermal printer designed for portability and convenience. It supports various paper sizes, including 8.5" x 11" Letter and A4, and offers wireless connectivity via Bluetooth, as well as USB connection for computers.

DEVICE COMPONENTS

Familiarize yourself with the key components of your Itari M832 printer:

- **Power Button:** Used to turn the printer on/off.
- **Power Indicator:** Displays the printer's power status.
- **Push Button:** Releases the top cover for paper loading.
- **Exit Slot:** Where printed documents emerge.
- **USB-C Charging Port:** For charging the device and connecting to computers.
- **Reset Button:** For factory reset or troubleshooting (use a pin to press).

SETUP

1. Charging the Printer

Before first use, fully charge the printer using the provided USB-C cable and a compatible power adapter (not included). The power indicator will show charging status.

2. Loading Thermal Paper

1. Press the push button to open the top cover.
2. Insert the thermal paper roll or flat thermal paper into the paper compartment. Ensure the printing side faces upwards.
3. Adjust the paper roll stopper (if using roll paper) to secure the paper in place according to its width. The printer supports widths of 2.08" (53mm), 3.14" (80mm), 4.33" (110mm), A4, and 8.5" x 11" US Letter.
4. Close the top cover firmly until it clicks into place.

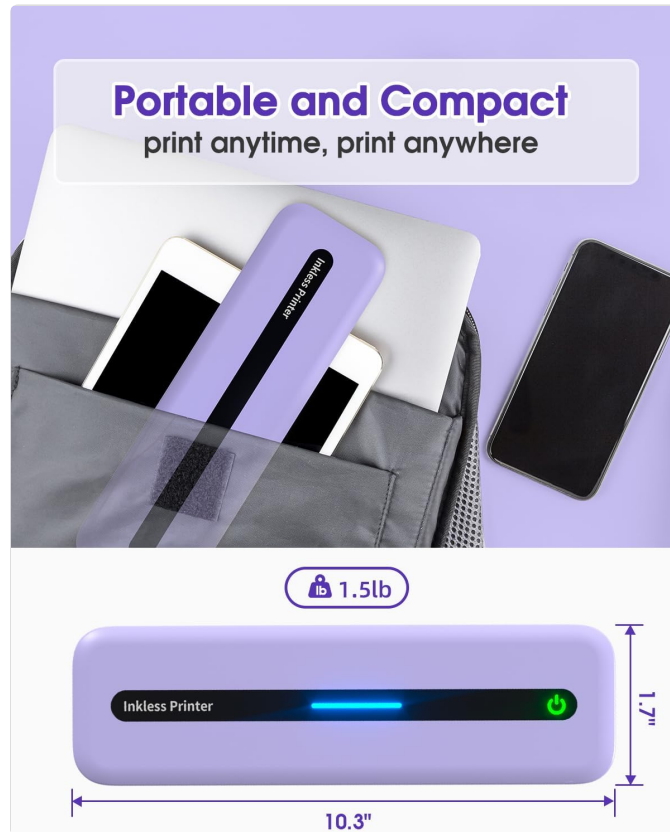


Image: The Itari M832 printer with its top cover open, illustrating how to load thermal paper and adjust the internal baffle for different paper sizes.

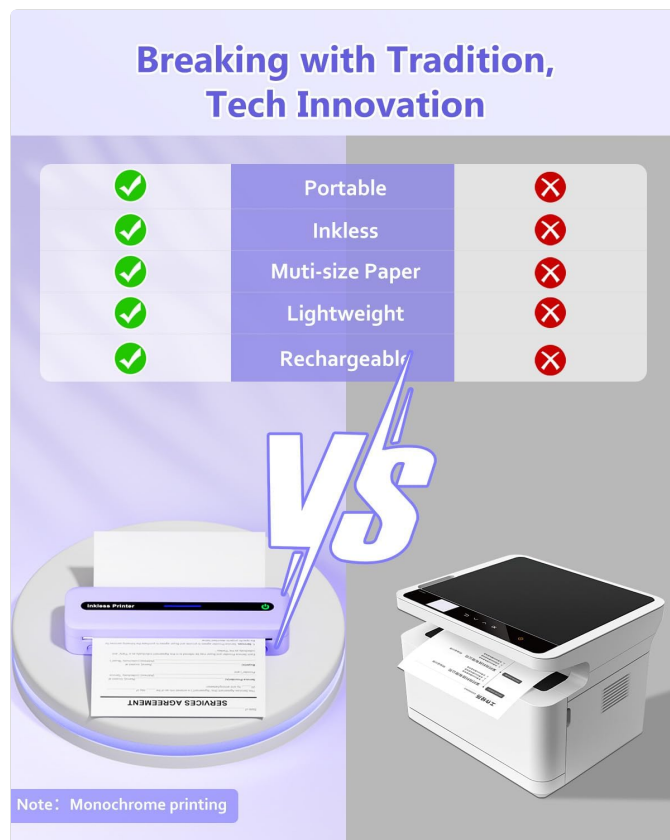


Image: The Itari M832 printer showcasing its compatibility with flat paper, continuous paper, and roll paper, highlighting its flexible paper handling capabilities.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Powering On/Off

Press and hold the Power Button for approximately 3 seconds to turn the printer on or off. The power indicator will illuminate when the printer is on.

2. Connecting to a Mobile Device (Bluetooth)

1. Ensure the printer is powered on.
2. Download the "Phomemo" app from your device's app store (available for iOS and Android).
3. Enable Bluetooth on your mobile device.
4. Open the "Phomemo" app, search for the M832 printer, and connect.
5. Within the app, select the desired document or image to print and choose the correct paper type/size.
6. Initiate printing from the app.

3. Connecting to a Computer (USB)

1. Ensure the printer is powered on.
2. Connect the printer to your computer using the provided USB-C cable.
3. Visit the Itari website (itaricartridge.com/pages/download-center) to download and install the appropriate printer driver for your operating system (Windows 10/11, macOS, Linux).
4. Once the driver is installed, select the M832 printer from your computer's print dialogue.

5. Initiate printing from your computer.

4. Printing Quality

The Itari M832 printer offers a 300dpi resolution for clear and sharp monochrome prints. Adjust print settings within the app or driver for optimal results.

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning the Print Head

To maintain print quality, regularly clean the print head. Use a soft, lint-free cloth lightly dampened with isopropyl alcohol. Gently wipe the print head surface. Ensure the printer is off and completely dry before use.

2. Battery Care

The printer is equipped with a 2600mAh Lithium Polymer battery. For optimal battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently and store the printer in a cool, dry place when not in use for extended periods.

3. Paper Storage

Store thermal paper in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and heat to prevent discoloration and degradation of print quality.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Printer does not turn on.	Low battery or power issue.	Charge the printer using the USB-C cable. Ensure the power button is held for 3 seconds.
Cannot connect via Bluetooth.	Bluetooth is off, incorrect printer selected, or app issue.	Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your device. Select the correct M832 printer in the Phomemo app. Restart the app or printer.
Poor print quality (faint/blurry).	Print head dirty, incorrect paper type, or low print density setting.	Clean the print head. Ensure you are using thermal paper. Adjust print density settings in the app/driver to "Heavy" or "Medium".
Paper jam.	Improper paper loading or foreign object.	Turn off the printer, open the cover, and carefully remove any jammed paper. Reload paper correctly.
Printer not recognized by computer.	Missing or incorrect driver installation.	Verify driver installation from itaricartridge.com . Reinstall if necessary. Ensure USB cable is securely connected.



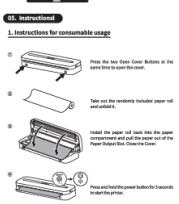
