1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the Emphsism Air Fryer Model KDF-562DW-4. This appliance uses rapid hot air circulation technology to cook your favorite foods with little to no oil, resulting in healthier meals. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure safe and optimal operation.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Always place the air fryer on a stable, heat-resistant surface, away from walls or other appliances to allow for proper ventilation.
- Do not immerse the appliance, cord, or plug in water or any other liquid.
- Ensure the voltage indicated on the appliance corresponds to your local mains voltage before connecting.
- Keep all ingredients in the basket to prevent contact with heating elements.
- Do not cover the air inlet and air outlet openings while the appliance is operating.
- Do not fill the basket with oil or other liquids, as this may cause a fire hazard.
- Always unplug the appliance after use and before cleaning. Allow it to cool down completely before handling.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure they do not play with the appliance.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Emphsism Air Fryer KDF-562DW-4 features a 7-liter capacity, a visible cooking window, and an intuitive LED touch screen for easy operation. It utilizes 360° hot air circulation for efficient and even cooking.

Components:

- Main Unit with Heating Element and Fan
- Control Panel (LED Touch Screen)
- Removable Frying Basket with Handle
- Visible Cooking Window
- Air Inlet and Air Outlet

4. SETUP AND FIRST USE

1. **Unpacking:** Remove all packaging materials and stickers from the appliance.

2. **Cleaning:** Wash the frying basket and any removable accessories with hot water, dish soap, and a non-abrasive sponge. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely. Wipe the inside and outside of the main unit with a damp cloth.
3. **Placement:** Place the air fryer on a stable, level, and heat-resistant surface. Ensure there is at least 10 cm (4 inches) of free space around the back and sides, and above the appliance for proper air circulation.
4. **First Run (Optional):** For the first use, it is recommended to run the air fryer empty for about 10-15 minutes at 180°C (350°F) to eliminate any manufacturing odors. A slight smell or smoke may occur, which is normal. Ensure good ventilation during this process.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Control Panel Overview

The LED touch screen allows you to easily select preset programs, adjust temperature, and set cooking time. The display shows current temperature and remaining time.

5.2. Basic Operation

1. **Plug In:** Connect the power cord to a grounded electrical outlet.
2. **Prepare Food:** Place ingredients into the frying basket. Do not overfill the basket to ensure even cooking.
3. **Insert Basket:** Slide the frying basket back into the air fryer until it clicks securely into place.
4. **Power On:** Press the power button (**red icon**) to turn on the appliance.
5. **Select Program or Manual Settings:**
 - **Preset Programs:** Choose one of the 10 preset cooking programs by tapping the corresponding icon. The appliance will automatically set the recommended time and temperature.
 - **Manual Settings:** Use the temperature (**+/- °C**) and time (**+/- min**) buttons to adjust settings manually. The temperature range is 50°C to 200°C, and the timer range is up to 60 minutes.
6. **Preheating (Recommended):** The air fryer features a preheating function. Press the preheat button (if available, or manually set temperature and time for 3-5 minutes) to ensure optimal cooking results and crispier food.

7. **Start Cooking:** Press the start/pause button (**play/pause icon**) to begin the cooking process.
8. **Monitor Cooking:** Use the visible cooking window and internal light to monitor food without opening the basket, which helps prevent heat loss.

9. **Shake Basket:** For even cooking, some recipes require shaking the basket halfway through the cooking time. The appliance features an automatic shut-off when the basket is removed. Reinsert the basket correctly to resume cooking.

10. **Finish Cooking:** The air fryer will beep when the cooking time is complete. Carefully pull out the basket and remove the food.
11. **Power Off:** Press the power button to turn off the appliance. Unplug from the wall socket.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning of your air fryer will ensure optimal performance and extend its lifespan.

1. **Before Cleaning:** Always unplug the air fryer and allow it to cool down completely before cleaning.
2. **Basket and Pan:** The frying basket and pan are non-stick coated and can be washed with hot water, dish soap, and a non-abrasive sponge. They are also dishwasher safe.
3. **Inside the Appliance:** Wipe the inside of the appliance with a damp cloth. For stubborn food residues, use a mild

detergent. Avoid abrasive cleaners or metal scouring pads.

4. **Heating Element:** Clean the heating element with a cleaning brush to remove any food residues.
5. **Exterior:** Wipe the exterior with a damp cloth.
6. **Drying:** Ensure all parts are completely dry before storing or using again.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Air fryer does not turn on.	Appliance is not plugged in.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a grounded outlet.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Food is not cooked evenly.	Basket is overfilled; food not shaken.	Do not overfill the basket. Shake the basket halfway through cooking.
White smoke coming from the appliance.	Fat residue from previous use; oily ingredients.	Clean the basket and pan thoroughly after each use. For oily foods, excess oil may drip into the pan.
Food is not crispy.	Not enough oil (if applicable); temperature too low; cooking time too short.	Lightly brush or spray oil on ingredients. Increase temperature or cooking time. Ensure preheating is used.
Appliance stops during operation.	Basket removed; automatic shut-off activated.	Reinsert the basket correctly. The appliance has an automatic shut-off feature for safety.
