1. Introduction

The Luque 5G 4G Mobile Hotspot is a portable wireless router designed to provide high-speed internet access on the go. It supports multiple frequency bands, allowing connectivity in various regions, and can share its internet connection with up to 10 users simultaneously. This manual will guide you through the setup, operation, and maintenance of your device to ensure optimal performance.

2. Safety Information

- Do not expose the device to extreme temperatures, direct sunlight, or moisture.
- Use only the provided USB cable and a compatible power adapter for charging.
- · Avoid dropping or subjecting the device to strong impacts.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the device yourself. Contact customer support for assistance.
- Keep the device out of reach of children.

4. Device Overview

Familiarize yourself with the physical components of your Luqueg Mobile Hotspot.

- Front Display: Shows signal strength, battery level, Wi-Fi status, message notifications, current time, and data usage.
- Power Button: Typically located on the side, used to power the device on/off and wake/sleep the screen.
- USB-C Port: Located at the bottom, used for charging the device.

5. Setup

5.1 Battery Installation

- 1. Carefully remove the back cover of the device.
- 2. Insert the provided 3000 mAh lithium battery into the battery compartment, ensuring the contacts align correctly.
- 3. Replace the back cover until it clicks securely into place.

5.2 SIM Card Installation

The device supports a single SIM card. Ensure the device is powered off before inserting or removing the SIM card.

- 1. Locate the SIM card slot, usually found under the battery or on the side of the device.
- 2. Insert your activated SIM card into the slot with the gold contacts facing down and the notched corner aligned as indicated on the device.
- 3. Gently push the SIM card until it locks into place.

5.3 Storage Card Installation (Optional)

The device supports a storage card up to 34GB (SD card not included).

- 1. Locate the storage card slot, typically adjacent to the SIM card slot.
- 2. Insert the storage card into the slot until it clicks into place.

5.4 Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge the device.

- 1. Connect the provided USB cable to the device's USB-C port.
- 2. Connect the other end of the USB cable to a compatible USB power adapter or a computer's USB port.
- 3. The battery indicator on the display will show charging status. Disconnect once fully charged.

6. Operating Instructions

6.1 Powering On/Off

- To Power On: Press and hold the Power button for a few seconds until the display lights up.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button until a power-off option appears on the screen (if applicable), then confirm. Alternatively, continue holding until the device shuts down.

6.2 Connecting to the Hotspot

Once powered on and a valid SIM card is inserted, the hotspot will attempt to connect to the mobile network. The Wi-Fi network name (SSID) and password will be displayed on the device screen or on a label inside the battery compartment.

- 1. On your Wi-Fi enabled device (smartphone, laptop, tablet), open the Wi-Fi settings.
- 2. Scan for available networks and select the SSID corresponding to your Luqueg Mobile Hotspot.
- 3. Enter the Wi-Fi password when prompted.
- 4. Your device should now be connected to the internet via the hotspot.

6.3 Understanding the Display

The device's screen provides real-time information:

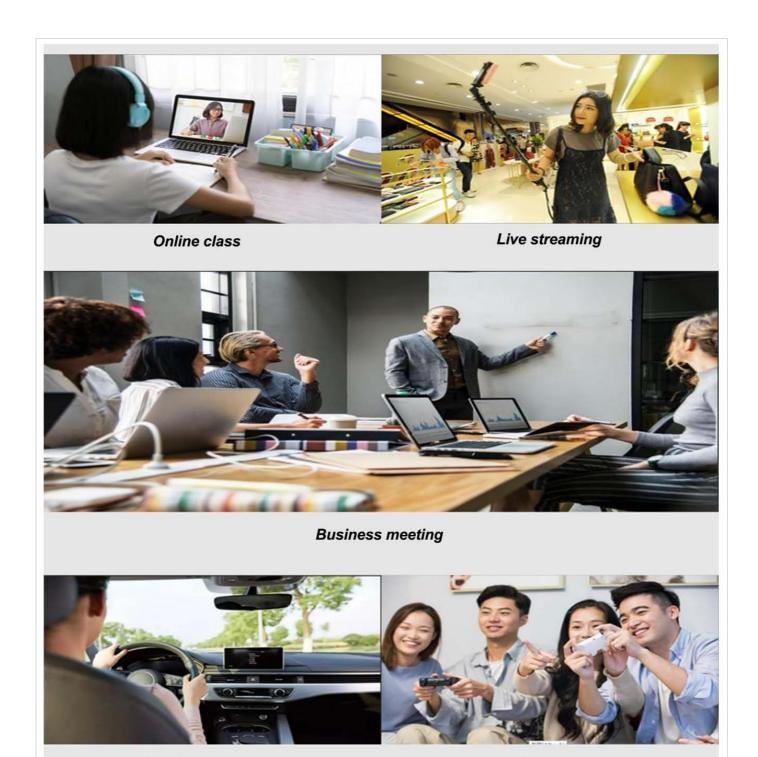
- Signal Strength: Bars indicating the strength of the 4G/5G mobile network connection.
- Battery Level: Icon showing the remaining battery charge.
- Wi-Fi Status: Indicates if Wi-Fi is active and if devices are connected.
- Message Icon: Notifies of new SMS messages (if supported by your SIM card).
- Data Usage: Displays current data consumption.
- Connected Users: Shows the number of devices currently connected to the hotspot (supports up to 10 users).

7. Maintenance

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the device. Avoid liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- Battery Care: To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Store the device in a cool, dry place if not used for extended periods.
- **Software Updates:** Periodically check the manufacturer's website for any available firmware updates to ensure optimal performance and security.

8. Troubleshooting

- **No Signal/Poor Signal:** Ensure the SIM card is correctly inserted and activated. Move to an area with better mobile network coverage. Restart the device.
- Cannot Connect to Wi-Fi: Verify the Wi-Fi password. Ensure the hotspot's Wi-Fi is enabled. Restart both the hotspot and the connecting device.
- Slow Internet Speed: Check your mobile network signal strength. Reduce the number of connected devices. Ensure your data plan is not exhausted or throttled.
- **Device Not Powering On:** Ensure the battery is correctly installed and charged. Connect the device to a power source and try again. If the issue persists, the battery may need replacement or contact support.
- **Display Not Working:** Try pressing the power button briefly to wake the screen. If the device is on but the screen remains blank, restart the device.
