## 1. INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the user manual for your Cubitt Power GO Waterproof Portable Speaker. This guide provides essential information on setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your device to ensure optimal performance and longevity. The Cubitt Power GO is designed for portability and durability, featuring Bluetooth connectivity, IPX7 waterproofing, and the ability to pair two speakers for a stereo audio experience.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all safety instructions carefully before using the product. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, or other hazards.

- Do not expose the speaker to extreme temperatures (hot or cold) or high humidity.
- Ensure the port cover is securely closed when near water to maintain IPX7 waterproof rating.
- Do not disassemble, repair, or modify the speaker. This will void the warranty.
- Keep the speaker away from children and pets.
- Use only the provided charging cable or a certified equivalent.
- Dispose of the speaker and its battery responsibly according to local regulations.

## 4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

---

Familiarize yourself with the various parts and controls of your Cubitt Power GO speaker.

## Controls:

- **Power Button:** Press and hold to power on/off.
- **Volume Up (+):** Short press for volume up, long press for next track.
- **Volume Down (-):** Short press for volume down, long press for previous track.
- **Play/Pause Button:** Short press to play/pause music, answer/end calls. Long press to reject calls or initiate TWS pairing.

## Ports:

- **USB-C Charging Port:** For charging the speaker.
- **Micro SD Card Slot:** For playing music directly from a Micro SD card.
- **AUX-in Port:** For wired audio connection using a 3.5mm audio cable.

## 5. SETUP

---

### 5.1 Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge your Cubitt Power GO speaker.

1. Open the protective port cover on the side of the speaker.
2. Connect the USB-C charging cable to the speaker's USB-C port and the other end to a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port.
3. The LED indicator will show charging status (e.g., red for charging, off when fully charged).
4. A full charge takes approximately 3 hours, providing up to 10 hours of playtime.

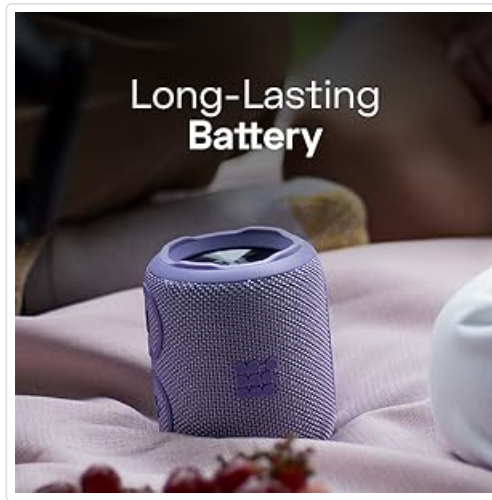


Image: A purple Cubitt Power GO speaker placed on a picnic blanket, illustrating its long-lasting battery life for outdoor use.

## 5.2 Power On/Off

- To power on, press and hold the Power button until you hear an audible prompt.
- To power off, press and hold the Power button again until you hear an audible prompt.

## 5.3 Bluetooth Pairing

1. Power on the Cubitt Power GO speaker. It will automatically enter Bluetooth pairing mode, indicated by a flashing LED.
2. On your smartphone, tablet, or other Bluetooth-enabled device, go to the Bluetooth settings.
3. Select "Cubitt Power GO" from the list of available devices.
4. Once connected, the LED indicator will become solid, and you will hear a confirmation tone.

## 5.4 True Wireless Stereo (TWS) Pairing

For an immersive stereo experience, you can pair two Cubitt Power GO speakers together.

1. Ensure both Cubitt Power GO speakers are powered on and not connected to any other Bluetooth device.
2. On one of the speakers (this will be your master speaker), press and hold the Play/Pause button for approximately 3 seconds. You will hear a tone indicating it is searching for another speaker.
3. The two speakers will automatically connect to each other. You will hear a confirmation tone once TWS pairing is successful.
4. Now, connect your master speaker to your Bluetooth device as described in section 5.3. Audio will play in stereo through both speakers.

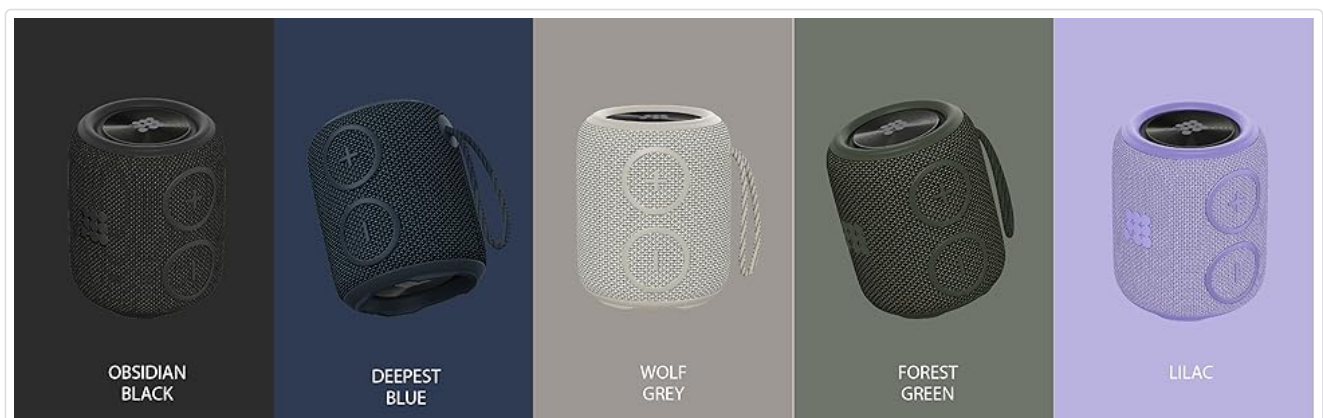


Image: Two Cubitt Power GO speakers positioned to illustrate the stereo sound experience when paired together.

## 6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 6.1 Basic Music Controls

- **Play/Pause:** Short press the Play/Pause button.
- **Volume Up:** Short press the '+' button.
- **Volume Down:** Short press the '-' button.
- **Next Track:** Long press the '+' button.
- **Previous Track:** Long press the '-' button.

### 6.2 Call Management

The built-in microphone allows for hands-free calling when connected via Bluetooth.

- **Answer/End Call:** Short press the Play/Pause button.
- **Reject Call:** Long press the Play/Pause button.

### 6.3 AUX-in Mode

Connect an external audio device using a 3.5mm audio cable (not included).

1. Open the protective port cover.
2. Connect one end of the 3.5mm audio cable to the speaker's AUX-in port and the other end to your audio device.
3. The speaker will automatically switch to AUX-in mode.
4. Control playback and volume from your connected audio device.

### 6.4 Micro SD Card Mode

Play music directly from a Micro SD card.

1. Open the protective port cover.
2. Insert a Micro SD card (with music files) into the Micro SD card slot.
3. The speaker will automatically switch to Micro SD card mode and begin playing music.
4. Use the speaker's controls for playback and volume adjustments.

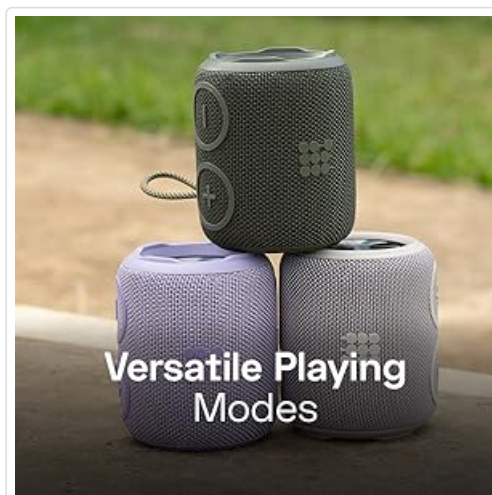


Image: Three Cubitt Power GO speakers in grey, purple, and green, illustrating the versatile playing modes available.

## 7. MAINTENANCE

---

Proper care ensures the longevity and performance of your speaker.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, damp cloth to clean the speaker's exterior. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** Store the speaker in a cool, dry place when not in use. Avoid direct sunlight or extreme temperatures.
- **Water Resistance:** Always ensure the protective port cover is firmly sealed before exposing the speaker to water to maintain its IPX7 waterproof rating.

## 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your speaker, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
Speaker does not power on.	Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the speaker to a power source using the USB-C cable.
Cannot pair via Bluetooth.	Ensure the speaker is in pairing mode (flashing LED). Turn off and on your device's Bluetooth. Make sure the speaker is within 10 meters of your device.
No sound or low volume.	Check the volume levels on both the speaker and your connected device. Ensure the correct input mode (Bluetooth, AUX, SD card) is selected.
Sound is distorted.	Move the speaker closer to your Bluetooth device. Check the audio source quality. Ensure the battery is not critically low.
TWS pairing fails.	Ensure both speakers are not connected to any other Bluetooth device. Try repeating the TWS pairing steps.
