QFX VP-110 Progressive Scan DVD/CD Player

User Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

The QFX VP-110 is a versatile digital multimedia player designed for home entertainment. It supports DVD and CD playback, features an HDMI output for high-definition video, and includes functionalities such as CD ripping to USB and an integrated FM radio tuner. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your device.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Please check the package for the following items:

- QFX VP-110 DVD/CD Player
- Remote Control (requires 2x AAA batteries, not included)
- Power Cable
- User Manual

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the main components of your QFX VP-110 player.

3.1 Front Panel and Remote Control

3.2 Rear Panel Connections

4. SETUP

Follow these steps to connect your DVD/CD player to your television and power source.

4.1 Connecting to a Television

1. **HDMI Connection (Recommended):** Connect one end of an HDMI cable (not included) to the **HD OUT** port on the rear of the player and the other end to an HDMI input on your television. Select the corresponding HDMI input on your TV.
2. **Composite Video Connection:** If your TV does not have an HDMI input, connect a composite video cable (yellow RCA) to the **VIDEO** output on the player and the corresponding video input on your TV. Connect the red and white RCA audio cables to the **R** (right) and **L** (left) audio outputs on the player and the corresponding audio inputs on your TV.

4.2 Power Connection

1. Plug the power cable into the **AC IN** port on the rear of the player.
2. Plug the other end of the power cable into a standard electrical outlet.

4.3 Remote Control Battery Installation

Open the battery compartment on the back of the remote control and insert two AAA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-). Close the compartment securely.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Disc Playback (DVD/CD)

1. Turn on your television and the QFX VP-110 player. Select the correct input source on your TV.
2. Press the **OPEN/CLOSE** button on the player or remote control to open the disc tray.
3. Place a DVD or CD disc gently onto the disc tray with the label side facing up.
4. Press the **OPEN/CLOSE** button again to close the disc tray. The player will automatically begin playback or display a disc menu.
5. Use the remote control's navigation buttons (Up, Down, Left, Right) and **ENTER** button to navigate menus. Use **PLAY/PAUSE**, **STOP**, **FF** (Fast Forward), and **REW** (Rewind) for playback control.

5.2 CD Ripping to USB

The player allows you to convert audio tracks from a CD into MP3 files and save them to a USB drive.

1. Insert an audio CD into the disc tray.
2. Insert a USB flash drive into the USB port on the front of the player.
3. During CD playback, press the **RIP** button on the remote control (if available) or navigate through the on-screen menu to find the ripping function.
4. Follow the on-screen prompts to select tracks and start the ripping process.

5.3 FM Radio Operation

1. Press the **MODE** or **FUNCTION** button on the remote control to switch to FM radio mode.
2. Use the **TUNE+** and **TUNE-** buttons to manually tune to a station, or press **SCAN** to automatically search and save available stations.
3. Adjust the volume using the **VOL+** and **VOL-** buttons.

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper care ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your player.

- **Cleaning the Unit:** Wipe the exterior of the player with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or

abrasive materials.

- **Cleaning Discs:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth to wipe discs from the center outwards. Avoid touching the playback surface.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure the player has adequate ventilation. Do not block ventilation openings.
- **Storage:** Store the player in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues, refer to the following common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power cable not connected; Power outlet faulty	Ensure power cable is securely connected. Try a different outlet.
No picture on TV	Incorrect TV input selected; Loose HDMI/AV cable	Select the correct HDMI or AV input on your TV. Check cable connections.
No sound	TV/player volume too low; Audio cables loose	Increase volume on TV and player. Check audio cable connections.
Disc not playing	Disc is dirty, scratched, or incompatible format	Clean the disc. Try a different disc. Ensure disc format is supported (DVD+/-R, DVD+/-RW, CD, CD-R, CD-RW).
Remote control not working	Batteries depleted or incorrectly inserted; Obstruction between remote and player	Replace batteries. Ensure correct polarity. Remove any obstructions.


