# Dell Inspiron 15 3535 Laptop User Manual

Your guide to setting up, operating, and maintaining your Dell Inspiron 15 3535 laptop.

## INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides essential information and instructions for the Dell Inspiron 15 3535 laptop. Please read this guide thoroughly to ensure proper use and to maximize the performance and longevity of your device. Keep this manual for future reference.

## 1. SETUP

### 1.1 Unboxing and Initial Inspection

Carefully remove your laptop and all accessories from the packaging. Inspect for any signs of damage. The package should contain:

- Dell Inspiron 15 3535 Laptop
- Power Adapter and Cable
- Documentation (this manual, warranty information)

### 1.2 Connecting the Power Adapter

1. Connect the power adapter cable to the power adapter.
2. Plug the power adapter into the power port on the side of your laptop.
3. Plug the power cable into a wall outlet.

It is recommended to fully charge the battery before initial use.

### 1.3 Initial Boot and Windows Setup

1. Open the laptop lid and press the power button located on the top-right of the keyboard.
2. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the Windows 11 Home setup. This includes selecting your region, language, connecting to a Wi-Fi network, and creating a user account.
3. Ensure your laptop is connected to the internet during setup for updates.

## 2. OPERATING YOUR LAPTOP

### 2.1 Power On/Off and Sleep Mode

- **Power On:** Press the power button.
- **Shut Down:** Click the **Start** button, then **Power**, and select **Shut down**.
- **Restart:** Click the **Start** button, then **Power**, and select **Restart**.
- **Sleep:** Close the lid or click the **Start** button, then **Power**, and select **Sleep**.

## 2.2 Using the Touch Screen

Your Dell Inspiron 15 3535 features a 15.6" FHD touch screen. You can interact with the display using gestures similar to a smartphone or tablet:

- **Tap:** Select an item.
- **Double-tap:** Open an item.
- **Swipe:** Scroll through content.
- **Pinch-to-zoom:** Zoom in or out on images and web pages.

## 2.3 Keyboard and Touchpad

The laptop includes a full-size keyboard and a precision touchpad for navigation. The touchpad supports multi-touch gestures for scrolling, zooming, and switching applications.

- **Touchpad Gestures:** Refer to Windows settings for customizable touchpad gestures.
- **Function Keys:** Use the **Fn** key in combination with the F1-F12 keys for quick access to system functions like volume, brightness, and Wi-Fi toggle.

## 2.4 Connecting Peripherals

Your laptop offers various ports for connecting external devices:

- **USB Ports:** Connect USB devices such as external drives, mice, or keyboards.
  - 1 x USB-A 2.0
  - 2 x USB-A 3.2 Gen 1
  - 1 x USB 3.2 Gen 1 Type-C
- **HDMI Port:** Connect to an external monitor or TV using an HDMI cable.
- **Headphone/Microphone Jack:** Connect headphones, speakers, or a headset.
- **SD Card Reader:** Insert an SD card for data transfer.

## 2.5 Wireless Connectivity

- **Wi-Fi:** Connect to wireless networks for internet access. Go to **Settings > Network & Internet > Wi-Fi** to manage connections.
- **Bluetooth:** Pair with Bluetooth devices like headphones, speakers, or mice. Go to **Settings > Bluetooth & devices** to manage connections.

## 3. MAINTENANCE

### 3.1 Cleaning Your Laptop

- **Screen:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth lightly dampened with water or a screen cleaner. Do not spray cleaner directly onto the screen.
- **Keyboard and Chassis:** Use a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth with mild soap solution can be used, ensuring no liquid enters openings.
- **Vents:** Use compressed air to clear dust from cooling vents to maintain optimal airflow.

## 3.2 Battery Care

- Avoid extreme temperatures.
- Do not leave the laptop plugged in constantly at 100% charge for extended periods.
- For long-term storage, charge the battery to about 50-60% and store in a cool, dry place.

## 3.3 Software Updates and Data Backup

- **Windows Updates:** Regularly check for and install Windows updates via **Settings > Windows Update** to ensure security and performance.
- **Driver Updates:** Visit the official Dell support website for the Inspiron 15 3535 to download and install the latest drivers.
- **Data Backup:** Regularly back up your important files to an external drive or cloud storage to prevent data loss.

## 4. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your Dell Inspiron 15 3535 laptop.

### 4.1 Laptop Does Not Power On

- Ensure the power adapter is securely connected to both the laptop and a working power outlet.
- Check if the power outlet is functional by plugging in another device.
- Try a different power adapter if available and compatible.
- If the battery is completely drained, it may take a few minutes of charging before the laptop can power on.

### 4.2 Display Issues

- **No Display:** Connect an external monitor to the HDMI port to check if the issue is with the laptop's internal display.
- **Dim Screen:** Adjust screen brightness using the function keys (e.g., Fn + F11/F12).
- **Touch Screen Unresponsive:** Restart the laptop. If the issue persists, check for driver updates on the Dell support website.

### 4.3 Connectivity Problems (Wi-Fi/Bluetooth)

- **Wi-Fi:**
  - Ensure Wi-Fi is enabled in Windows settings.
  - Restart your router/modem.
  - Forget the network and reconnect.
  - Update Wi-Fi drivers from the Dell support website.
- **Bluetooth:**
  - Ensure Bluetooth is enabled in Windows settings.
  - Make sure the device you are trying to pair is in pairing mode and within range.
  - Remove and re-pair the device.
  - Update Bluetooth drivers from the Dell support website.

### 4.4 Slow Performance

- Close unnecessary applications running in the background.

- Check Task Manager (Ctrl+Shift+Esc) for resource-intensive processes.
- Ensure Windows and drivers are up to date.
- Run a disk cleanup and defragmentation (for HDD, not necessary for SSD).
- Scan for malware or viruses.


