1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the tectake ISP HB TH 900W Hybrid Infrared Heater. This modern heating panel combines the benefits of both infrared and convection heating technologies, providing efficient and comfortable warmth. It is designed to heat objects and people directly, contributing to energy savings. This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your heater, including setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting.

1.1 Safety Information

Please read all safety instructions carefully before operating the device. Keep this manual for future reference.

- Ensure the heater is placed on a stable, level surface or securely mounted to a wall or ceiling.
- Do not cover the heater. This can lead to overheating.
- · Keep flammable materials at a safe distance from the heater.
- Do not operate the heater near water or in excessively damp environments.
- The heater is equipped with overheat protection, which automatically switches off the device if the internal temperature becomes too high.
- A tilt sensor is integrated, immediately deactivating the heater if it tips over.
- Always unplug the heater before cleaning or performing any maintenance.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory
 or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision
 or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS



3. SETUP

The tectake ISP HB TH heater offers flexible installation options: it can be used as a mobile unit with the included floor stand or permanently mounted on a wall or ceiling.

3.1 Floor Stand Assembly

- 1. Attach the two support legs to the main crossbar of the floor stand using the provided screws.
- 2. Align the heater with the slots on the assembled floor stand.
- 3. Carefully slide the heater onto the stand until it clicks securely into place.
- 4. Ensure the heater is stable and upright before plugging it in.

3.2 Wall or Ceiling Mounting

The heater can be mounted vertically or horizontally. Choose a suitable location away from flammable materials and ensure the mounting surface can support the heater's weight (approx. 15.9 kg).

- 1. Mark the desired drilling points on the wall or ceiling using the mounting bracket as a template.
- 2. Drill holes at the marked positions and insert the wall plugs.
- 3. Secure the mounting bracket to the wall/ceiling using the provided screws.
- 4. Carefully hang the heater onto the mounting bracket, ensuring it is securely seated.
- 5. Verify that the heater is firmly attached and level.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The tectake ISP HB TH features an integrated control unit with an LCD display and various programming options for optimal heating control.

4.1 Control Panel Overview

The control panel is located on the side of the heater and features an LCD display and several buttons for operation.

4.2 Power On/Off

- Plug the heater into a suitable electrical outlet (230V).
- Press the power button on the control panel to turn the heater on or off. The LCD display will illuminate when the heater is active.

4.3 Thermostat Control

Use the '+' and '-' buttons to set your desired room temperature. The heater will automatically maintain this temperature, switching on and off as needed.

4.4 Programming Modes

- Overheat Protection: An integrated safety feature that automatically turns off the heater if it reaches an unsafe operating temperature.
- **Tip-Over Protection:** A tilt sensor immediately deactivates the heater if it is accidentally knocked over, enhancing safety.

5. MAINTENANCE

- 2. Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or harsh

chemicals, as these can damage the finish.

- 3. Ensure no water enters the control panel or other electrical components.
- 4. Do not immerse the heater in water or spray it directly with liquids.

5.2 Storage

If storing the heater for an extended period, clean it thoroughly and store it in a dry, dust-free environment, preferably in its original packaging.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your heater, please refer to the following common problems and solutions before contacting customer support.

· Heater does not turn on:

- Check if the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet.
- Ensure the main power switch on the heater is in the 'ON' position.
- Verify that the room thermostat is set higher than the current room temperature.
- · Check if the child lock is activated.

· Heater turns off unexpectedly:

- The overheat protection may have been activated. Unplug the heater, let it cool down for 30 minutes, and ensure it is not covered or obstructed.
- The tip-over protection may have been triggered. Ensure the heater is upright and stable.
- The window mode may have detected a sudden temperature drop. Close any open windows or doors.

· Heater is not heating effectively:

- Ensure the thermostat setting is appropriate for the desired warmth.
- Check for drafts or open windows/doors that might be affecting room temperature.
- Verify that the heater is correctly positioned and not obstructed.


