Lavales Bluetooth 5.3 Car Speakerphone

1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Lavales Bluetooth 5.3 Car Speakerphone is designed to provide hands-free communication and audio streaming in your vehicle. It features Bluetooth 5.3 technology for stable connections, a motion sensor for automatic power management, and support for voice assistants like Siri and Google Assistant.

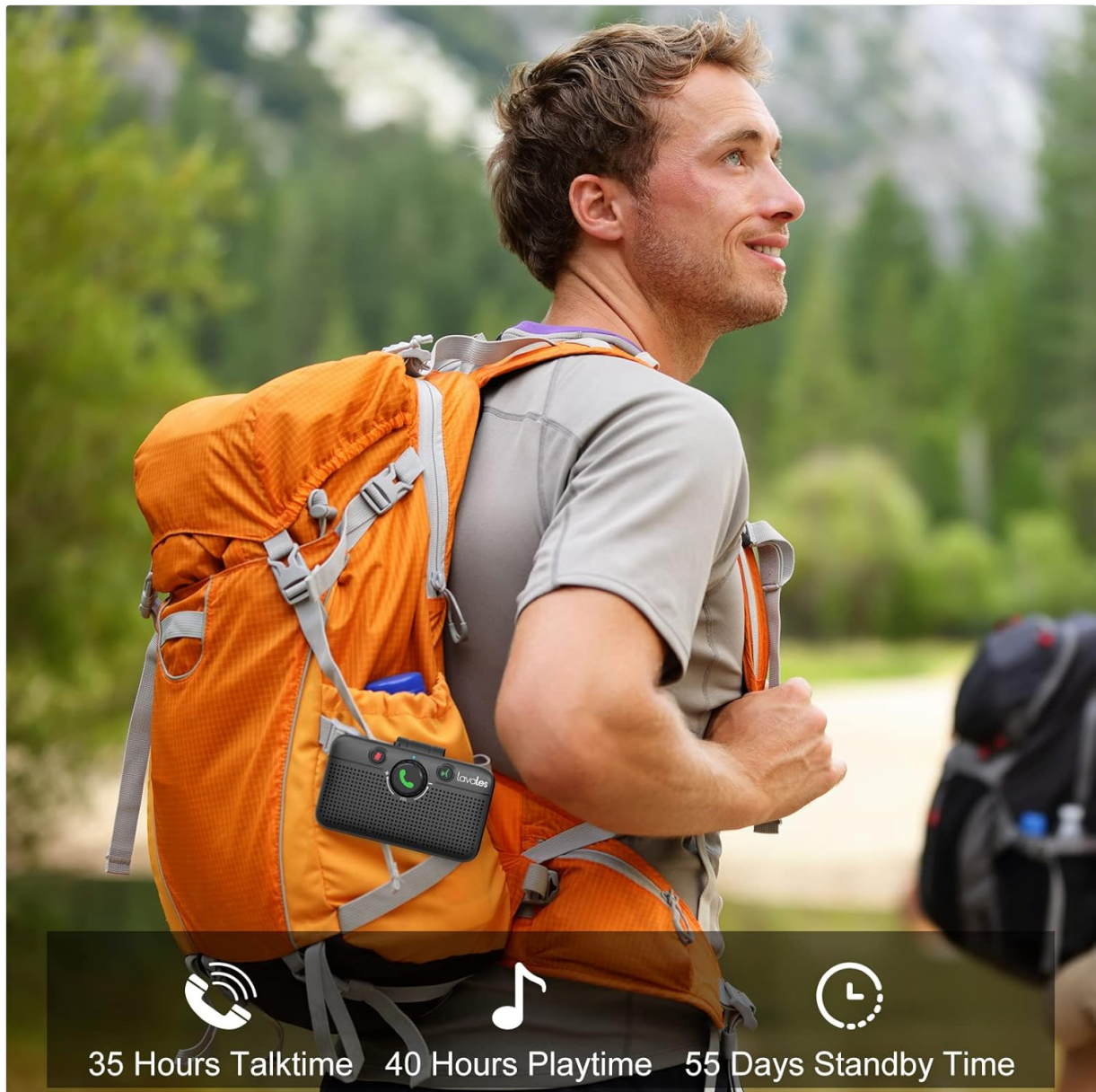


Figure 1: Lavales Bluetooth Car Speakerphone with labeled components including Siri/Google button, LED indicator, multi-function button, mute button, charging port, sun visor clip, power On/Off switch, and microphone.

2. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

2.1 Charging the Device

Before first use, fully charge the speakerphone. Connect the provided USB Type-C charging cable to the charging port on the device and to a compatible USB power source (DC 5V).

2.2 Mounting in Vehicle

The speakerphone is designed to be clipped onto your car's sun visor. Use the magnetic back clip to securely attach the device to the visor, ensuring it does not obstruct your view or interfere with driving.

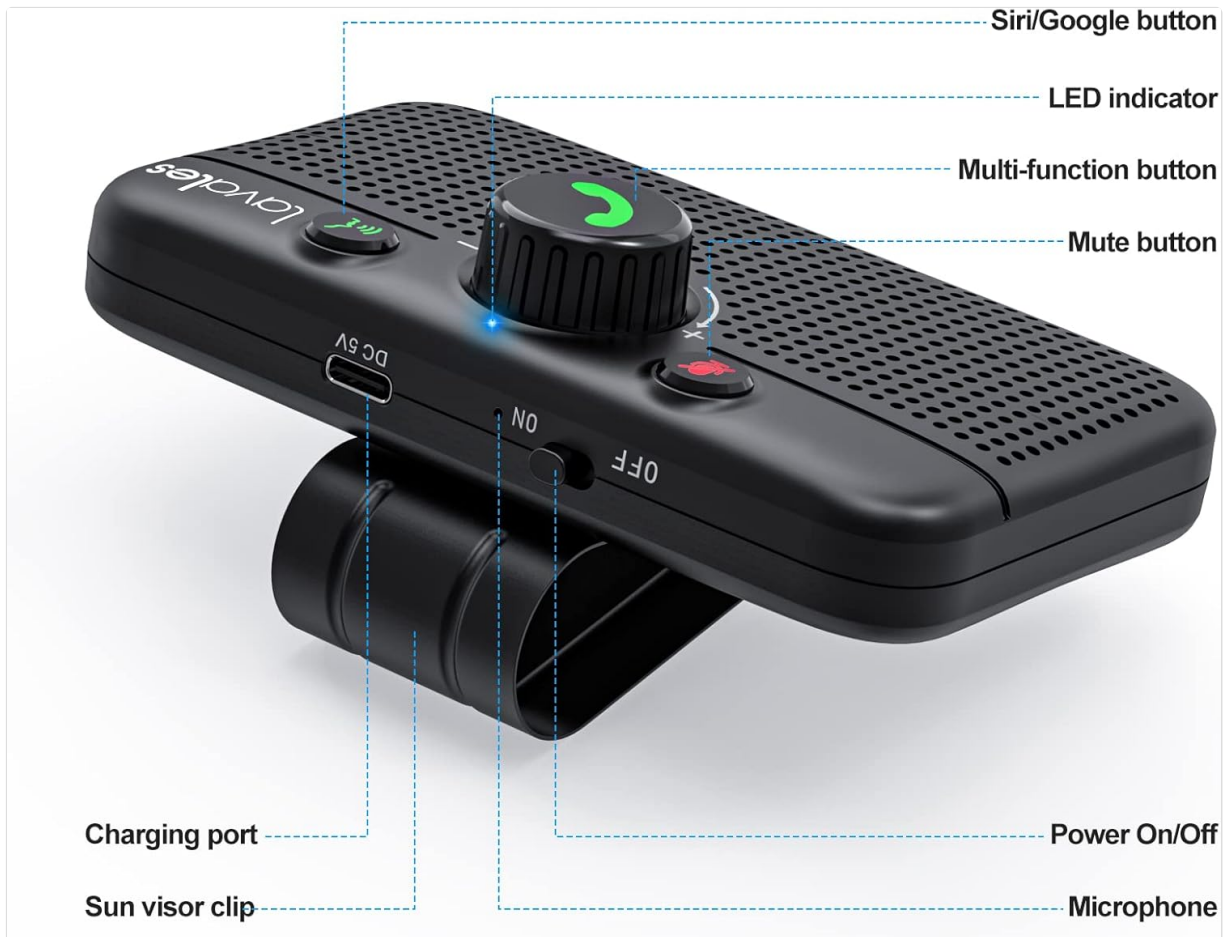


Figure 3: The speakerphone features motion detection for automatic power on when entering the car and auto-off when leaving.

2.3 Initial Bluetooth Pairing

1. Slide the Power On/Off switch to the 'ON' position. The LED indicator will flash, indicating it is in pairing mode.
2. On your mobile phone, enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
3. Select "Lavales MK02" (or similar name) from the list of devices.

4. Once connected, the LED indicator will show a steady blue light.

2.4 Connecting Two Phones

The device supports simultaneous connection to two mobile phones. After pairing the first phone, follow the pairing steps for the second phone. The speakerphone will manage calls and audio from both connected devices.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Power On/Off

- **Manual Power:** Slide the 'ON/OFF' switch to power the device on or off.
- **Auto Power:** The built-in motion sensor will automatically power on the device when you open your car door and power off when no motion is detected for a period.

3.2 Call Management

- **Answer Call:** Press the **Call Button** (green phone icon) once.
- **End Call:** Press the **Call Button** (green phone icon) once during a call.

- **Reject Call:** Press and hold the **Call Button** (green phone icon) for 2 seconds.
- **Redial Last Number:** Double-press the **Call Button** (green phone icon) when not on a call.
- **Mute Microphone:** Press the **Mute Button** (red microphone icon) during a call. Press again to unmute.

3.3 Volume Control

Rotate the **Volume Knob** (around the Call Button) clockwise to increase volume and counter-clockwise to decrease volume.

3.4 Voice Assistant Activation

Press the **Siri/Google Assistant Button** (blue voice icon) once to activate your phone's voice assistant (Siri or Google Assistant) for voice commands, navigation, or sending messages.

3.5 Music Playback

When connected via Bluetooth, audio from your phone, including music and GPS instructions, will play through the speakerphone.

- **Play/Pause:** Press the **Call Button** (green phone icon) once during music playback.

- **Next Track:** Press the **Next Track Button** (right arrow icon).
- **Previous Track:** Press the **Previous Track Button** (left arrow icon).

4. ADVANCED FEATURES

4.1 Noise Reduction and Echo Cancellation

The speakerphone incorporates CVC 8.0 Echo Cancellation and Noise Reduction technology to provide clear and loud voice quality for both the user and the caller, even in noisy environments.

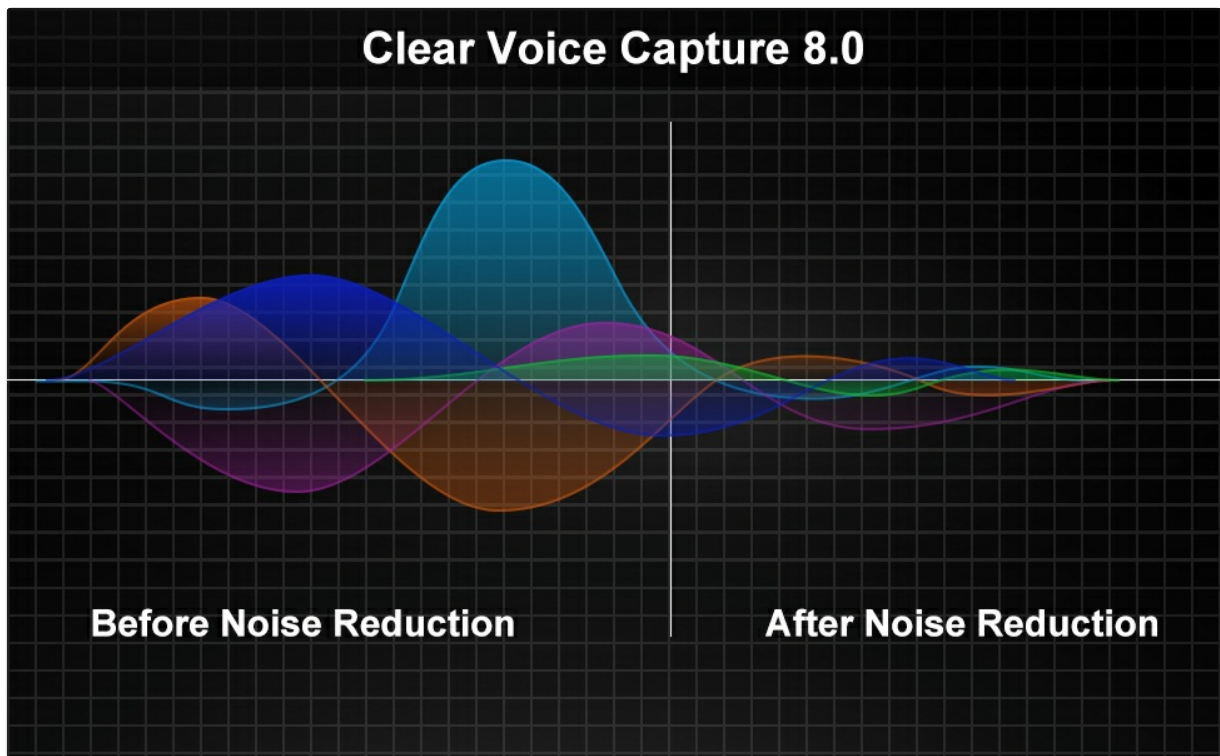


Figure 7: Illustration of Clear Voice Capture 8.0 technology, demonstrating the effect of noise reduction on audio waveforms.

4.2 Voice Guidance

The device provides intelligent voice guidance for status updates such as power on, power off, connected, pairing, battery low, and disconnected.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning

Wipe the device with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners. Avoid exposing the device to excessive moisture.

5.2 Battery Care

To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the device frequently. Charge the device regularly, especially if it will not be used for an extended period.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

6.1 Device Not Powering On

- Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the device to a power source using the USB cable.
- Check the Power On/Off switch is in the 'ON' position.

6.2 Unable to Pair with Phone

- Ensure the speakerphone is in pairing mode (LED indicator flashing).
- Make sure Bluetooth is enabled on your phone and it is discoverable.
- Move the speakerphone closer to your phone.
- Restart both the speakerphone and your phone.
- If previously paired, delete the device from your phone's Bluetooth list and attempt to pair again.

6.3 Poor Audio Quality

- Ensure the speakerphone is within range of your phone.
- Adjust the volume on both the speakerphone and your phone.
- Check for obstructions between the speakerphone and your phone.
- Ensure the microphone is not blocked during calls.
