1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Aircillin AP0801 Air Purifier. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your device. Please read it thoroughly before use and retain it for future reference.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Read all instructions before operating the appliance.
- Do not operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug.
- Keep the appliance away from water or other liquids.
- Do not block air inlets or outlets.
- Unplug the appliance before cleaning or performing any maintenance.
- This appliance is for indoor use only.
- Do not use in areas with flammable gases or vapors.
- Supervise children to ensure they do not play with the appliance.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

3.1 Package Contents

- H13 True HEPA Filter (pre-installed)
- Power Adapter

- Aroma Pads (12 included)

3.2 Components and Features

The Aircillin AP0801 Air Purifier features a multi-stage filtration system and user-friendly controls.

- **Pre-Filter:** Captures large particles such as pet fur, fibers, and lint.
- **Blue Nano Nylon Fabric Layer:** Designed to capture wildfire smoke, soot, and other suspended small particles.
- **H13 True HEPA Layer:** Removes airborne allergens, including dust, pollen, mold, mildew, fungus spores, pet dander, dust mites, and their excrement, with 99.9% efficiency for particles as small as 0.1 microns.
- **Effective Activated Carbon Layer:** Adsorbs and decomposes formaldehyde, benzene, ammonia,

volatile organic compounds, nicotine, and other pungent odors.

- **Sturdy Steel Mesh Layer:** Protects filters from crushing and maintains structural integrity.

- **Fan Speed Button:** Adjusts fan speed (I, II, III).
- **Timer Button:** Sets operation time (2H, 4H, 8H).
- **Filter Replacement Indicator:** Lights up when filter replacement is needed.
- **Turbo Button:** Activates maximum fan speed for rapid purification.
- **Display Indicator Button:** Turns the display lights on or off.
- **Power On/Off Button:** Turns the unit on or off.
- **Child Lock Button:** Locks the control panel to prevent accidental changes.

4. SETUP

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove the air purifier from its packaging.
2. **Filter Installation:**
 - Unscrew the base cover of the air purifier.

- Remove the plastic packaging from the H13 True HEPA filter.
 - Insert the filter back into the unit.
 - Securely reattach the base cover.
3. **Placement:** Place the air purifier on a flat, stable surface. Ensure there is adequate space around the unit for optimal air intake and output (360° air intake).
 4. **Power Connection:** Plug the power adapter into the air purifier and then into a standard electrical outlet.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Power On/Off

- Press the **Power On/Off** button to turn the unit on. The default fan speed will activate.
- Press the **Power On/Off** button again to turn the unit off.

5.2 Adjusting Fan Speed

- Press the **Fan Speed** button repeatedly to cycle through fan speeds: Level I (Low), Level II (Medium), Level III (High).

5.3 Turbo Boost Function

- Press the **Turbo Button** (lightning bolt icon) to immediately activate the highest fan speed for rapid air purification.
- Press it again to return to the previously selected fan speed.

5.4 Timer Function

- Press the **Timer** button repeatedly to set the operating duration to 2 hours, 4 hours, or 8 hours. The unit will automatically turn off after the selected time.
- To cancel the timer, press the **Timer** button until no timer indicator is lit.

5.5 Display Indicator (Light On/Off)

- Press the **Display Indicator** button (light bulb icon) to turn the control panel lights on or off. This is useful for undisturbed sleep.

5.6 Child Lock Function

- Press and hold the **Child Lock** button (padlock icon) for 3 seconds to activate or deactivate the child lock.
- When activated, all other buttons on the control panel will be unresponsive.

CHILD LOCK

Prevent children and pets from accidentally changing the settings.

5.7 Aromatherapy Function

- Locate the aroma pad tray on the top of the air purifier.
- Add a few drops of your preferred essential oil onto one of the provided aroma pads.
- Place the aroma pad into the tray and close it.
- The air purifier will diffuse the scent as it operates.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning the Air Purifier

- Always unplug the air purifier before cleaning.
- Wipe the exterior of the unit with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- The pre-filter can be gently vacuumed to remove larger dust and debris.

6.2 Filter Replacement

The Filter Replacement Indicator light will flash after approximately 1500 hours of operation (typically 3 to 6 months), indicating that the filter needs to be replaced.

1. Unplug the air purifier from the power outlet.
2. Unscrew the base cover of the unit.
3. Remove the old filter.

4. Insert a new Aircillin H13 True HEPA filter (ensure plastic packaging is removed).
5. Securely reattach the base cover.
6. Plug in the air purifier.
7. To reset the filter replacement indicator, press and hold the **Filter Replacement** button for 3 seconds until the light turns off.

Replacement filters can be found by searching for B0CMC8F3TV (2-pack) or B0CMCGFLXJ (4-pack).

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet malfunction; unit malfunction.	Ensure power cord is securely plugged in. Try a different outlet. Contact customer support if issue persists.
Airflow is weak.	Filter is dirty or clogged; air inlets/outlets blocked.	Check and clean/replace the filter. Ensure no obstructions around the unit.
Unusual noise.	Filter not installed correctly; foreign object inside; unit on uneven surface.	Check filter installation. Unplug and inspect for foreign objects. Place on a flat, stable surface.
Filter Replacement Indicator remains on after filter change.	Indicator not reset.	Press and hold the Filter Replacement button for 3 seconds to reset.
Control panel unresponsive.	Child Lock is active.	Press and hold the Child Lock button for 3 seconds to deactivate.
