3. SETUP

3.1 Initial Power-Up

1. Connect the AC adapter to the power port on the laptop and then to a power outlet.
2. Open the laptop lid.
3. Press the power button, typically located on the top-right of the keyboard deck.
4. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the Windows 10 Home setup.

3.2 Connecting Peripherals

- **Battery not charging:** Check the AC adapter and cable for damage. Ensure the battery is properly seated (if removable).

7.2 Display Problems

- **Blank screen:** Connect an external monitor to check if the issue is with the laptop's display. Restart the laptop.
- **Flickering screen:** Update your graphics drivers. Adjust the display refresh rate in Windows settings.

7.3 Performance Issues

- **Slow performance:** Close unnecessary applications. Check for malware. Ensure sufficient free space on the

SSD.

- **Overheating:** Ensure ventilation vents are clear. Use the laptop on a hard, flat surface.
