INTRODUCTION

The Benro SupaDupa Carbon Fiber Monopod MSD46C72 is a lightweight, professional-grade support system designed for cameras and video equipment. Constructed from carbon fiber, it offers strength and rigidity while maintaining portability. This manual provides instructions for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your monopod to ensure optimal performance and longevity.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Carefully unpack your Benro SupaDupa Monopod and verify that all components are present:

- Benro SupaDupa Carbon Fiber Monopod
- Carry Case
- Allen Key

SETUP

1. Attaching a Camera or Tripod Head

The monopod features a reversible 1/4"-20 and 3/8"-16 mounting screw for universal compatibility. To attach your camera directly or a tripod head:

1. Ensure the correct screw size is exposed for your equipment. If not, unscrew and reverse the mounting screw.
2. Carefully screw your camera or tripod head onto the mounting screw until secure.

2. Using the Leveling Base

The integrated 72mm leveling base allows for smooth adjustments and precise leveling, particularly useful for video or panoramic photography.

- To adjust the tilt, loosen the locking knob on the side of the leveling base.
- Adjust the angle as needed, then tighten the knob to secure the position.
- The quick release plate (PU58M) can be detached by loosening the large blue knob and pressing the safety release button.

3. Adjusting Tension

An Allen key is provided for minor adjustments to the quick release plate tension if needed.

OPERATING

1. Extending and Retracting Leg Sections

The monopod features 6-section carbon fiber legs with twist locks for quick height adjustment.

- To extend a section, twist the lock counter-clockwise until it loosens, pull the section to the desired length, then twist clockwise to secure.
- Repeat for all sections until the desired height is reached.
- To retract, reverse the process.

2. Using the Padded Grip

The monopod includes a padded grip for comfortable handling during extended use.

- Position your hand on the padded grip for improved comfort and secure holding.
- The grip also features a strap for added security.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and reliable performance of your monopod.

- **Cleaning:** After use, especially in dusty or sandy environments, wipe down the monopod with a soft, dry cloth. If necessary, use a slightly damp cloth and mild soap, then dry thoroughly. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Storage:** Store the monopod in its carry case in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Ensure all sections are retracted and locks are lightly tightened before storage.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all screws and connections for tightness. Do not overtighten.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Benro SupaDupa Monopod, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Leg sections not locking securely:** Ensure the twist locks are fully tightened clockwise. If the issue persists, check for any debris inside the locking mechanism.
- **Camera/head feels loose:** Verify that the mounting screw is fully tightened into your equipment. For quick release plates, ensure the plate is correctly seated in the clamp and the locking knob is secure.
- **Leveling base movement is stiff or too loose:** Adjust the tension of the leveling base locking knob.
