INTRODUCTION

The MB Trapper's Cap is an essential tool designed to enhance the efficiency and safety of setting MB 450 traps. This cap assists in firmly bedding traps, minimizing the need for pan covers, and preventing accidental firing during the setting process. It also helps keep debris from interfering with the trap's mechanism.

SETUP AND PREPARATION

Before using the MB Trapper's Cap, ensure your MB 450 trap is clean and in good working order. The cap is designed to fit precisely over the trap's pan and jaws during the bedding process.

- 1. Inspect the Trap:** Verify that the MB 450 trap is free of dirt, rust, or any obstructions that might hinder

its operation.

2. **Clear the Set Location:** Prepare the ground where the trap will be set, ensuring it is level and free of large debris.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The MB Trapper's Cap simplifies the process of bedding your trap securely and safely.

1. **Position the Trap:** Place the MB 450 trap in its desired set location.
2. **Place the Trapper's Cap:** Carefully place the MB Trapper's Cap over the trap's pan and jaws. The cap is designed to cover these components, preventing accidental firing and keeping dirt from getting under the pan.
3. **Bed the Trap:** Firmly pack dirt around the trap, ensuring it is stable and level. The cap allows you to pack dirt inside the jaws without interference.
4. **Sift Dirt:** Sift fine dirt over the trap and the cap. The cap prevents debris from falling under the trap pan.
5. **Remove the Cap:** Once the trap is firmly bedded and covered, carefully remove the MB Trapper's Cap. The trap should now be set and ready.

- **Cleaning:** After each use, wipe the cap clean of any dirt or debris. A damp cloth can be used if necessary. Ensure it is thoroughly dried before storage.
- **Storage:** Store the cap in a dry place to prevent corrosion.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the cap for any signs of damage or wear. While durable, extreme impacts could deform it.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cap does not fit over trap pan/jaws.	Incorrect trap model or debris on trap.	Ensure you are using an MB 450 trap. Clean the trap and cap thoroughly.
Trap fires accidentally when cap is removed.	Trap not properly bedded or pan tension too light.	Ensure the trap is firmly bedded and stable before removing the cap. Check and adjust pan tension if necessary.
Dirt/debris still gets under pan.	Cap not positioned correctly or excessive sifting.	Ensure the cap is fully seated over the pan and jaws. Sift dirt carefully and avoid excessive force.
