ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps carefully for quick and easy assembly. All necessary tools are included in the package.

- 1. Assemble the Base:** Connect the horizontal base bars (labeled 'C' in some diagrams) to the curved bottom pieces (labeled 'A' or 'B'). Secure with the provided screws using the screwdriver.
- 2. Attach Casters:** Screw the four casters into the designated holes at the bottom of the curved base pieces. Ensure the two lockable casters are placed on the same side for easier access.

3. **Install Vertical Rods:** Insert the vertical support rods into the base. These rods often have spring-loaded buttons that click into place.
4. **Place Mesh Shelf:** Position the mesh shelf onto the designated supports on the vertical rods. Ensure it sits securely.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- **Hanging Clothes:** Utilize the top bar for hanging clothes, dresses, coats, and other garments. The anti-slip stoppers at each end prevent hangers from sliding off.
- **Using the Mesh Shelf:** Place shoes, storage boxes, bags, or other accessories on the bottom mesh shelf to maximize storage space.
- **Moving the Rack:** Unlock the two lockable casters to move the rack smoothly across various surfaces. When the desired position is reached, lock the casters to secure the rack in place.
- **Load Capacity:** Adhere to the maximum load capacity of 82 pounds to ensure stability and prevent damage.

MAINTENANCE

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Rack is wobbly.	Screws are loose or uneven assembly.	Ensure all screws are tightened securely. Check that all parts are correctly aligned during assembly.
Casters are not rolling smoothly.	Debris caught in casters or casters are locked.	Check and clear any debris from the casters. Ensure the lockable casters are in the unlocked position.
Clothes sliding off the ends.	Hangers are not properly placed or anti-slip stoppers are missing/damaged.	Ensure hangers are fully on the bar. Verify that the anti-slip stoppers are present and intact at both ends of the hanging bar.
