#### 1. Introduction

The Pyle PDA63BT is a compact wireless Bluetooth stereo amplifier designed to deliver high-quality audio for home theater and karaoke applications. It features a 200-watt max power output (20W x 2 RMS at 8 Ohm), Bluetooth streaming with a 40+ ft range, dual 1/4-inch microphone inputs, and various audio inputs including RCA, USB, and SD card readers. This manual provides detailed instructions for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your PDA63BT amplifier.

# 2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read and follow these safety guidelines carefully before operating the Pyle PDA63BT amplifier to ensure safe and optimal performance.

- Power Source: Ensure the amplifier is connected to a power supply that matches the voltage specified on the unit.
- Ventilation: Do not block any ventilation openings. Maintain adequate space around the unit for proper airflow to prevent overheating.
- Water and Moisture: Do not expose the unit to rain, moisture, or excessive humidity. Keep liquids away from the amplifier.
- **Heat Sources:** Avoid placing the unit near heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other heat-producing appliances.
- Cleaning: Disconnect the power cord before cleaning. Use a dry cloth for cleaning. Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosol cleaners.
- Servicing: Do not attempt to service this product yourself. Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel.
- Fire and Smoke Safety: The unit incorporates fire and smoke safety protection features. However, always operate in a well-ventilated area and avoid covering the unit.

# 4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

#### **4.1 Front Panel Controls**

The front panel provides access to all primary controls and inputs for the amplifier.

- Power Button: Turns the unit on or off.
- Mode Button: Selects input source (Bluetooth, USB/SD, FM, AUX).
- Media Controls: Play/Pause, Previous, Next for USB/SD playback.
- **Digital LCD Display:** Shows current mode, track information, and FM frequency.
- USB Reader: For connecting USB flash drives.
- SD/MMC Reader: For connecting SD memory cards.
- Remote Sensor: Receives signals from the remote control.
- MIC/VOL: Master microphone volume control.
- MIC 1 / MIC 2 Inputs: 1/4-inch inputs for microphones.
- Reverb Control: Adjusts the reverb effect for microphones.
- **Delay Control:** Adjusts the delay effect for microphones.

- Bass Control: Adjusts the low-frequency audio output.
- Treble Control: Adjusts the high-frequency audio output.
- Balance Control: Adjusts the left/right channel balance.
- Volume Control: Master volume for all audio output.
- **Headphone Input:** 1/4-inch output for headphones.
- **HP VOL:** Headphone volume control.

#### 4.2 Rear Panel Connections

The rear panel houses all the necessary connections for external audio devices and speakers.




Image: Rear panel of the PDA63BT amplifier, showing connections for speakers, audio inputs/outputs, FM antenna, and power.

- FM Antenna: Connection for the included FM antenna.
- Audio Input (CD/DVD, AUX): RCA (L/R) inputs for connecting external audio sources like CD/DVD players or other auxiliary devices.

- Audio Output (Line Out): RCA (L/R) outputs for connecting to another amplifier or recording device.
- Speaker Output (Main Speakers 4-16 $\Omega$ ): Screw terminals for connecting passive speakers.
- Voltage Selector: Switch to select between 110V and 220V power (ensure correct setting for your region).
- AC Power Input: For connecting the power cord.

# 5. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to set up your Pyle PDA63BT amplifier.

# **5.1 Connecting Speakers**

- 1. Ensure the amplifier is powered off and unplugged.
- 2. Connect your passive speakers to the **Speaker Output (Main Speakers 4-16\Omega)** terminals on the rear panel. Match the positive (+) terminal of the amplifier to the positive (+) terminal of the speaker, and the negative (-) to the negative (-).
- 3. Ensure all speaker wires are securely fastened and no stray strands are touching each other or the amplifier chassis.

# **5.2 Connecting Audio Sources**

- RCA (CD/DVD, AUX) Input: Connect your CD player, DVD player, or other audio devices using RCA cables
  to the corresponding Audio Input (CD/DVD, AUX) ports on the rear panel. Match red to right (R) and white to
  left (L).
- 2. **USB/SD Card:** Insert a USB flash drive or SD card into the respective slots on the front panel.

# **5.3 Connecting Microphones**

1. Plug your 1/4-inch microphone cables into the MIC 1 or MIC 2 inputs on the front panel.

# 5.4 Connecting FM Antenna

1. Connect the included FM antenna to the **FM Antenna** terminal on the rear panel. Extend the antenna for better reception.

#### **5.5 Power Connection**

- 1. Before plugging in, ensure the **Voltage Selector** on the rear panel is set to the correct voltage for your region (110V or 220V).
- 2. Connect the power cord to the AC Power Input on the rear panel, then plug it into a wall outlet.

# 6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

#### 6.1 Power On/Off

Press the **Power Button** on the front panel to turn the amplifier on or off. The LCD display will illuminate when the unit is powered on.

#### **6.2 Source Selection**

Press the **Mode Button** on the front panel or the remote control to cycle through the available input sources: Bluetooth, USB/SD, FM Radio, and AUX/RCA.

# 6.3 Bluetooth Pairing

- 1. Select **Bluetooth** mode using the Mode button. The LCD display will show "Bluetooth Connected" or "Bluetooth Pairing".
- 2. On your Bluetooth-enabled device (smartphone, tablet, laptop), search for available Bluetooth devices.
- 3. Select "Pyle Audio" or a similar name from the list.
- 4. Once connected, the amplifier will indicate a successful pairing, and you can stream audio wirelessly. The wireless range is approximately 40+ feet.

# 6.4 USB/SD Card Playback

- 1. Insert a USB flash drive or SD card into the corresponding slot on the front panel.
- 2. The amplifier will automatically switch to USB/SD mode and begin playing audio files. If not, select USB/SD mode using the Mode button.
- 3. Use the Media Controls (Play/Pause, Previous, Next) on the front panel or remote to manage playback.

# 6.5 FM Radio Operation

- 1. Select **FM** mode using the Mode button.
- 2. Press the Play/Pause button (or a dedicated scan button on the remote) to initiate an auto-scan for available FM stations. The amplifier can store up to 60 presets.
- 3. Use the Previous/Next buttons to navigate through saved stations or manually tune.

# 6.6 Microphone Usage

1. Connect microphones to the MIC 1 or MIC 2 inputs.

- 2. Adjust the overall microphone volume using the MIC/VOL knob.
- 3. Use the **Reverb** and **Delay** knobs to add effects to the microphone audio.

# 6.7 Tone and Volume Controls

- Volume Control: Adjust the master volume for all audio output using the large rotary knob.
- Bass/Treble Controls: Use the Bass and Treble knobs to fine-tune the low and high frequencies of your audio.
- Balance Control: Adjust the audio balance between the left and right speakers.
- Headphone Output: Connect headphones to the Headphone Input and adjust their volume using the HP VOL knob.

#### 7. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and performance of your amplifier.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the unit. Do not use abrasive cleaners, waxes, or solvents.
- Ventilation: Regularly check that the ventilation openings are clear of dust and debris.
- **Storage:** If storing the unit for an extended period, unplug it from the power outlet and store it in a cool, dry place.

# 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Pyle PDA63BT, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power cord not connected; Power outlet faulty; Voltage selector incorrect.	Check power cord connection; Try a different outlet; Verify voltage selector setting.
No sound output	Incorrect input source selected; Volume too low; Speaker connections loose; Mute activated.	Select correct input source; Increase master volume; Check speaker wiring; Ensure unit is not muted.
Bluetooth not connecting	Amplifier not in Bluetooth mode; Device too far; Device already connected to another unit.	Ensure amplifier is in Bluetooth mode; Move device closer; Disconnect from other Bluetooth devices.
Poor FM reception	Antenna not connected or extended; Weak signal.	Connect and fully extend the FM antenna; Reposition the antenna for better signal.
Microphone not working	Microphone not plugged in; MIC/VOL knob too low.	Ensure microphone is securely plugged into MIC 1 or MIC 2; Increase MIC/VOL.






