INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the PayLessHere 54-inch Multi-Level Cat Tree. This manual provides detailed instructions for assembly, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting to ensure safe and proper use of your new cat furniture. Please read this manual thoroughly before assembly and retain it for future reference.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Ensure all parts are securely fastened before allowing pets to use the cat tree.
- Place the cat tree on a flat, stable surface to prevent tipping.
- Regularly inspect the cat tree for loose parts, damage, or wear. Tighten screws and replace damaged components as needed.
- Keep small children away from the cat tree during assembly and ensure they do not climb on it.
- This product is designed for indoor cat use only.
- Do not allow cats to chew on non-sisal components, as this may cause damage or ingestion of materials.

PARTS LIST

Before beginning assembly, verify that all components listed below are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, please contact customer support.

- Support posts (various lengths, some wrapped with sisal rope)

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly typically requires one person and approximately 30-60 minutes. An Allen wrench is usually included. Follow these steps carefully:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging. Lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches.
2. **Identify Base:** Locate the largest, heaviest board, which will serve as the base of the cat tree.
3. **Attach First Level Posts:** Secure the shortest support posts to the base using the provided screws and Allen wrench. Ensure they are tightened firmly.
4. **Install Lower Platforms/Condos:** Attach the first set of platforms or the lower cat condo(s) to the posts. Pay attention to the orientation of the condo openings.
5. **Add Ladder (if applicable):** If your model includes a ladder, attach it between the base and a lower platform as indicated in the diagram.

- Continue Building Upwards:** Progressively attach more support posts and platforms/condos, working your way up. Refer to the product images for the correct arrangement of levels and components.

7. **Attach Sisal Scratching Posts:** Ensure that posts wrapped with sisal rope are placed in accessible areas for your cat to scratch.

8. **Install Top Perches:** Attach the highest platforms or perches. These often include a raised rim for comfort.
9. **Add Hanging Toys:** Secure any hanging furry balls or toys to designated points on the cat tree.
10. **Final Check:** Once assembled, gently shake the cat tree to ensure stability. Retighten any loose screws.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The PayLessHere Cat Tree is designed to provide a stimulating and comfortable environment for your indoor cats. No complex operation is required; simply place it in a suitable location and allow your cats to explore.

- **Placement:** Position the cat tree in a quiet corner, near a window, or in a common area where your cat enjoys spending time. Ensure it is away from high-traffic zones to prevent accidental bumps.
- **Encouraging Use:** Introduce your cat to the tree by placing treats, catnip, or their favorite toys on different levels. Gently guide them to the scratching posts.
- **Multi-Level Exploration:** The various platforms, condos, and perches offer opportunities for climbing, resting, and observing. Cats can utilize the sisal posts for scratching to maintain claw health.

- **Safety:** Always ensure the tree remains stable. If it wobbles, check and tighten all connections.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will extend the life of your cat tree and ensure a hygienic environment for your pet.

- **Cleaning:**
 - Spot clean soiled areas with a damp cloth and mild, pet-safe detergent. Avoid saturating the fabric.
 - For general cleaning, use a lint roller or vacuum cleaner with a brush attachment to remove pet hair and dust.
 - The manufacturer recommends "Hand Wash Only" for specific components if they are removable, though the entire structure is generally spot-cleaned.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all screws and bolts for tightness. Retighten as necessary to maintain stability.
- **Sisal Rope:** The sisal scratching posts are designed to withstand scratching. If the rope becomes excessively frayed or detached, consider wrapping it with new sisal rope or replacing the post if possible.
- **Damage:** If any structural components (platforms, posts) become damaged, discontinue use and contact customer

support for replacement parts or advice.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cat tree wobbles	Loose screws; uneven floor; incorrect assembly	Check and tighten all screws. Ensure the tree is on a flat, level surface. Review assembly steps.
Cat not using scratching posts	Prefers other surfaces; unfamiliar with sisal	Sprinkle catnip on posts. Gently guide paws to demonstrate scratching. Reward use.
Cat not using condos/perches	Shy; prefers other resting spots; too small/large	Place favorite blankets or toys inside. Ensure the size is appropriate for your cat. Allow time for adjustment.
Hanging toy detached	Excessive play; worn attachment point	Reattach securely if possible. If damaged, remove to prevent choking hazard.

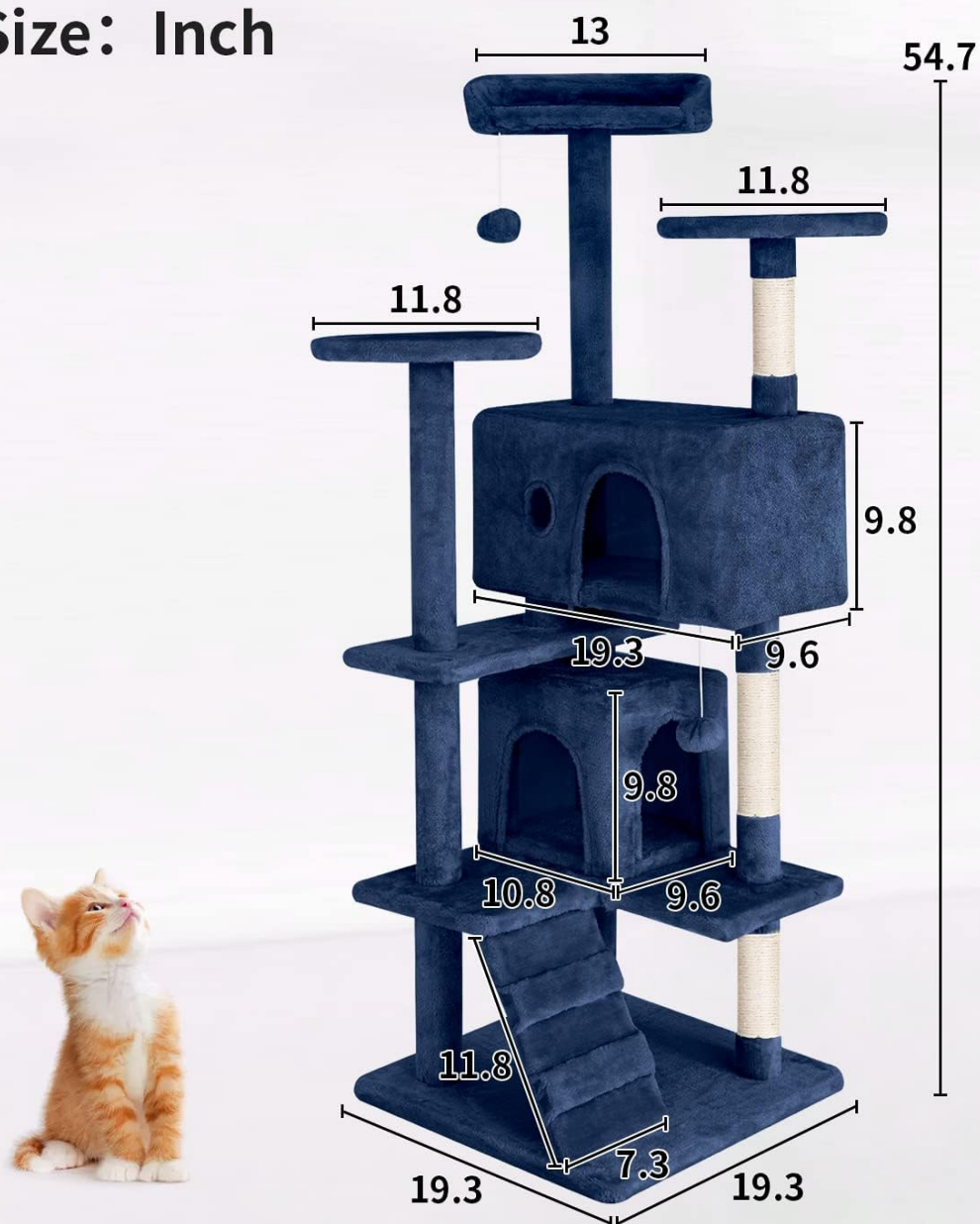


Figure 7: Dimensional diagram of the 54-inch cat tree, indicating height, width, and depth of various sections.
