Gvyugke Captain 300 Wireless Gaming Headset User Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Gvyugke Captain 300 Wireless Gaming Headset. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your headset to ensure optimal performance and an immersive gaming experience. Please read this manual thoroughly before use and retain it for future reference.

The Gvyugke Captain 300 headset features versatile 3-in-1 connectivity (2.4 GHz wireless, Bluetooth 5.2, and 3.5mm wired), 50mm audio drivers for stereo sound, a detachable noise-cancelling microphone, and an ergonomic design for extended comfort.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Gvyugke Captain 300 headset is engineered for superior audio performance and user comfort. Key components and features include:

- **50mm Audio Drivers:** Deliver rich stereo sound with enhanced bass for an immersive experience.
- **Detachable Omnidirectional Microphone:** Provides clear voice communication with noise reduction capabilities.
- **Adjustable Headband:** Ensures a comfortable fit for various head sizes.
- **Soft Memory Foam Earcups:** Designed for passive noise reduction and comfort during long gaming sessions.
- **Integrated Controls:** Easy access to volume, microphone mute, and power functions.

- **RGB Lighting:** Customizable lighting effects for aesthetic appeal.
- **Long-lasting Battery:** Up to 35-40 hours of playtime (15-20 hours with RGB lighting enabled).

4. SETUP

4.1 Charging the Headset

1. Connect the USB charging cable to the headset's charging port.
2. Plug the other end of the USB cable into a compatible USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, wall adapter).
3. The LED indicator on the headset will show charging status. A full charge typically takes about 3 hours.

4.2 Connecting via 2.4 GHz Wireless (USB Dongle)

This mode offers low latency connectivity for PC, PS4, PS5, and Nintendo Switch (microphone not supported on Switch).

1. Insert the 2.4 GHz USB wireless dongle into an available USB port on your device.
2. Power on the headset. It should automatically connect to the dongle.
3. Ensure the headset is selected as the audio output/input device in your system settings.

4.3 Connecting via Bluetooth 5.2

This mode is suitable for phones, tablets, and other Bluetooth-enabled mobile devices.

1. Power on the headset and put it into Bluetooth pairing mode (refer to headset controls for specific instructions,

usually a long press of the power button or a dedicated Bluetooth button).

2. On your device, go to Bluetooth settings and search for available devices.
3. Select "Gvyugke Captain 300" (or similar name) from the list to pair.

4.4 Connecting via 3.5mm Audio Cable

This wired mode is compatible with PS5, PS4, PC, Mac, phone, pad, Switch, and Xbox series controllers (audio only for Xbox).

1. Connect one end of the 3.5mm audio cable to the headset's 3.5mm port.
2. Connect the other end to the 3.5mm audio jack on your device or controller.
3. The headset will operate in passive mode, drawing power from the device if needed, or using its own battery for features like RGB.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Power On/Off

- To power on: Press and hold the Power button until the LED indicator lights up.
- To power off: Press and hold the Power button until the LED indicator turns off.

5.2 Volume Control

- Use the volume roller/buttons located on the earcup to adjust the audio output level.

5.3 Microphone Usage

- **Attaching the Microphone:** Insert the detachable microphone into the designated port on the headset until it clicks into place.
- **Adjusting the Microphone:** The microphone is flexible; adjust its position for optimal voice pickup.
- **Muting the Microphone:** Use the microphone mute button on the headset to toggle mute on/off. The LED indicator on the microphone or headset may show its status.
- **Detaching the Microphone:** Gently pull the microphone out of its port when not needed.

5.4 RGB Lighting Control

- The headset features RGB lighting. Refer to the specific button on your headset (if available) to cycle through lighting modes or turn them off.
- Note that disabling RGB lighting extends battery life.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning

- Wipe the headset with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use harsh chemicals, cleaning solvents, or strong detergents.
- Avoid getting moisture into any openings.

6.2 Storage

- Store the headset in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- When storing for extended periods, ensure the headset is fully charged to preserve battery health.

6.3 Battery Care

- To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently.
- Charge the headset regularly, even if not in frequent use.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound from headset	Headset not powered on; Volume too low; Incorrect audio output selected; Not paired/connected.	Ensure headset is on; Increase volume; Select headset as default audio device; Repair/reconnect.
Microphone not working	Microphone muted; Not properly attached; Incorrect audio input selected; Compatibility issue (e.g., Switch).	Unmute microphone; Ensure it's securely attached; Select headset mic as default input; Note Switch compatibility limitation.
Poor wireless connection/disconnections	Out of range; Interference; Low battery.	Move closer to the dongle/device; Avoid obstacles; Charge the headset.
Headset not charging	Faulty cable/charger; Loose connection.	Try a different USB cable/charger; Ensure connections are secure.
