### User Manual

#### Introduction

The SAHAUHY 80 Pints ENERGY STAR Dehumidifier is designed to efficiently remove excess moisture from large indoor spaces, improving air quality and comfort. This unit is ideal for areas up to 5,200 square feet, including basements, garages, bedrooms, and living rooms. It features multiple operating modes, adjustable fan speeds, and convenient drainage options.

#### Key Features:

- Removes up to 80 pints of moisture per day.
- ENERGY STAR Certified for energy efficiency.
- Easy-to-use controls with automatic humidity settings.
- Multiple drainage options: manual, continuous drain hose, or compatible with garden hose.
- Humanized features: 4 modes (Sleep, Living, Basement, Continuous), adjustable fan speeds, 24-hour timer, built-in 360° wheels and handle, auto restart, auto defrost, low-noise operation, power outage restart, child lock, and removable washable filter.

## Setup

Follow these steps to set up your SAHAUHY Dehumidifier:

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the dehumidifier and all accessories from the packaging. Inspect the unit for any shipping damage.
2. **Placement:** Place the dehumidifier in an area where humidity control is desired. Ensure there is at least 8 inches of space around the unit for proper airflow. The unit is equipped with 360° rotatable wheels for easy movement.
3. **Power Connection:** Plug the 64-inch power cord into a single, grounded electrical outlet.
4. **Drainage Options:** Your dehumidifier offers three drainage methods:

This image illustrates the three available drainage methods: Manual Draining using the 1.14-gallon water tank, Automatic Drainage with the included 3.3 ft drain hose, and Portable Drainage compatible with a garden hose (not included).

- **Manual Draining:** The dehumidifier collects water in the 1.14-gallon water tank. When the tank is full, the unit will automatically stop and an indicator will light up. Carefully remove and empty the tank, then reinsert it.
- **Automatic Drainage:** For continuous operation without emptying the tank, connect the included 3.3 ft drain hose to the drainage port at the back of the unit. Ensure the hose is positioned below the drain outlet to allow gravity drainage into a suitable receptacle or floor drain.
- **Portable Drainage (Garden Hose Compatible):** If the included hose is not long enough, you can connect a standard garden hose (purchased separately) to the drainage port for continuous draining.

## Operating Instructions

Your SAHAUHY Dehumidifier features a smart control panel for easy operation.

## Perfect for Various Indoor Places

1. **Power On/Off:** Press the **POWER** button to turn the unit on or off.
2. **Setting Humidity:** Use the **HUMIDITY %** up/down arrows to set your desired humidity level. The unit will automatically operate to maintain this level, stopping when reached and restarting if humidity rises. The adjustable range is typically between 30% and 80%.
3. **Operating Modes:** Press the **MODE** button to cycle through the four available modes:
  - **Sleep Mode:** Operates quietly for undisturbed rest.
  - **Living Mode:** Standard operation for general living areas.
  - **Basement Mode:** Optimized for higher humidity environments like basements.
  - **Continuous Mode:** Runs continuously regardless of humidity level, ideal for very damp conditions or when using continuous drainage.

# Optional Draining Methods

Three drainage methods can be chosen according to the effect you want, how convenient!






**Portable Drainage**

## Automatic drainage hose connection precautions



Ensure the drain hose is always positioned below the horizontal line.



The drain hose cannot be above the drain outlet as this will cause water to back up into the bucket.

This image displays the four distinct operating modes: Living Area Mode, Sleeping Area Mode, Basement Mode, and Continuous Mode, each designed for specific environmental needs.

4. **Fan Speed:** Press the **FAN SPEED** button to select between Low, Medium, and High fan speeds.
5. **24-Hour Timer:** Use the **TIMER** button to set a delayed start or stop time for the unit, up to 24 hours.
6. **Child Lock:** Activate the child lock feature to prevent accidental changes to settings.
7. **Auto Restart:** In case of a power outage, the unit will automatically restart with the previous settings once power is restored.
8. **Auto Defrost:** The dehumidifier is equipped with an auto defrost function to ensure efficient operation even in colder conditions, preventing ice buildup on coils.



## Maintenance

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your dehumidifier.

1. **Emptying the Water Tank:** If using manual drainage, empty the 1.14-gallon water tank when the 'Bucket Full' indicator lights up. Pull the tank out, discard the collected water, and slide it back into place until it clicks securely.
2. **Cleaning the Air Filter:** The dehumidifier features a detachable and washable air filter. It is recommended to clean the filter every 30 days or more frequently depending on usage and air quality.



This image demonstrates the process of removing and washing the dehumidifier's air filter, which should be done regularly to maintain efficiency.

To clean the filter:

- Turn off and unplug the unit.
  - Remove the filter from the back of the unit.
  - Wash the filter with warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly.
  - Allow the filter to air dry completely before reinserting it into the unit.
- **General Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior of the unit with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.

## Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your dehumidifier, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Dehumidifier does not turn on.	No power, power cord unplugged, circuit breaker tripped.	Check power connection, ensure outlet is functional, reset circuit breaker.
Unit runs but does not dehumidify.	Air filter clogged, room temperature too low, humidity setting too high, unit size too small for space.	Clean air filter, ensure room temperature is above 41°F (5°C), lower humidity setting, consider unit capacity for room size.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Water tank is full, but unit is not stopping.	Water tank not properly seated, float switch malfunction.	Ensure water tank is fully inserted and correctly aligned. Contact customer support if issue persists.
Unit is noisy.	Unit not on a level surface, fan obstruction.	Place unit on a firm, level surface. Check for any obstructions in the fan area.
