INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Ciays 43" Fire Pit Table, Model CIFPT9B. Please read all instructions thoroughly before use and retain this manual for future reference. This product is designed for outdoor use only.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Failure to follow these instructions could result in fire, explosion, or carbon monoxide poisoning, which could cause property damage, personal injury, or death.

- This appliance is for outdoor use only. Do not operate indoors.
- Keep clear of combustible materials. Maintain adequate clearance from walls, ceilings, and other structures.
- Only use liquefied petroleum gas (propane) as fuel. Do not use natural gas or any other fuel.
- Ensure proper ventilation. Do not obstruct the flow of combustion and ventilation air.
- Do not store or use gasoline or other flammable vapors and liquids in the vicinity of this or any other appliance.
- Always connect and disconnect the propane cylinder outdoors in a well-ventilated area.
- Never leave the fire pit unattended while in operation.
- Keep children and pets away from the fire pit.

- Allow the unit to cool completely before moving or storing.
- If you smell gas:
 - a. Shut off gas to the appliance.
 - b. Extinguish any open flame.
 - c. If odor continues, keep away from the appliance and immediately call your gas supplier or fire department.

This Ciays Fire Pit Table is CSA-certified, ensuring it meets recognized safety standards.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present and undamaged before assembly. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble or operate the fire pit. Contact customer support for assistance.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Keep packaging materials until assembly is complete to ensure no small parts are discarded.
2. **Placement:** Position the fire pit table on a flat, stable, non-combustible surface outdoors. Ensure adequate clearance from any combustible materials (e.g., walls, furniture, overhead structures).
3. **Adjustable Feet:** Use the adjustable feet at the base of the fire pit to level the unit on uneven ground, ensuring stability.

Beautiful Design Details




Image: Detailed view of the fire pit's features, including the elegant blue glass beads, the removable lid for converting to a table, and the adjustable feet for leveling.

4. Propane Tank Installation:

- Open the side access door on the fire pit table.
- Place a standard 20 lb propane tank (not included) into the designated compartment.
- Connect the regulator hose from the fire pit to the propane tank valve. Hand-tighten securely.
- Ensure all connections are tight before opening the propane tank valve.

5. **Glass Beads Placement:** Carefully distribute the blue glass beads over the burner area. Do not overfill or cover the igniter.

6. **Accessory Attachment:** Attach the two cup holders to the designated corners underneath the tabletop edge. Install the hanging shelf as desired for additional storage.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Before Lighting:

- Ensure the area around the fire pit is clear of debris and combustible materials.
- Verify the propane tank valve is fully open.
- Remove the tabletop lid if it is in place.

2. Ignition:

- Locate the control knob on the side of the fire pit table.
- Push in the control knob and slowly turn it to the "LOW" position.
- While holding the knob in, press the igniter button repeatedly until the burner ignites.
- Once ignited, continue to hold the control knob in for 10-15 seconds to allow the thermocouple to heat up and engage the safety valve.
- Release the control knob. If the flame extinguishes, repeat the ignition process.

- 3. Flame Adjustment:** Once the burner is lit, push in and adjust the control knob to increase or decrease the flame height to your desired level. The fire pit provides up to 60,000 BTUs of heat output.

4. Shutting Down:

- Turn the control knob to the "OFF" position.
- Close the valve on the propane tank.
- Allow the fire pit to cool completely before covering or storing.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Clean the fire pit table regularly with a soft cloth and mild detergent. Do not use abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals. Ensure the unit is cool before cleaning.
- **Burner Maintenance:** Periodically inspect the burner and gas connections for any signs of damage, blockages, or leaks. Use a soapy water solution to check for gas leaks (bubbles indicate a leak).
- **Storage:** When not in use, especially during inclement weather or extended periods, cover the fire pit table with the included nylon protective cover to shield it from dust and moisture.

- **Lid Usage:** The tabletop lid can be placed over the stainless steel burner when the fire pit is not in use, converting it into an outdoor table. Ensure the burner is completely cool before placing the lid.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Burner does not ignite.	No gas flow. Igniter not sparking. Air in gas line.	Ensure propane tank valve is open and tank has fuel. Check igniter electrode for damage or blockage. Purge air by attempting ignition several times.
Flame goes out after releasing control knob.	Thermocouple not heating sufficiently or faulty.	Hold the control knob in for 10-15 seconds after ignition to allow the thermocouple to heat up. If issue persists, contact customer support.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Low flame or inconsistent flame.	Low propane level. Gas line obstruction. Regulator issue.	Check propane tank level. Inspect gas hose for kinks or blockages. Ensure regulator is properly connected.
Gas odor detected.	Gas leak.	Immediately shut off gas supply. Check all connections for leaks using soapy water. If odor persists, do not operate and contact emergency services.
