## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Good Housekeeping Roman 83007 Bathroom Ventilation Exhaust Fan with Light and Night-Light. This unit is designed to effectively remove excess humidity and odors from your bathroom, contributing to a more comfortable and healthier environment. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning installation or operation.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury to persons, observe the following:

- Installation work and electrical wiring must be done by qualified person(s) in accordance with all applicable codes and standards, including fire-rated construction codes and standards.
- Always disconnect power at the service panel before wiring or servicing the unit.
- This unit is ETL Listed for safe use over shower enclosures and bathtubs when connected to a Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter (GFCI) protected circuit.
- Do not use this fan with any solid-state speed control device.
- Never place a switch where it can be reached from a tub or shower.
- Duct work must always be vented to the outdoors.

### INSTALLATION

This fan is designed for flush mount installation. Ensure you have adequate space and access for wiring and ducting.

#### Tools and Materials Required (Not Included):


- Screwdriver
- Wire strippers
- Drill
- Duct tape or clamps
- Appropriate wiring (e.g., 12/2 gauge)
- Light bulbs (2x LED A-15, 8W max; 1x Candelabra base, 7W max)

#### Installation Steps:

1. **Prepare the Opening:** Create an appropriate opening in the ceiling for the fan housing. The housing

dimensions are approximately 9.7" x 8.9" x 7.4" (W x D x H).

2. **Mount the Housing:** Use the included adjustable slider bars to secure the fan housing between ceiling joists. The slider bars can extend the housing range from 13.78" to 22.83".
3. **Connect Ducting:** Attach a 4-inch round duct to the fan's exhaust port. Secure it with duct tape or clamps to ensure an airtight seal. Ensure the duct vents to the outdoors.
4. **Electrical Wiring:** Disconnect power at the circuit breaker. Route electrical wires (e.g., 12/2 gauge) to the fan's junction box. Connect the wires according to local electrical codes. The junction box is designed with ample space for wiring. It may be easier to wire the fan in the attic before fully securing it in the ceiling.
5. **Install Light Kit:** Once the housing is secured and wired, attach the light kit and glass shade.
6. **Insert Light Bulbs:** Install the required light bulbs. Note that the fixture requires 2 LED A-15 bulbs (maximum 8 watts each) and 1 Candelabra base bulb (maximum 7 watts). Ensure bulbs are short enough to fit within the light plate.
7. **Restore Power:** Once installation is complete, restore power at the circuit breaker and test the fan and light functions.

## OPERATION

The Good Housekeeping Roman 83007 fan operates via standard wall switches (not included). It features a main light and a night-light function.

- **Fan Operation:** Activate the fan by flipping the designated wall switch. The fan will operate at 110 CFM to remove moisture and odors.

- **Main Light Operation:** Activate the main light using its dedicated wall switch. This light provides general illumination for your bathroom.
- **Night-Light Operation:** The night-light function is typically controlled by a separate switch or integrated into the main light switch with multiple toggles. Consult your electrician for specific wiring configurations if you desire separate control for the night-light.

## MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your fan.

### Cleaning the Fan and Light Cover:

1. **Disconnect Power:** Always turn off power to the fan at the circuit breaker before cleaning.
2. **Remove Cover:** Carefully remove the decorative light cover and glass shade.
3. **Clean Components:** Wipe the exterior of the fan and the light cover with a soft, damp cloth. A mild, non-abrasive cleaner can be used if necessary. Ensure all parts are dry before reassembly.
4. **Clean Fan Blades:** Gently clean any dust or debris from the fan blades and motor housing using a soft brush or vacuum cleaner attachment. Avoid direct contact with electrical components.
5. **Reassemble:** Carefully reattach the glass shade and decorative cover.
6. **Restore Power:** Restore power at the circuit breaker.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your fan, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Fan does not turn on	No power, loose wiring, faulty switch	Check circuit breaker. Verify wiring connections. Test wall switch.
Light does not turn on	Burned out bulb, loose wiring, faulty switch	Replace light bulbs. Check wiring connections. Test wall switch.
Light is too dim	Incorrect bulb wattage or type, opaque glass shade	Ensure you are using the recommended bulb types and wattages (2x LED A-15, 8W max; 1x Candelabra base, 7W max). The frosted glass shade diffuses light, which may appear dimmer than clear glass.
Fan is noisy	Loose mounting, debris in fan blades, motor issue	Ensure fan housing is securely mounted. Clean fan blades. If noise persists, contact customer support.

Night-light not working or cannot be found

Wiring configuration, bulb issue

Verify wiring for the night-light function. Ensure the Candelabra base bulb is installed and functional. Consult an electrician if unsure about wiring.
