1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the KRIB BLING ZT-NEW-GOLD WASHER Portable Automatic Washing Machine. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new appliance. Please read it thoroughly before use and retain it for future reference.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury when using your appliance, follow these basic precautions:

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Do not wash articles that have been previously cleaned in, washed in, soaked in, or spotted with gasoline, dry-cleaning solvents, or other flammable or explosive substances, as they emit vapors that could ignite or explode.
- Do not allow children to play on or in the appliance. Close supervision of children is necessary when the appliance is used near children.
- Do not reach into the appliance if the tub or agitator is moving.

- Do not install or store this appliance where it will be exposed to the weather or freezing temperatures.
- Do not tamper with controls.
- Do not repair or replace any part of the appliance or attempt any servicing unless specifically recommended in this manual or in published user-repair instructions that you understand and have the skills to carry out.
- Always disconnect the appliance from the power supply before cleaning, servicing, or attempting to remove any parts.
- Ensure the appliance is properly grounded.

3. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Carefully unpack your washing machine and check that all the following items are included:

- KRIB BLING Portable Automatic Washing Machine
- Inlet Hose
- Drain Hose
- Adaptor
- Washing Impeller (pre-installed)
- User Manual (this document)

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components of your washing machine.

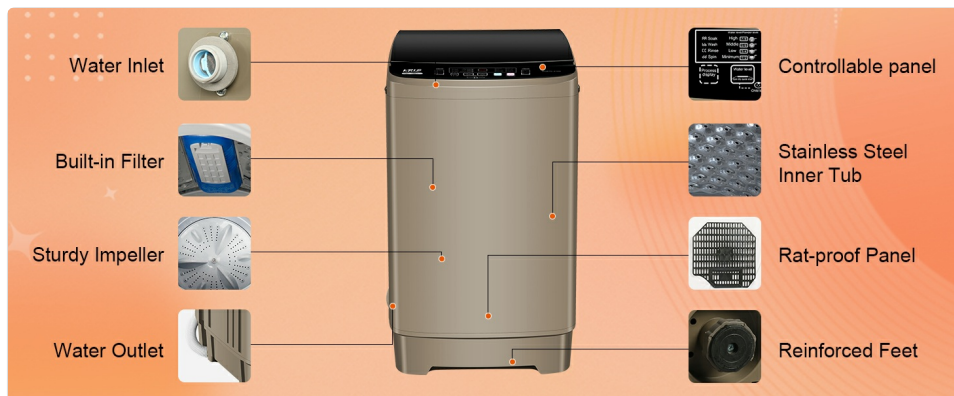


Figure 3: Labeled diagram of the washing machine's main parts, including the water inlet, filter, impeller, control panel, and inner tub.

5. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

5.1 Placement

Place the washing machine on a firm, level surface. Ensure there is adequate space around the unit for ventilation and hose connections. This appliance is suitable for various locations such as apartments, dorms, RVs, and bathrooms.

5.2 Leveling

The washing machine is equipped with adjustable leveling legs. Adjust these legs to ensure the machine is stable and level. An unlevel machine can cause excessive vibration and noise during operation.

5.3 Water Inlet Connection

1. Connect one end of the inlet hose to the water inlet port on the back of the washing machine.

2. Connect the other end of the inlet hose to a cold water faucet. Ensure all connections are tight to prevent leaks.

5.4 Drain Hose Connection

Attach the drain hose to the drain outlet on the washing machine. Position the other end of the drain hose into a sink, utility tub, or standpipe. The machine features a drain pump, allowing for flexible drainage angles.

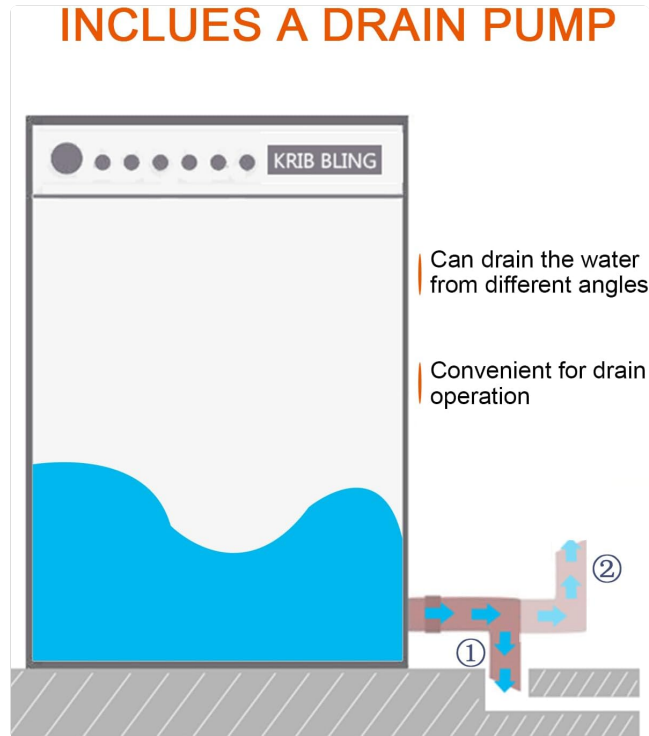


Figure 6: Illustration of the drain pump's capability to drain water from various angles.

5.5 Power Connection

Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet. Ensure the voltage matches the specifications of the appliance.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Control Panel Overview

The washing machine features a multi-functional control panel with an LED display for easy operation.

6.2 Loading Laundry

The inner tub has a capacity of 17.7 lbs. Distribute laundry evenly inside the tub to ensure balanced washing.

6.3 Washing Programs

The machine offers 10 washing programs to suit different fabric types and soil levels:

- **Standard:** For daily laundry.
- **Soft:** For delicate items.
- **Quick Wash:** For lightly soiled items or small loads.
- **Heavy Duty:** For heavily soiled or bulky items.
- **Soak Wash:** For items requiring pre-soaking.
- **Wash Only:** Performs only the wash cycle.
- **Spin Only:** Performs only the spin cycle.
- **Tub Clean:** For cleaning the washing machine tub.
- **Tub Air Dry:** For drying the inside of the tub.
- **Water Recycle:** For specific water-saving operations.

6.4 Water Levels

Select from 8 water level options to match your load size, optimizing water usage.

6.5 Child Lock Function

To activate the child lock, press and hold the designated buttons (refer to the control panel diagram) for a few seconds. This prevents accidental changes to settings during operation.

7. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

7.1 Cleaning the Exterior

Wipe the exterior of the machine with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

7.2 Cleaning the Interior (Tub Clean)

Regularly use the 'Tub Clean' program to prevent mold and mildew buildup and maintain hygiene. You may use a washing machine cleaner specifically designed for this purpose.

7.3 Cleaning the Lint Filter

The machine has a built-in lint filter. Regularly remove and clean the filter to ensure efficient operation and prevent lint from redepositing on clothes. Refer to the product overview diagram for the filter's location.

7.4 Winterizing (for cold climates)

If the machine is stored in an area subject to freezing temperatures, drain all water from the hoses and tub to prevent damage. Disconnect water inlet hoses and allow them to drain. Run a spin cycle to remove any remaining water from the tub.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting customer service, please refer to the following table for common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Machine does not start	Power cord unplugged; Door not closed properly; Power outage.	Check power connection; Ensure lid is fully closed; Check household circuit breaker.
No water filling	Water faucet off; Water inlet hose kinked; Water supply pressure too low.	Open water faucet; Straighten hose; Check water supply.
Machine vibrates excessively	Machine not level; Load unbalanced; Shipping bolts not removed (if applicable).	Adjust leveling legs; Redistribute laundry; Ensure all shipping materials are removed.
Water not draining	Drain hose kinked or blocked; Drain pump filter clogged.	Check and clear drain hose; Clean drain pump filter.
Error code displayed	Specific malfunction.	Refer to the specific error code in a more detailed manual or contact customer support.




