## INTRODUCTION

---

The Amazon Kindle (11th Generation) is designed to provide an enhanced reading experience, offering a lightweight and compact form factor with improved display features. This manual will guide you through the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your device.

## WHAT'S IN THE BOX

---

Upon unboxing your new Kindle, ensure all the following items are present:

- Kindle device
- USB-C charging cable
- Quick Start Guide

## SETUP

---

### Initial Charge

Before first use, it is recommended to fully charge your Kindle. Connect the included USB-C cable to the Kindle's charging port and to a power source. A full charge takes approximately 4 hours from a computer via USB cable, or 2 hours with a 9W USB power adapter (sold separately).

### Power On/Off

To power on your Kindle, press and hold the power button located on the bottom edge of the device for a few seconds until the screen illuminates. To turn off or restart, press and hold the power button until a power dialog appears on the screen, then select the desired option.

### Wi-Fi Connectivity

Your Kindle requires a Wi-Fi connection to download content and access online services. It supports 2.4

GHz and 5.0 GHz networks with WEP, WPA, WPA2, WPA3, and OWE security. Navigate to the settings menu, select 'Wi-Fi & Bluetooth', then choose your network and enter the password. Ad-hoc (peer-to-peer) Wi-Fi networks are not supported.

## Device Registration

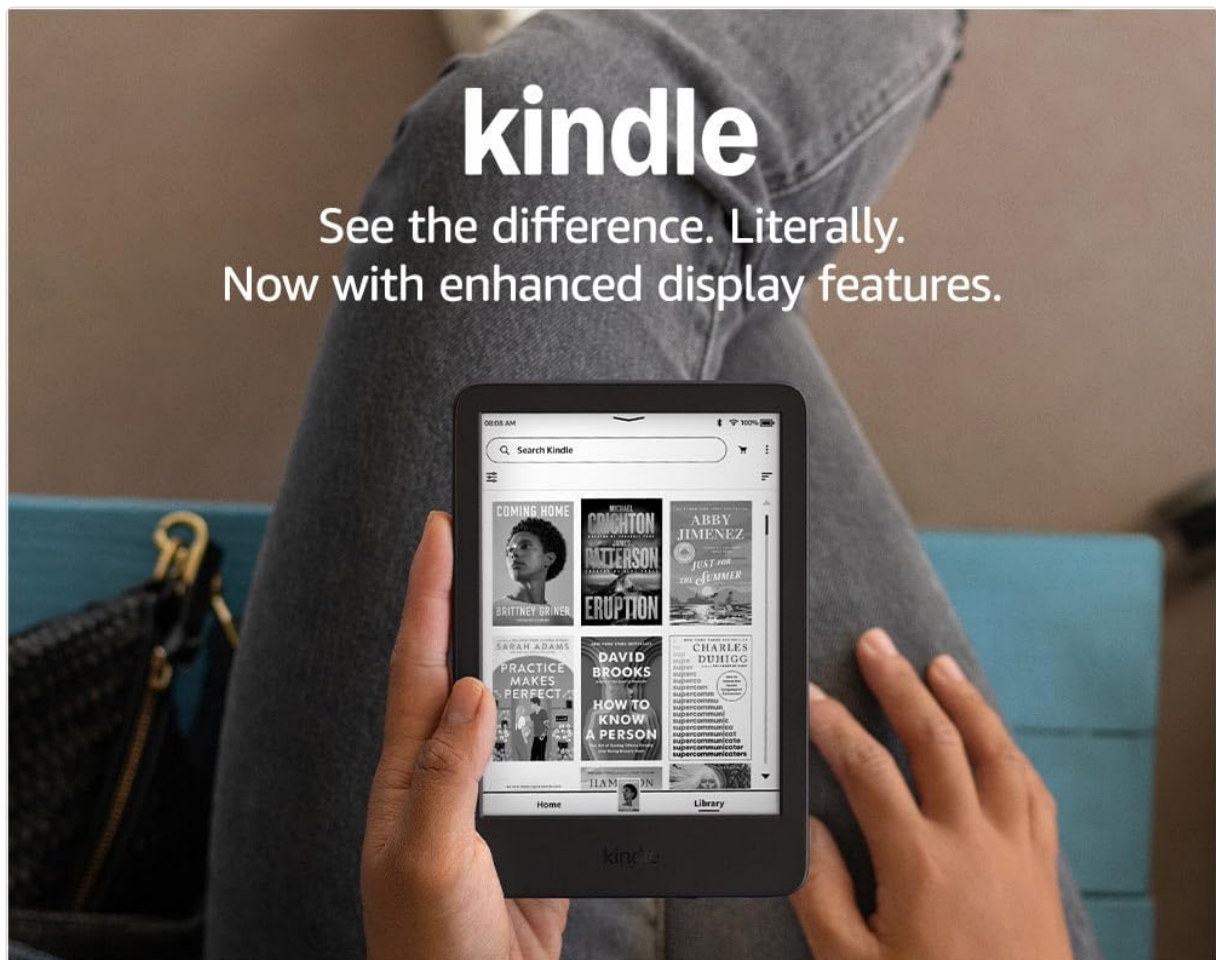
Upon first connecting to Wi-Fi, you will be prompted to register your Kindle to your Amazon account. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete this process. Registration is necessary to access your Kindle library and the Kindle Store.

## OPERATING YOUR KINDLE

---

### Reading Experience

The Kindle features a 6-inch glare-free display with 300 ppi, optimized font technology, and 16-level gray scale for comfortable reading. The adjustable front light is now 25% brighter at max setting, and a dark mode is available for reading in low-light conditions. Page turns are faster for a more fluid experience.

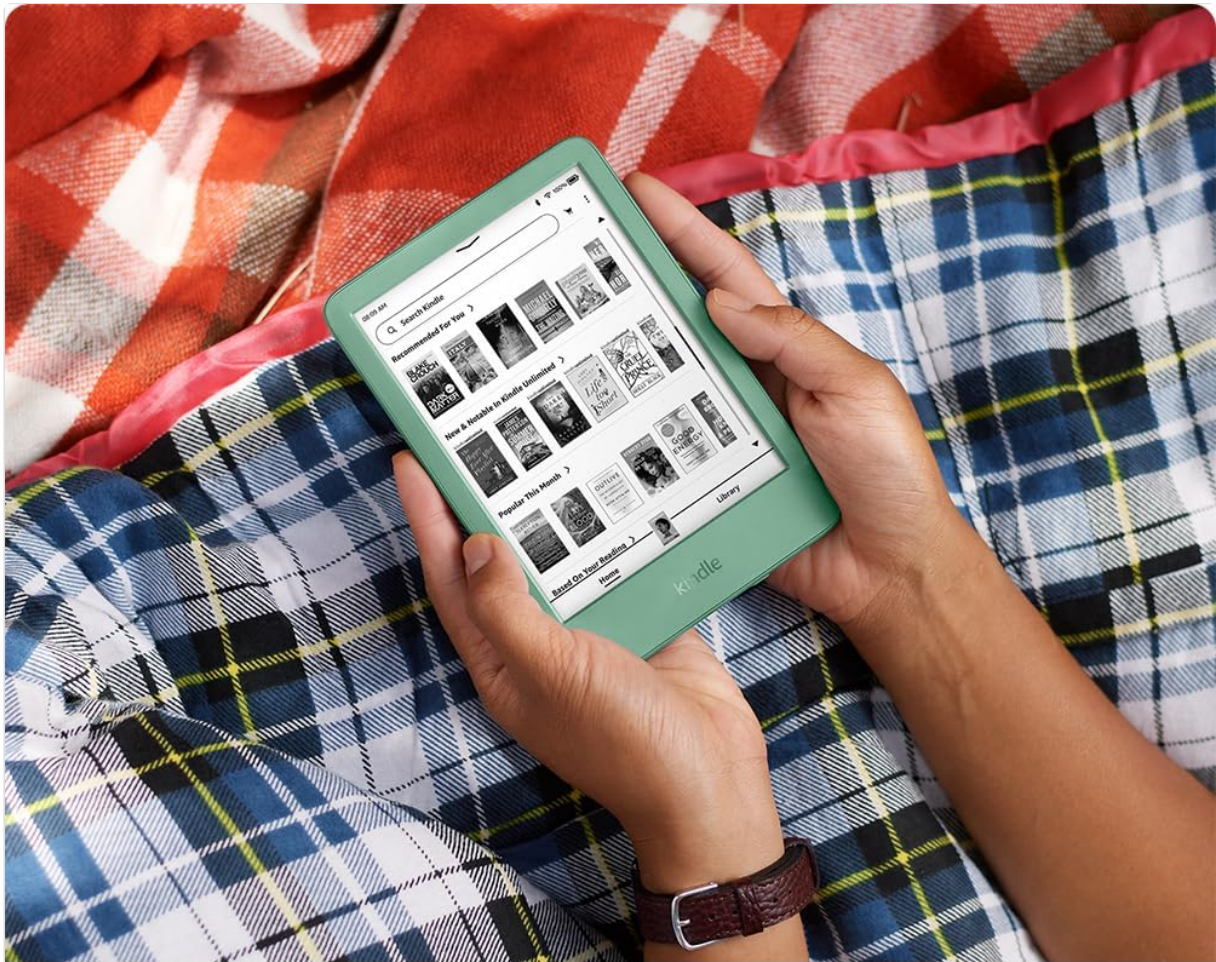
### **Navigating Your Library**

## MAINTENANCE

## Cleaning

To clean your Kindle, use a soft, lint-free cloth. Avoid abrasive materials, sprays, or harsh chemicals. Do not submerge the device in water.

## Battery Management

A single charge can last up to six weeks, based on a half hour of reading per day with wireless off and the light setting at 13. Battery life may vary depending on usage. To maximize battery life, turn off Wi-Fi when not needed and adjust the front light to a lower setting.

## Software Updates

Your Kindle receives guaranteed software security updates for at least four years from its last availability as a new unit. These updates are typically delivered automatically over Wi-Fi. Ensure your device is connected to Wi-Fi periodically to receive the latest software.

# TROUBLESHOOTING

---

## Common Issues

- **Device not turning on:** Ensure the device is charged. Connect it to a power source for at least 30 minutes.
- **Cannot connect to Wi-Fi:** Verify your Wi-Fi password. Ensure you are connecting to a supported network type (not ad-hoc). Try restarting your Kindle and your Wi-Fi router.
- **Slow performance or page turns:** Restart your Kindle by holding the power button until the power dialog appears, then select 'Restart'.
- **Screen frozen:** Press and hold the power button for 40 seconds until the device restarts.
