SETUP GUIDE

1. Unboxing and Initial Inspection

- Carefully remove all components from the packaging.

- Inspect the console and accessories for any visible damage.

2. Connecting the Console

- 1. Connect the HDMI cable from the console's HDMI OUT port to an HDMI input on your TV or monitor.
- 2. Connect the power cable to the console's power input, then plug the other end into a power outlet.
- 3. Ensure adequate ventilation around the console. Do not block air vents.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Console does not power on.	Power cable not connected properly; power outlet issue.	Check power cable connections. Try a different power outlet.
No image on TV.	HDMI cable loose or incorrect input selected on TV.	Ensure HDMI cable is securely connected. Select the correct HDMI input on your TV.
Controller not responding.	Low batteries; not paired with console.	Replace batteries. Re-pair the controller with the console.
Game Pass code not working.	Incorrect entry; region restriction; already redeemed.	Double-check the code. Ensure it matches your region. Contact Xbox Support if issues persist.




