- Flexible Design: Equipped with a 7-inch 360° flexible gooseneck tube and an aluminum alloy clip, suitable for framed or frameless aquariums up to 0.9 inches thick.
- **Memory Function:** Retains previous settings (color, brightness, timing) after a power outage, eliminating the need for re-setup.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps to correctly install your AQQA LED Aquarium Light:

- Assemble the Clip: Attach the adjustable clip to the gooseneck tube. Ensure all screws are tightened securely.
- 2. **Attach to Aquarium:** Position the light on the edge of your aquarium. The aluminum alloy clip is designed for tanks up to 0.9 inches (2.3 cm) thick. Gently tighten the screw on the clip until the light is firmly secured. Avoid over-tightening, especially on rimless glass tanks.

- 3. **Adjust Position:** Use the 360° flexible gooseneck tube to adjust the angle and direction of the light over your aquarium.
- 4. **Connect Power:** Plug the power adapter into a suitable electrical outlet.




Figure 1: Flexible clip-on design for easy attachment to aquarium edges up to 0.9 inches thick.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The AQQA LED Aquarium Light offers various modes and settings for optimal aquarium environment control.

Control Panel Overview

The inline controller allows you to manage all light functions:

- **TIMER Button:** Sets the lighting duration (6H/10H/12H).
- ON/OFF & Mode (M) Button: Turns the light on/off and cycles through color modes in DIY mode.
- Brightness (+/-) Buttons: Adjusts light intensity.
- 24/7 Button: Activates or deactivates the 24/7 natural mode.

1. 24/7 Default Mode

This mode simulates a natural 24-hour light cycle, promoting a healthy environment for your aquatic life. The default cycle starts with warm orange light at 6 a.m., transitions to 100% bright full-spectrum light at noon, and then to starry blue light at night, turning off at 10:58 p.m.

- Activation: Press the '24/7' button on the controller. The indicator light for 24/7 mode will illuminate.
- **Time Adjustment:** The automatic on/off time can be postponed or advanced to shift the entire default time period. Refer to the specific instructions in the video for detailed time setting.

2. DIY Mode

Customize your aquarium lighting with specific colors, brightness, and timer settings.

- **Brightness Adjustment:** Press the '+' or '-' buttons to cycle through 5 levels of light brightness (10%, 25%, 50%, 75%, 100%).
- Color Selection: Press the 'M' button to cycle through 7 distinct colors (Red, Green, Blue, Orange, Yellow, Cyan Blue, Purple), Full Spectrum, and an Auto Color Cycle mode.
- **Timer Setting:** Press the 'TIMER' button to select a lighting duration of 6 hours, 10 hours, or 12 hours. The light will automatically turn off after the selected duration.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your aquarium light.

- **Cleaning:** Periodically wipe the light fixture with a soft, damp cloth to remove dust, water spots, and algae buildup. Ensure the light is unplugged before cleaning.
- Check Connections: Regularly inspect the power cord and connections for any signs of damage or wear.
- Water Exposure: While the light is IP68 waterproof, avoid submerging the power adapter or controller.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Light does not turn on.	No power, loose connection, timer setting.	Check power outlet and connections. Verify timer settings are correct.
Light flickers or dims unexpectedly.	Unstable power, damaged cable, overheating.	Ensure stable power supply. Inspect cable for damage. Ensure proper heat dissipation (clean fixture).
Settings are lost after power outage.	This model features a memory function. If settings are lost, ensure the power outage was not prolonged or severe enough to reset internal components. Re-enter desired settings.


