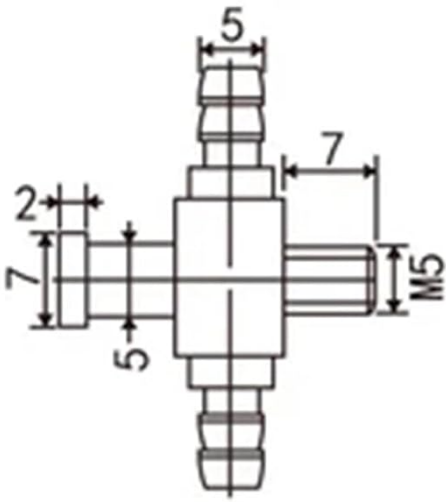

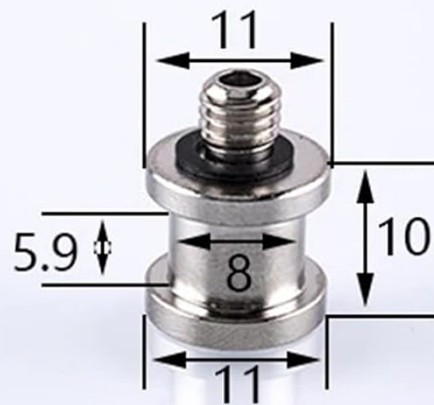

Figure 2.3: Dimensions for Variant J (Male M5). This diagram illustrates the specific measurements for this particular adapter type.

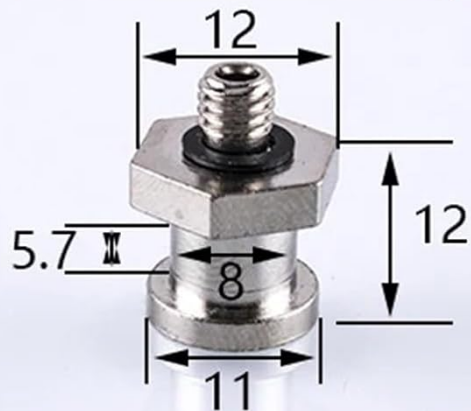

3. INSTALLATION AND SETUP

The CONTIA adapters are designed for straightforward integration into pneumatic and vacuum systems. While the adapters themselves do not require assembly, proper installation is crucial for optimal performance and to prevent air leaks.

1. **Identify Correct Thread:** Ensure the adapter's thread (M4 or M5) matches the thread of the component it will connect to (e.g., suction cup, pneumatic cylinder, manipulator arm).
2. **Clean Threads:** Before installation, ensure both the adapter's threads and the mating component's threads are clean and free of debris.
3. **Apply Sealant (Optional):** For applications requiring an extra secure seal or in high-vibration environments, a small amount of thread sealant (e.g., PTFE tape or liquid thread sealant) can be applied to the male threads.

- 4. **Thread Connection:** Carefully thread the adapter into the corresponding component. Hand-tighten first to ensure proper alignment and prevent cross-threading.
- 5. **Tighten Securely:** Use an appropriate wrench to tighten the adapter securely. Do not overtighten, as this can damage the threads or the adapter itself. Refer to the torque specifications of your pneumatic system components if available.
- 6. **Verify Connection:** After tightening, visually inspect the connection for any gaps or misalignments.

4. OPERATION

- No specific operational controls are associated with the adapter itself; its function is entirely dependent on the pneumatic or vacuum system it is integrated into.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and reliable performance of your CONTIA hardware adapters.

- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the adapters for any signs of wear, corrosion, or damage, especially around the threads and sealing surfaces.
- **Cleaning:** If necessary, clean the adapters with a soft cloth and a mild, non-abrasive cleaner. Ensure no residue is left that could interfere with sealing. Avoid harsh chemicals that may damage the material.
- **Thread Condition:** Check the threads for any deformation or stripping. Damaged threads can lead to leaks and unstable connections.
- **Storage:** Store unused adapters in a clean, dry environment to prevent corrosion and contamination.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Adapter Does Not Thread Smoothly	- Cross-threading - Debris in threads - Incompatible thread size	- Unscrew, realign, and re-thread carefully - Clean threads thoroughly - Confirm correct M4/M5 thread size
Adapter Appears Damaged	- Overtightening - Physical impact - Corrosion	- Replace the adapter - Ensure proper handling and storage
