INTRODUCTION

- **Two-Package Delivery:** The chair is shipped in two separate boxes for secure delivery. Ensure both packages are received before beginning assembly.
- **Assembly:** Assemble the chair on a flat, stable surface. It is recommended to have two people for assembly due to the weight of some components.
- **Weight Capacity:** Do not exceed the maximum weight recommendation of 440 pounds.
- **Movement:** When moving the chair, ensure the hydraulic pump is in the lowest position and the chair is not reclined.
- **Children:** Keep children away from the chair during assembly and operation to prevent accidents.
- **Maintenance:** Regularly inspect all parts for wear and tear. Do not use the chair if any components are damaged.

3. **Attach the Seat Frame:** Secure the seat frame to the top of the hydraulic pump.
4. **Install Backrest and Armrests:** Connect the backrest and armrests to the seat frame using the provided hardware.
5. **Attach Footrest:** Secure the footrest assembly to the chair.
6. **Insert Headrest:** Place the removable headrest into its designated slot on the backrest.
7. **Final Check:** Verify that all screws are tightened and all parts are securely attached before using the chair.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Baasha Barber Chair is designed for ease of use and client comfort.

- **Height Adjustment:** Use the hydraulic pump lever located on the side of the chair to adjust the seat height. Press down on the lever to lower the chair, and pump the lever to raise it.
- **Reclining Function:** The backrest reclines up to 165 degrees. Locate the recline lever (typically on the side, near the armrest) and pull it to adjust the backrest angle. Release the lever to lock it in position.
- **360-Degree Rotation:** The chair can rotate a full 360 degrees. To lock the rotation, engage the locking mechanism (usually a foot pedal or lever at the base).
- **Removable Headrest:** The headrest can be adjusted for height or removed entirely to accommodate different

client needs or services.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care will extend the life and appearance of your barber chair.

- **Cleaning the Upholstery:** The chair features breathable, waterproof PU leather. Wipe down the upholstery regularly with a soft, damp cloth and mild soap. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that can damage the material.

- **Cleaning the Base and Frame:** Clean the stainless steel frame and base with a non-abrasive cleaner and a soft cloth. Dry thoroughly to prevent water spots.
- **Lubrication:** Periodically check the hydraulic pump and reclining mechanisms. If movement becomes stiff, apply a small amount of silicone-based lubricant to moving parts as needed.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they are tight. Tighten any loose fasteners to maintain stability and safety.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Baasha Barber Chair, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Chair Not Adjusting Height:** Check the hydraulic pump lever. Ensure it is fully engaged. If the pump feels loose or unresponsive, it may require lubrication or professional service.

- **Chair Not Reclining:** Verify that the recline lever is functioning correctly and not obstructed. Ensure no debris is preventing the mechanism from moving freely.
- **Chair Wobbles:** Inspect all assembly bolts and screws. Tighten any loose connections. Ensure the base is on a flat, even surface.
- **Squeaking Noises:** Apply a small amount of silicone lubricant to moving parts and pivot points.
