SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

- 4. Connect Handle:** Attach the ergonomic handle to the top pipe section, ensuring proper alignment of the holes. Secure with the remaining fastener and tighten using the hex key.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the life of your Trazon Ergonomic Snow Shovel.

- **Cleaning:** After each use, remove any snow, ice, or debris from the shovel blade and handle. A damp cloth can be used for cleaning.
- **Drying:** Ensure the shovel is completely dry before storing to prevent rust on metal components and degradation of plastic.
- **Storage:** Store the shovel in a dry, protected area away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

the material into smaller, manageable pieces before attempting to scoop or push.

- **Reduced Ergonomic Benefit:** Ensure you are using both the main ergonomic handle and the mid-point grip for optimal posture and weight distribution. Adjust your stance to allow your body weight to assist in pushing.

SAFETY INFORMATION

To ensure safe operation and prevent injury, please observe the following precautions:

- Use the shovel carefully to minimize back and muscle strain. Lift with your legs, not your back.
- Avoid heavy-duty tasks that could damage the plastic blade, such as prying large, frozen objects.
- Ensure the handle is securely assembled and tightened before each use.
- Do not leave the shovel in hot temperatures, as this may affect material integrity.
- Wear appropriate winter clothing and footwear with good traction when shoveling.
- Be aware of your surroundings and avoid shoveling near obstacles or uneven surfaces.
