Introduction

This instruction manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your NERF Elite 2.0 Lock N Load Pack blaster. Please read this manual thoroughly before assembly and operation to ensure proper function and safety.

SAFETY INFORMATION

For your safety and the safety of others, observe the following guidelines:

- · Do not aim at face or eyes.
- Use of eyewear is recommended during play.
- Only use official NERF Elite darts. Other darts may not meet safety standards and could cause injury or damage to the blaster.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Your NERF Elite 2.0 Lock N Load Pack includes:

- One NERF Blaster (main body)
- Multiple blaster accessories for customization
- 50 Official NERF Elite Darts

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The NERF Elite 2.0 Lock N Load Pack blaster features modular components that allow for various configurations. Follow these steps to assemble your blaster:

- 1. **Identify Components:** Unpack all components and identify the main blaster body, stock, barrel extension, scope, and foregrip.
- 2. **Attach Stock:** Align the stock with the attachment point at the rear of the main blaster body and push firmly until it clicks into place.
- 3. **Attach Barrel Extension:** Connect the desired barrel extension to the front of the main blaster body. Ensure it is securely fastened.
- 4. **Attach Scope:** Slide the scope onto the tactical rail located on top of the blaster.
- 5. Attach Foregrip: Attach the foregrip to the tactical rail on the underside of the blaster.
- 6. Load Darts: Insert official NERF Elite darts into the dart loading slot or magazine (if applicable to

The modular design allows for 12 different blaster styles. Experiment with various combinations to find your preferred setup.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once assembled and loaded with darts, your blaster is ready for use.

- 1. **Prime the Blaster:** Pull the priming slide or handle (location varies by configuration) all the way back until it locks into place. This action prepares the blaster to fire.
- 2. **Aim:** Point the blaster at your target, ensuring no one is in the line of fire, especially not aiming at faces or eyes.
- 3. Fire: Press the trigger to launch a dart.
- 4. **Reload and Repeat:** After firing, prime the blaster again to prepare for the next shot. Reload darts as needed.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and performance of your blaster.

- **Dart Care:** Keep darts clean and dry. Avoid bending or crushing darts, as this can affect performance and cause jams.
- **Blaster Cleaning:** Wipe the blaster with a dry or slightly damp cloth to remove dust and debris. Do not submerge the blaster in water or use harsh chemicals.
- **Storage:** Store the blaster and darts in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your blaster, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Blaster jams frequently.	Damaged, bent, or non- official darts. Improper dart loading.	Ensure only official, undamaged NERF Elite darts are used. Load darts fully and correctly. Clear any jammed darts carefully.
Dart does not fire or fires weakly.	Blaster not fully primed. Damaged dart.	Pull the priming slide/handle all the way back until it locks. Replace damaged darts with new ones.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Accessories do not attach securely.	Incorrect alignment. Debris in attachment point.	Ensure accessories are aligned correctly with the rails/ports. Clear any debris from attachment points.
