The controller supports MCU and HUI protocols for seamless DAW integration, allowing control across various platforms. Customization for other software is possible via the downloadable MIDI Control Center software.

4. SETUP

3. **Software Installation:** Install the included software bundle (Analog Lab V, Ableton Live Lite, UVI Grand Piano, NI The Gentleman Piano) by following the instructions provided in the software download guide.
4. **DAW Integration:** The KeyLab Essential mk3 utilizes MCU and HUI protocols for seamless integration with major DAWs. Ensure your DAW is configured to recognize the controller.
5. **Customization:** For advanced customization or integration with other software, download the MIDI Control Center software from the Arturia website.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The KeyLab Essential mk3 is designed for intuitive operation. Here's a guide to its main functions:

5.1. Keys and Pads

- **61 Synth-Action Keys:** Play melodies, chords, and basslines. The keys are velocity-sensitive, meaning the sound's intensity changes based on how hard you press them.
- **8 Pads:** Use the velocity- and pressure-sensitive pads to trigger drums, samples, or launch clips in your DAW.

5.2. Encoders and Faders

- **9 Faders and 9 Encoders:** These controls are pre-mapped to essential parameters in Analog Lab V and other

integrated DAWs. Use them to adjust volume, filter cutoff, resonance, and other sound parameters.

- **Clickable Encoder:** The central clickable encoder allows for navigation through menus, preset selection, and fine-tuning parameters displayed on the LCD screen.

5.3. Transport Controls

The six transport control switches (Play, Stop, Record, Loop, Rewind, Fast Forward) allow you to control your DAW's playback and recording functions directly from the keyboard.

5.4. Pitch and Modulation Wheels

Use the pitch bend wheel to momentarily shift the pitch of notes up or down for expressive playing. The modulation wheel can be assigned to control various parameters like vibrato, tremolo, or filter sweeps.

- **Scale Mode:** Automatically quantizes your playing to a selected scale, making it easier to stay in key.
- **Chord Mode:** Play full chords with a single key press. Configure chord types and voicings to instantly create harmonic progressions.

- **Handling:** Handle the controller with care. Avoid dropping it or placing heavy objects on top of it.

- **Software Not Responding:** Check your DAW's MIDI settings to ensure the KeyLab Essential mk3 is recognized and enabled as a MIDI input device. Restart your DAW and/or computer.
- **Controls Not Working:** Verify that the controller is in the correct mode (e.g., DAW mode, Instrument mode). Use the MIDI Control Center software to check or re-assign MIDI mappings.
- **Sound Issues:** Ensure your audio interface and speakers/headphones are properly connected and configured. Check the volume levels on both the controller and your software.
