1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe operation, assembly, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Best Choice Products 12V Licensed Chevrolet Silverado Ride On Truck. Please read this manual thoroughly before initial use and retain it for future reference. This electric ride-on truck offers a realistic driving experience for children, featuring both manual and parent remote control options, a built-in sound system with Bluetooth connectivity, and functional LED lights.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: To reduce the risk of injury, adult supervision is required at all times. Failure to follow these safety instructions may result in serious injury or death.

- Never use this product on roadways, near motor vehicles, on or near steep inclines or steps, swimming pools, or other bodies of water.
- Always ensure the child wears appropriate footwear while operating the vehicle.
- Never allow more than one rider on the vehicle at a time. The vehicle is designed for single-rider use only.
- Ensure all assembly steps are completed correctly and all fasteners are securely tightened before first use.
- Regularly inspect the vehicle for damage, loose parts, or worn components. Do not operate if damaged.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present and undamaged upon opening the package. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact customer support immediately.

- 12V Licensed Chevrolet Silverado Ride On Truck (main body and components)
- Parent Remote Control
- Charger

- Assembly Guide
- Hardware Pack (screws, nuts, washers, etc.)

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the Chevrolet Silverado Ride On Truck is required before first use. Please refer to the included Assembly Guide for detailed, step-by-step instructions and diagrams. Ensure all parts are correctly installed and secured.

4.1 Initial Battery Charging

Before the first use, fully charge the 12V battery for approximately 8-12 hours. Do not overcharge. Subsequent charges should be 8-12 hours. The battery runs for up to 1 hour on a full charge, depending on usage.

4.2 Assembly Overview

The assembly process typically involves attaching the wheels, steering wheel, seat, and connecting the battery. Follow the specific instructions in the Assembly Guide for your model.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Manual Driving

The child can operate the truck manually using the steering wheel and foot pedal. Ensure the vehicle is on a flat, safe surface away from hazards.

- **Start/Stop:** Use the power button or switch to turn the vehicle on or off.
- **Acceleration:** Press the foot pedal to move forward. Release to brake.
- **Steering:** Turn the steering wheel left or right to change direction.
- **Speed Selection:** If equipped, use the speed switch (high/low) to adjust the maximum speed. The maximum speed is 2.5 mph.

5.2 Parent Remote Control

The included 2.4G remote control allows parents to safely guide the vehicle, especially for younger children or in situations requiring immediate control. The remote control has priority over manual operation.

- **Pairing:** Follow the instructions in the Assembly Guide to pair the remote control with the vehicle.
- **Forward/Reverse:** Use the corresponding buttons on the remote to move the truck forward or backward.
- **Left/Right:** Use the directional buttons to steer the truck left or right.
- **Stop Button:** Press the 'P' or stop button on the remote to immediately halt the vehicle.

5.3 Bluetooth Connectivity

The built-in sound system allows for media playback via Bluetooth, USB, or AUX input (if available on your model). Refer to the dashboard controls for specific functions.

- **Pairing Bluetooth:** Turn on the vehicle. Activate Bluetooth on your mobile device and search for the vehicle's Bluetooth name (e.g., "BCP Ride On"). Select to pair.
- **Media Playback:** Once connected, play audio from your device. Use the vehicle's dashboard controls for volume adjustment, track skipping, or mode selection (Bluetooth/USB/AUX).




Figure 5.3.1: The dashboard features controls for power, speed, and the integrated sound system with Bluetooth connectivity.

6. PRODUCT FEATURES

6.1 Realistic Driving Experience

7. MAINTENANCE

7.1 Battery Care

- Always charge the battery in a dry, well-ventilated area.
- Do not allow the battery to completely drain before recharging.
- If storing the vehicle for an extended period, charge the battery fully every 3 months to prolong its lifespan.
- Only use the charger provided by the manufacturer.

7.2 Cleaning and Storage

- Clean the vehicle with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Avoid spraying water directly onto electrical components.
- Store the vehicle indoors in a dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vehicle does not move	Battery is low or dead Loose battery connection Overload protector activated	Recharge battery Check and secure battery terminals Turn off vehicle for 5 minutes, then restart
Vehicle moves slowly	Undercharged battery Overloaded vehicle Operating on rough terrain	Fully recharge battery Reduce weight on vehicle Operate on smoother surfaces
Remote control not working	Remote battery dead Remote not paired Interference	Replace remote batteries Re-pair remote control (refer to manual) Move to an area with less interference
Bluetooth not connecting	Vehicle not in Bluetooth mode Device too far Bluetooth not enabled on device	Switch vehicle to Bluetooth mode Bring device closer to vehicle Enable Bluetooth on your device







Figure 9.1: Detailed product dimensions for the Chevrolet Silverado Ride On Truck.




