1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the YATOINTO 20" Log Grabber. This tool is designed to assist in the efficient and safe handling, lifting, dragging, and carrying of logs and poles. Its robust construction and ergonomic design aim to simplify demanding tasks in logging and yard work. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure proper operation and to maximize the lifespan of your tool.

Key features include:

- **20" Max Opening:** Accommodates a wide variety of log sizes.
- **440 LBS Lifting Capacity:** Designed for heavy-duty tasks.
- **Sharp Claw Hooks:** Provides a secure grip on logs, preventing slippage.
- **Durable Steel Construction:** Ensures strength and longevity, resisting bending or breaking.
- **Wooden Slip-proof Handle:** Offers a comfortable and secure hold.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Failure to follow these safety instructions may result in serious injury or property damage.

- Always wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE), including safety gloves, safety glasses, and sturdy footwear, when operating the log grabber.
- Ensure a clear work area free from obstructions and bystanders.
- Inspect the log grabber for any signs of damage, wear, or loose components before each use. Do not use if damaged.
- Do not exceed the maximum lifting capacity of 440 LBS.

- Maintain a firm grip on the handle and ensure the claws are securely engaged with the log before lifting or dragging.
- Lift with your legs, not your back, to prevent injury.
- Be aware of your surroundings and potential hazards, such as uneven terrain or unstable logs.
- Keep children and pets away from the work area.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items are present and in good condition upon opening the package:

- 1 x YATOINTO 20" Log Grabber
- 1 x Pair of Anti-slip Gloves

4. SETUP

The YATOINTO Log Grabber comes pre-assembled and ready for use. Before initial use and periodically thereafter, perform the following checks:

1. **Inspect Bolts:** Ensure all bolts connecting the moving parts are securely tightened.
2. **Check Handle:** Verify the wooden handle is firmly attached and shows no signs of looseness or damage.
3. **Test Movement:** Open and close the grabber several times to ensure smooth operation of the claw hooks.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps for safe and effective use of your log grabber:

1. **Wear Gloves:** Always put on the provided anti-slip gloves for enhanced grip and protection.
2. **Positioning:** Approach the log you intend to move. Open the log grabber by holding the wooden handle and spreading the claws.
3. **Engage Claws:** Place the sharp claw hooks around the log. Ensure both claws penetrate the log surface for a secure hold. The grabber is designed to automatically tighten its grip as you lift.
4. **Lifting/Dragging:** With a firm grip on the wooden handle, lift or drag the log. Utilize proper lifting techniques, bending your knees and keeping your back straight, especially for heavier logs.
5. **Releasing:** To release the log, simply lower it to the ground and open the grabber by hand.

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and reliable performance of your log grabber:

- **Cleaning:** After each use, clean any dirt, sap, or debris from the grabber, especially around the claw hooks and pivot points. A damp cloth is usually sufficient.
- **Lubrication:** Periodically apply a light lubricant to the pivot points to ensure smooth operation and prevent rust.

- **Inspection:** Regularly check for any signs of wear, cracks, or deformation in the steel components. Ensure the wooden handle remains secure.
- **Storage:** Store the log grabber in a dry place, away from direct moisture and corrosive materials, to prevent rust and damage.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your log grabber, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Problem:** The grabber does not hold the log securely.
Solution: Ensure the sharp claw hooks are fully engaged with the log. The log surface might be too hard or slippery; try repositioning the grabber. Inspect the claw tips for dullness or damage.
- **Problem:** The grabber feels stiff or difficult to open/close.
Solution: The pivot points may require lubrication. Clean any accumulated dirt or debris from the joints and apply a suitable lubricant.
- **Problem:** The tool appears bent or deformed.
Solution: Immediately cease use. This indicates the tool may have been subjected to excessive force or loads beyond its capacity. Continued use of a bent or damaged tool can be dangerous. Contact customer support for assistance.
