INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the user manual for your Daysnew Wireless TV Headphones. These headphones are designed to provide a high-quality audio experience for TV watching, featuring both 2.4GHz RF and Bluetooth 5.3 connectivity. This manual will guide you through the setup, operation, and maintenance of your new headphones.

SETUP

Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge the headphones. Place the headphones on the transmitter charging dock. The charge indicator light on the dock will show charging status.



The headphones are placed on the RF transmitter, which also functions as a charging dock. Ensure proper alignment for charging.

Connecting the Transmitter to Your TV

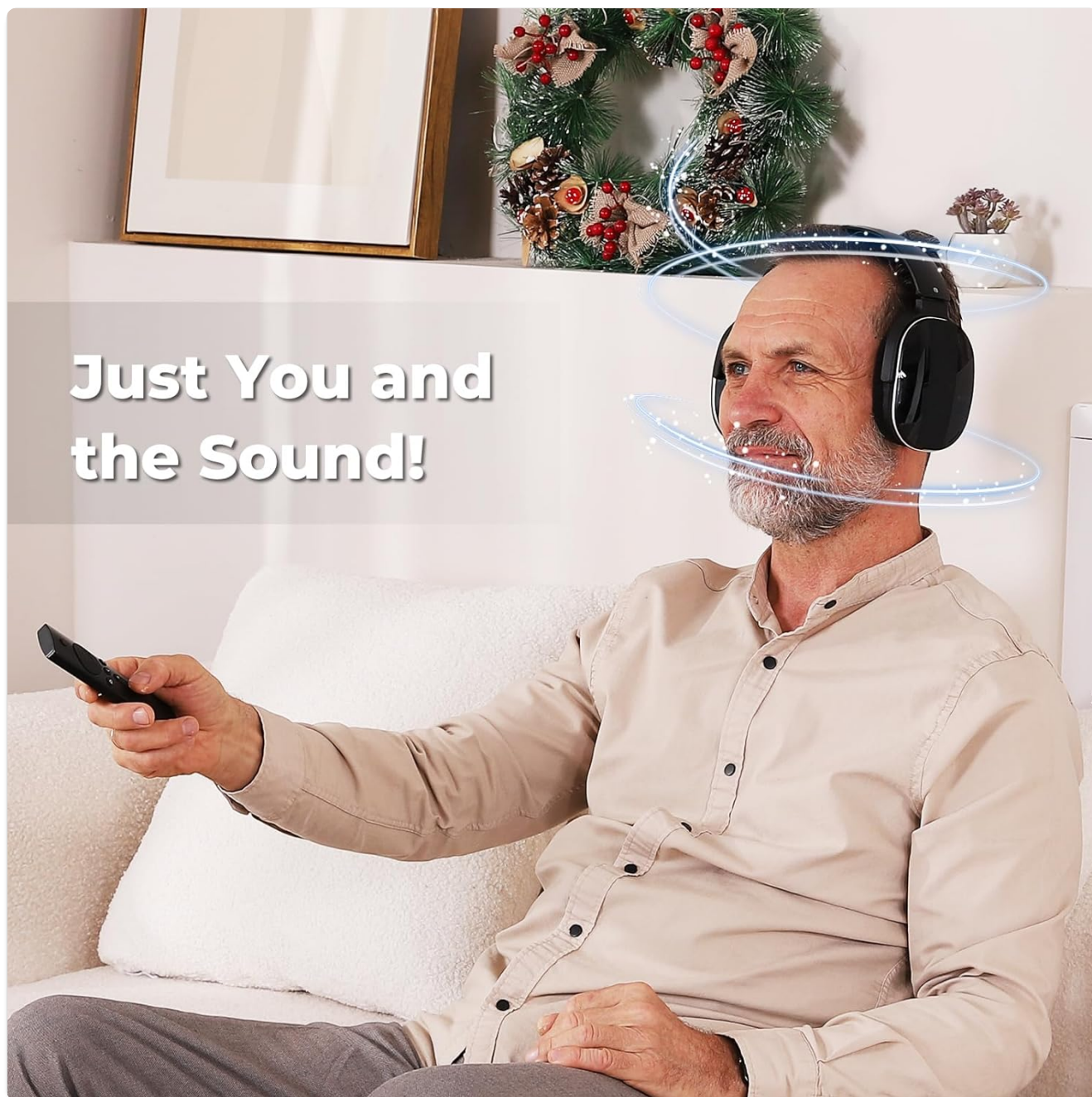
The RF transmitter offers multiple connection options to your TV. Choose the method compatible with your

television's audio output.

Optical Audio Connection (Recommended)

Connect one end of the optical audio cable to the OPTICAL OUT port on your TV and the other end to the OPTICAL IN port on the RF transmitter.

On your TV's audio settings, select "Optical" or "Digital Audio Out" and ensure the format is set to PCM.

RCA Audio Connection

Connect the red and white plugs of the RCA audio cable to the corresponding AUDIO OUT (L/R) ports on your TV and the other end to the RCA IN ports on the transmitter.

AUX Audio Connection

Connect the 3.5mm AUX cable to the headphone jack or AUX OUT port on your TV and the other end to the AUX IN port on the transmitter.

Powering On

Connect the Type-C adapter to the transmitter and plug it into a power outlet. The transmitter's indicator light will illuminate.

Press and hold the Power button on the headphones for 3 seconds to turn them on. The headphones will automatically connect to the transmitter.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

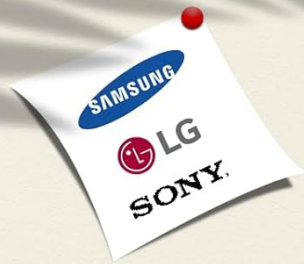
TV Mode (RF 2.4GHz)

Once the transmitter is connected and powered on, and the headphones are turned on, they will automatically establish a 2.4GHz RF connection for TV audio.

Adjust the volume using the volume controls on the headphones.

Bluetooth Mode (BT 5.3)

To switch to Bluetooth mode, press the "TV/BT" button on the headphones. The indicator light will change to blue, indicating Bluetooth pairing mode.

On your device (phone, tablet, laptop), search for "DAYSNEW DB100" in the Bluetooth settings and select to pair.

Once paired, the headphones will play audio from your Bluetooth device.

Controls

The headphones feature intuitive controls for easy operation.

- **Power Button:** Press and hold for 3 seconds to turn on/off.
- **Volume Up/Next Track:** Short press for volume up, long press for next track (in Bluetooth mode).
- **Volume Down/Previous Track:** Short press for volume down, long press for previous track (in Bluetooth mode).
- **Play/Pause/Call Answer:** Single press to play/pause music or answer/end calls (in Bluetooth mode).
- **TV/BT Button:** Press to switch between RF (TV) and Bluetooth modes.

The headphones allow for independent volume adjustment, enabling you to listen at your preferred level without affecting the TV's main volume or disturbing others.



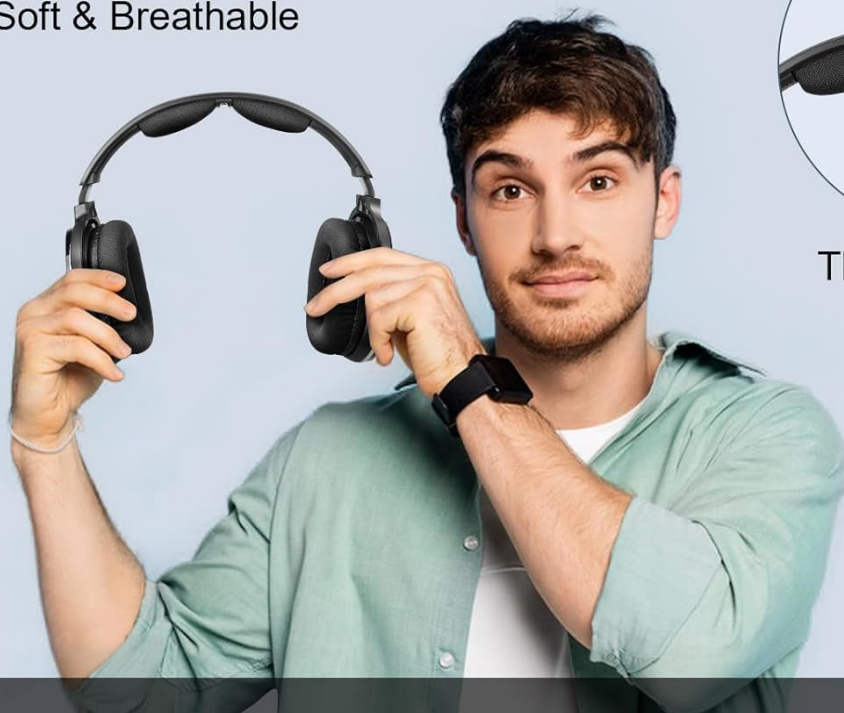

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Solution
No Sound in TV Mode	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure the transmitter is powered on and connected correctly to the TV's audio output.• Check TV audio settings: select "Optical" or "Digital Audio Out" and set format to PCM.• Verify headphones are turned on and in TV mode (RF).• Check headphone volume.

Problem	Solution
No Sound in Bluetooth Mode	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure headphones are in Bluetooth mode (blue indicator light).• Check if headphones are paired with your device. If not, re-pair.• Verify Bluetooth is enabled on your device.• Check volume on both headphones and your device.
Poor Audio Quality / Static	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure headphones are within the 98ft (30M) operating range of the transmitter.• Minimize interference from other 2.4GHz devices.• Check cable connections for looseness or damage.
Headphones Not Charging	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure the transmitter is plugged into a working power outlet.• Verify headphones are correctly seated on the charging dock.• Check the charging indicator light on the dock.
