#### SETUP AND PAIRING

#### 1. Battery Installation

Open the battery compartment cover on the back of the remote. Insert two (2) AA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-). Close the cover securely.

#### 2. Initial Pairing with Your TV

- 1. Ensure your LG TV is powered on.
- 2. Point the Magic Remote towards your TV.
- 3. Press the **Wheel (OK)** button located in the center of the directional pad. The remote should automatically pair with your TV.
- 4. If the pointer function is not working, press and hold the **GUIDE** button for more than 5 seconds to disconnect and re-register the motion sensor remote control. This step is often necessary for new remotes or remotes previously used with another TV.

Note: If the TV fails to register the Magic Remote, try again after turning the TV off and then back on.

# How to register(pair) this Magic Remote

To use the Magic Remote, first pair it with your TV

- 1 At first, Hold down the and buttons simultaneously for 10 seconds to reset Remote Control.
- 2 Point the Magic Remote at your TV and press the Wheel(OK) on the remote control.

#### **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

#### **Voice Function**

The Magic Remote features voice recognition, supporting Google Assistant and Alexa. To use this function, ensure your TV has an active internet connection. Press and hold the **Voice Recognition** button (microphone icon) and speak your command. Release the button when finished speaking.

#### **Pointer Function (Magic Remote)**

The wheel button also functions as an air mouse. Move the remote to control a pointer on the TV screen. Press the **Wheel (OK)** button to select items. If the pointer disappears, shake the Magic Remote to reactivate it.

#### **Button Functions Overview**

Below is a list of common buttons and their functions. Some buttons and services may vary depending on your specific TV model or region.

Button	Function
POWER	Turns the TV on or off.
STB POWER	Can turn your set-top box on or off by adding the set-top box to the universal remote control for your TV.
Number Buttons (0-9)	Enters numbers.
9**	Accesses the Quick Help.
- (DASH)	Inserts a DASH between numbers such as 2-1 and 2-2.

LIST	Accesses the saved programs list.
(MORE ACTIONS)	Displays more remote control functions.
QUICK ACCESS**	Edits QUICK ACCESS. A feature that allows you to enter a specified app or Live TV directly by pressing and holding the number buttons.
AD / SAP**	SAP (Secondary Audio Program) feature can also be enabled by pressing the button.
Volume Up/Down	Adjusts the volume level.
MUTE	Mutes all sounds.
Accessibility**	Accesses the [Accessibility] menu.
Channel Up/Down	Scrolls through the saved channels.
Voice Recognition	Network connection is required to use the voice recognition function. Check for recommended content. (Some recommended services may not be available in some countries)
Voice Recognition**	Speak while pressing and holding the button to use the voice recognition feature.
HOME	Accesses the Home menu.
HOME**	Shows the previous history.
Q Setting	Accesses the Quick Settings.
Q Setting**	Displays the [All Settings] menu.
WHEEL (OK)	Press the center of the Wheel button to select a menu. You can change programs by using the wheel button.
Up/Down/Left/Right	Press the up, down, left, or right button to scroll the menu. If you press these buttons while the pointer is in use, the pointer will disappear from the screen and the Magic Remote will operate like a general remote control. To display the pointer on the screen again, shake the Magic Remote to the left and right.
BACK	Returns to the previous screen.
BACK**	Clears on-screen displays and returns to last input viewing.
GUIDE	Displays the program event according to time scheduler.
Streaming Service Buttons	Connects to the Video Streaming Service (e.g., Netflix, Prime Video).
INPUT	Changes the input source.
INPUT**	Accesses the [Home Dashboard].
Colored Buttons	These access special functions in some menus.

Button	Function
CONTROL BUTTONS	Controls media contents (Play, Pause, Stop, Fast Forward, Rewind).

# **Using Magic Remote Control**

(Depending on model)

The descriptions in this manual are based on the buttons on the remote control. Please read this manual carefully and use the TV correctly. When the message "Magic Remote battery is low. Please change the battery." is displayed, replace the battery.

To install batteries, open the battery cover, replace batteries (1.5V AA) matching the  $\bigoplus$  and  $\bigoplus$  ends to the label inside the compartment, and close the battery cover Be sure to point the magic remote toward the remote control sensor on the TV, To remove the batteries, perform the installation actions in reverse This remote uses infrared light When in use, it should be pointed in the direction of the TVs remote sensor

#### **T**ROUBLESHOOTING

- **Remote not responding:** Ensure batteries are correctly inserted and have sufficient charge. Replace with new AA batteries if necessary.
- **Pointer not appearing or working:** Re-pair the remote by holding the GUIDE button for 5 seconds. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV.
- Voice function not working: Verify that your LG Smart TV has voice recognition capabilities and is connected to the internet. Ensure you are pressing and holding the voice button while speaking.
- Specific buttons not working: Confirm your TV model is listed in the compatibility section. Some

advanced functions may require specific TV software versions or settings.

• **Intermittent connection:** Ensure the remote is within a reasonable range of the TV and there is no significant interference from other electronic devices.
