1. INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides detailed guidance for assembling and maintaining your Kadablk Musical Instruments Micro Blocks Building Set, featuring a Piano and a Saxophone model. This set contains approximately 1500 micro building blocks designed for enthusiasts aged 14 years and older.

3. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

3.1. Piano Model Assembly (Model 9940-1)

The Piano model consists of approximately 800 pieces. Begin by sorting the blocks by color and shape to facilitate the building process. Pay close attention to the diagrams in the instruction booklet for correct placement of each micro block.

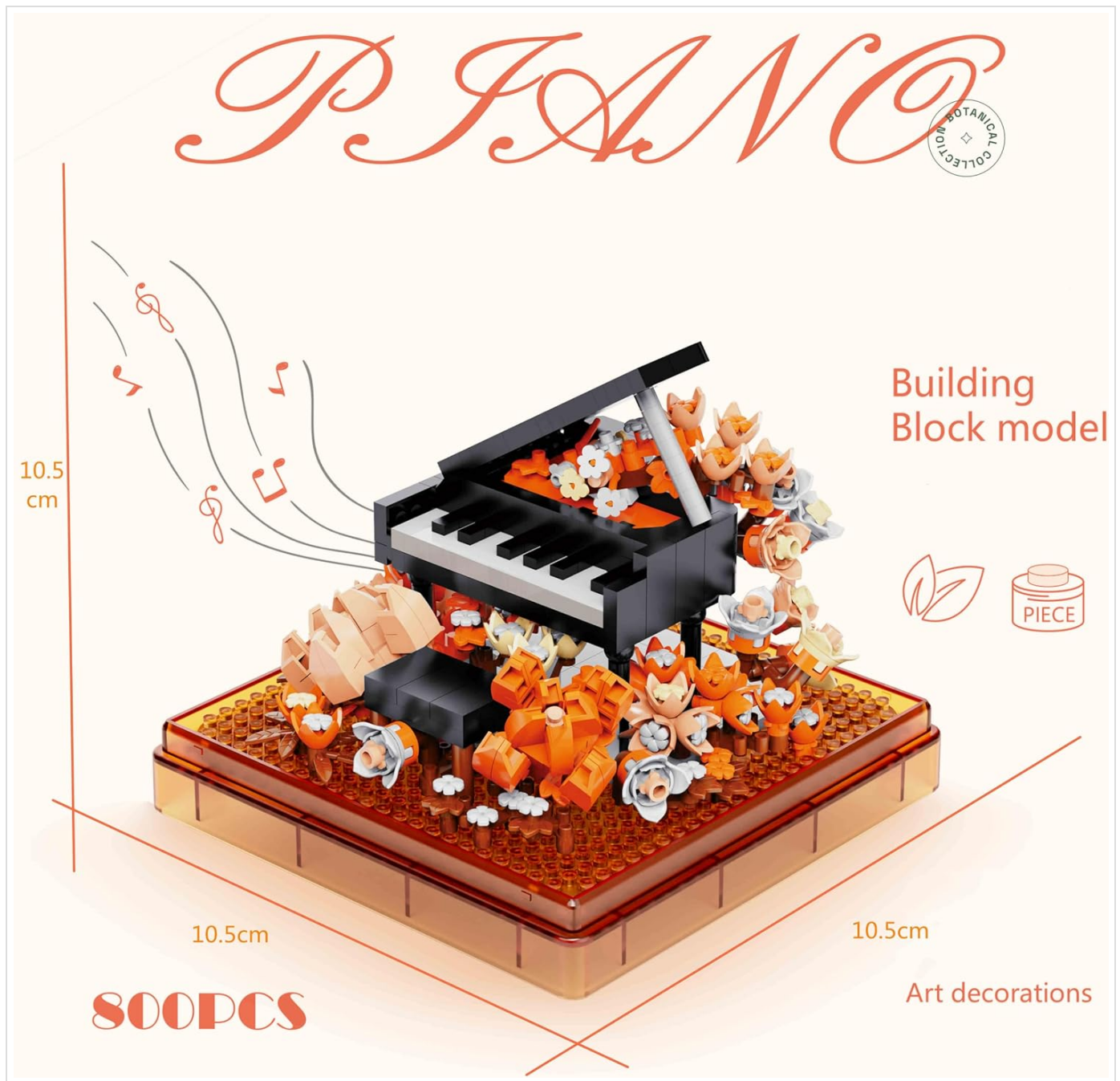


Figure 3.1: Piano Model Overview. This image displays the fully assembled Piano model, measuring approximately 10.5 cm in length, width, and height. It includes a base plate and decorative floral elements.

3.2. Saxophone Model Assembly (Model 9940-4)

The Saxophone model comprises approximately 730 pieces. Similar to the Piano, organize your blocks before starting. The Saxophone model features intricate details and a vibrant floral base. Ensure all connections are secure as you build.

- **Use a Flat Surface:** Assemble the models on a clean, flat, and well-lit surface.

Once assembled, your Kadablk Musical Instruments Micro Blocks models can be displayed using the provided clear plastic covers. These covers help protect the models from dust and damage.

4.1. Displaying Your Models

Place the assembled models on their respective base plates. Carefully position the clear plastic cover over each model. The covers can be stacked for a compact display.

4.2. Storage

For long-term storage, ensure the models are clean and placed within their display covers. Store them in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight to prevent material degradation or discoloration.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will ensure the longevity and appearance of your micro block models.

5.1. Cleaning

- **Dust Removal:** Use a soft brush or a can of compressed air to gently remove dust from the models.
- **Spot Cleaning:** For stubborn dirt, lightly dampen a soft cloth with water (and a mild soap if necessary) and gently wipe the affected area. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Drying:** Allow models to air dry completely before re-covering or storing.

5.2. Handling

Handle the assembled models with care. While the blocks are designed to interlock securely, excessive force or dropping can cause parts to detach.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter during assembly or use.

6.1. Missing Pieces

If you discover missing pieces during assembly, please:

1. Double-check all packaging materials and the assembly area. Small micro blocks can be easily overlooked.

- Verify that you are using the correct block for the step.
