Dome Brush for curved surfaces



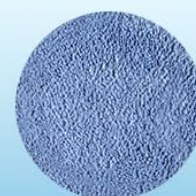
Pointed Brush for corner areas



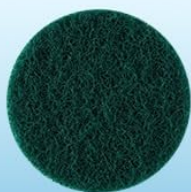

3. SETUP

These brush heads are designed for quick and easy attachment to your QCHMM YMG-820 Electric Cleaning Brush.

1. **Ensure Power Off:** Before attaching or detaching any brush head, ensure your YMG-820 Electric Cleaning Brush is turned off and disconnected from any power source.
2. **Align Brush Head:** Take the desired brush head and align its connector with the rotating shaft of the electric cleaning brush.
3. **Attach Securely:** Push the brush head firmly onto the shaft until it clicks into place. Gently pull on the brush head to confirm it is securely attached and will not detach during operation.
4. **Detaching:** To remove a brush head, firmly grasp the brush head and pull it away from the shaft.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Select the appropriate brush head for your cleaning task and follow these general guidelines for optimal results.

- **Surface Compatibility:** The brush heads are suitable for a wide range of surfaces including wood, tile, grout, ceramic, metal, stone, plastic, porcelain, floors, glass, and vinyl. Always test on an inconspicuous area first.
- **Large Flat Brush:** Ideal for extensive flat surfaces such as floors, walls, and large shower areas.
- **Small Flat Brush:** Best for smaller flat areas, countertops, and detailed flat surfaces.
- **Dome Brush:** Excellent for curved surfaces like sinks, bathtubs, and toilet bowls.
- **Pointed Brush (Scrubbing Brush):** Designed to reach into corners, crevices, and grout lines for deep cleaning.
- **Scouring Pad Brush:** Effective for kitchen areas, stovetops, and removing stubborn oily stains.
- **Sponge Brush:** Suitable for delicate surfaces, sinks, and small, intricate spaces requiring gentle cleaning.
- **Wool Brush:** Use for cleaning and polishing sensitive surfaces like car exteriors and furniture.
- **Small Fabric Brush (Absorbent Clot Brush):** Perfect for streak-free cleaning of windows, mirrors, and shower glass.
- **Application:** Apply a suitable cleaning solution to the surface or the brush head before activating the electric cleaning brush. Move the brush steadily over the surface, allowing the rotation to do the work.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance extends the life of your brush heads and ensures consistent cleaning performance.

- **Cleaning Brush Heads:** After each use, detach the brush head and rinse it thoroughly under running water to remove any dirt, debris, or cleaning solution residue.
- **Drying:** Allow brush heads to air dry completely before storing them. Do not store wet brush heads, as this can lead to mildew or damage.
- **Restoring Shape:** If brush heads become deformed, especially those made from regenerable material, immerse them in warm water for a few minutes. This can help restore their original shape.
- **Storage:** Store brush heads in a clean, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Replacement:** Replace brush heads when they show signs of significant wear, damage, or reduced cleaning effectiveness.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your brush heads, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Brush Head Not Attaching Securely:**
Solution: Ensure the brush head is correctly aligned with the electric cleaning brush's shaft and pushed firmly until it clicks. Check for any obstructions in the connection point.
- **Reduced Cleaning Effectiveness:**
Solution: The brush head may be worn out or dirty. Clean the brush head thoroughly or replace it if it shows significant wear. Ensure you are using the correct brush head for the surface and applying appropriate cleaning solution.
- **Brush Head Deformed:**
Solution: As mentioned in maintenance, immerse the brush head in warm water to help it regain its original shape. If deformation persists or affects performance, replace the brush head.
