

SETUP AND FITTING

Proper fitting of your Osprey Aether Pro 75L backpack is crucial for comfort and load stability. Follow these steps to adjust your pack.

1. Torso Length Adjustment:

The AirScape frame sheet maintains comfortable back contact with ventilated airflow channels and superior stability. The webbing length adjusters on the torso allow for easy and secure fit adjustments.



Refer to the Aether Sizing Chart to determine the appropriate size for your torso length and hipbelt maximum.

2. Shoulder Strap Adjustment:

The custom Fit-on-the-Fly shoulder straps allow for precise shoulder wrap. The spacer mesh fabric provides a cool, comfortable contact surface.

3. Hipbelt Adjustment:

The length and angle of the Fit-on-the-Fly hipbelt can be adjusted, offering a precise fit for varying waist sizes. The cross-body ErgoPull design secures the weight into the lumbar, ensuring stable load carry when tightened.

OPERATING FEATURES

Access and Storage:

- Removable Top Lid with FlapJacket Cover: The top lid can be removed for weight savings or when carrying
 oversized items. The integrated FlapJacket cover provides protection for the main compartment when the lid is
 removed.
- Full-Length Vertical Side Zipper: Provides convenient access to the main compartment, allowing you to retrieve items without unpacking the entire bag.
- **Dual Removable Hipbelt Pockets:** Ideal for storing small, frequently accessed items like snacks, phone, or GPS. These pockets can be removed to further reduce pack weight.
- Internal Reservoir Sleeve: Designed to hold a hydration reservoir (not included), ensuring easy access to water during your activities.

External Attachments:

- **Dual Removable Side Compression Straps:** Used to stabilize the load and compress the pack when it's not full. These can be removed if not needed.
- **Dual Front Compression Straps with StraitJacket Compression:** Further secure the load and allow for external attachment of gear.
- Stow-on-the-Go Trekking Pole Attachment: Allows for quick and easy attachment and removal of trekking poles without taking off your pack.

- Removable Dual Ice Tool Loops with Upper Cord Attachments: Securely carry ice axes or other technical tools.
- Removable Sleeping Pad Straps: Located at the bottom of the pack for external attachment of a sleeping pad or other bulky gear.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and performance of your Osprey Aether Pro 75L backpack, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- Cleaning: Hand wash with mild soap and cold water. Do not use bleach or harsh detergents. Air dry thoroughly away from direct sunlight.
- **Storage:** Store your backpack in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Ensure it is completely dry before storing to prevent mildew.
- Fabric Care: The pack is treated with DWR (Durable Water Repellent) made without PFAS. Over time, the DWR treatment may wear off. You can reapply a DWR spray designed for outdoor gear to maintain water resistance.
- **Zippers and Buckles:** Periodically check all zippers and buckles for smooth operation. Clean zippers with a small brush if they become gritty. Lubricate with a silicone-based spray if needed.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter with your backpack:

• Discomfort/Poor Fit:

- Re-evaluate torso length adjustment using the webbing adjusters.
- Ensure shoulder straps are properly wrapped and adjusted.
- Tighten the Fit-on-the-Fly hipbelt using the ErgoPull design to transfer weight to your hips.
- Distribute load evenly inside the pack, placing heavier items closer to your back and between your shoulder blades.

• Squeaking Noises:

- Check for loose buckles or straps and tighten them.
- Ensure the frame sheet is properly seated within its sleeve.

· Zippers Sticking:

- Clean any dirt or debris from the zipper teeth.
- · Apply a small amount of zipper lubricant (e.g., silicone spray or zipper wax) to the teeth.

• Reduced Water Repellency:

- Clean the pack as per maintenance instructions.
- Apply a DWR re-treatment spray suitable for outdoor fabrics.
